APPLIQUE INSTRUCTIONS:

- Trace thirty 6" circles onto the paper side of fusible web.
- Rough cut the circles from the fusible web.
- Following the manufacturer's directions, fuse the circles to wrong side of the appliqué fabrics as directed in the Cutting Instructions.
- Cut out the circle shape. Peel off the paper. Center the circles onto Blocks 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6. Fuse.
- Machine appliqué the circles to the blocks using the stitch of your choice.

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS: *Cut fabrics in order given.*

A. Pattern #17738 – BLU1 (large paisley):

- Cut four 8 1/2" x 42" strips for outer border.
- Fuse five 6" circles for appliqué.

B. Pattern #17738 – PIN1 (large paisley):

- Cut four 8 1/2" x 42" strips for outer border.
- Fuse five 6" circles for appliqué.

C. Pattern #17739 – LTPIN1 (medium floral):

- Fuse four 6" circles for appliqué.

D. Pattern #17739 – BLU1 (medium floral):

- Fuse four 6" circles for appliqué.

E. Pattern #17740 – BLU1 (circles):

- Fuse one 6" circle for appliqué.

F. Pattern #17740 – RED1 (circles):

- Fuse one 6" circle for appliqué.

G. Pattern #17741 – RED1 (strips):

- Cut four 2 1/2" x 42" strips for inner border.
- Fuse two 6" circles for appliqué.

H. Pattern #17741 – BLU1 (strips):

- Cut four 2 1/2" x 42" strips for inner border.
- Fuse two 6" circles for appliqué.

I. Pattern #17742 – PUR1 (plaid):

- Cut one 9 1/4" square. Cut once on each diagonal to yield four triangles for blocks.

J. Pattern #17742 – RED1 (plaid):

- Cut five 9 1/4" squares. Cut once on each diagonal to yield twenty triangles for blocks. You will have one extra.

K. Pattern #17742 – GRE1 (plaid):

- Cut three 9 1/4" squares. Cut once on each diagonal to yield twelve triangles for blocks.

L. Pattern #17742 – BLU1 (plaid):

- Cut two 9 1/4" squares. Cut once on each diagonal to yield eight triangles for blocks.

M. Pattern #17743 – PIN1 (small floral):

- Fuse three 6" circles for appliqué.

N. Pattern #17743 – BLU1 (small floral):

- Fuse three 6" circles for appliqué.

O. Pattern #17744 – RED1 (dots):

- Cut three 9 1/4" squares. Cut once on each diagonal to yield twelve triangles for blocks.

P. Pattern #17744 – OLI1 (dots):

- Cut six 9 1/4" squares. Cut once on each diagonal to yield twenty-four triangles for blocks. You will have two extra.

Q. Pattern #17744 – LTYEL1 (dots):

- Cut five 9 1/4" squares. Cut once on each diagonal to yield twenty triangles for blocks. You will have three extra.

R. Pattern #17744 – YEL1 (dots):

- Cut two 9 1/4" squares. Cut once on each diagonal to yield eight triangles for blocks.
- Cut seven 2 1/2" x 42" strips for binding.

S. Pattern #17745 – GRE1 (seeds):

- Cut five 9 1/4" squares. Cut once on each diagonal to yield twenty triangles for blocks. You will have two extra.

T. Pattern #17745 – BLU1 (seeds):

- Cut two 9 1/4" squares. Cut once on each diagonal to yield eight triangles for blocks. You will have three extra.

U. Pattern #17745 – PUR1 (seeds):

- Cut three 9 1/4" squares. Cut once on each diagonal to yield twelve triangles for blocks. You will have three extra.

V. Pattern #17745 – RED1 (seeds):

- Cut three 9 1/4" squares. Cut once on each diagonal to yield twelve triangles for blocks. You will have two extra.

PIECING INSTRUCTIONS: *All sewn seams are 1/4".*

Quarter-Square Triangle Blocks:

Make 36 (six plain blocks and thirty appliqué blocks)

Finished Block Size: 8" square

General Sewing Directions for all

Quarter-Square Triangle Blocks:

- Sew each set of triangles together (Figure 1). Press seams in opposite directions.
- Sew the two halves of the block together (Figure 2). Press.

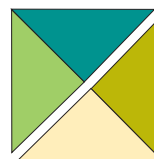

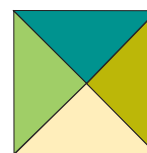

Block 1: Plain blocks

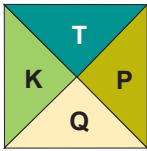

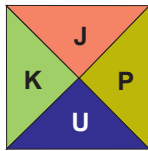

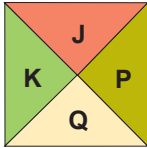

Refer to Applique Instructions to complete Blocks 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6.

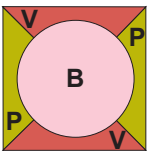

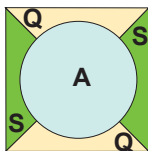

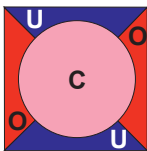

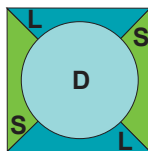

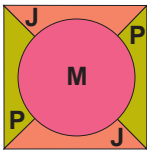

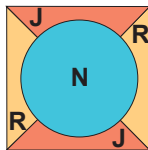

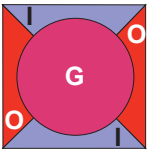

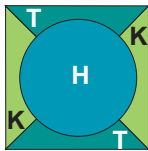

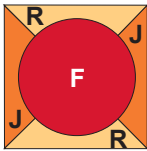

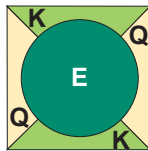


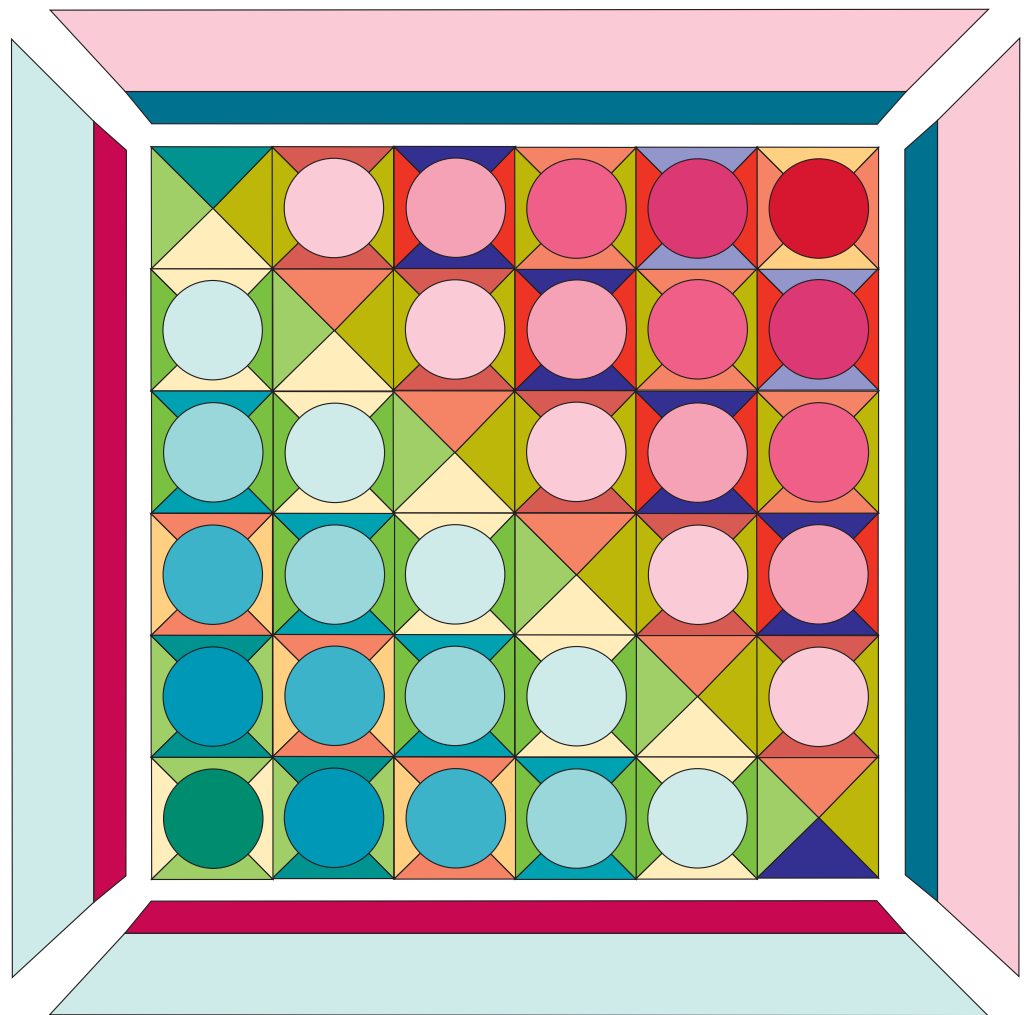

QUILT ASSEMBLY: Refer to Quilt Diagram.

1. Arrange the blocks into six rows of six blocks each.
2. Sew the blocks into rows. Press seams in opposite directions from row to row.
3. Sew rows together. Press.
4. Mitered Borders: Refer to Quilt Diagram for color placement of the borders.
 - A. Sew two sets of 2 1/2" red inner border strips together end-to-end. Press seams open. Repeat with the blue inner border strips.
 - B. Sew two sets of 8 1/2" blue outer border strips together end-to-end. Press seams open. Repeat with the pink outer border strips.
 - C. Sew each blue inner border strip to each pink outer border strip. Press. Repeat with the red inner border strips and the blue outer border strips.
 - D. Match the center of each border strip unit to the center of each side of the quilt. Sew to the sides of the quilt, stitching to within 1/4" of each corner of the quilt. Press seams toward the border. Miter the corners. Trim 1/4" away from seams and press.

FINISHING:

1. Prepare the backing with vertical seams to measure 75" x 75". Press seams open.
2. Layer quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Trim the batting and backing even with the quilt top.
5. Join binding strips. Apply the binding to the quilt using your favorite method.
