

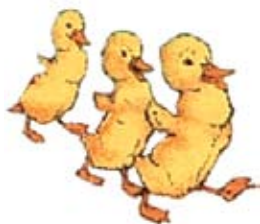
Daisies, Dogs and Ducks, Two!

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

- Pattern #13866 – MUL11½ yards
 13870 – GRE1½ yard
 13870 – YEL1½ yard
 13870 – RED1½ yard
 13870 – RED1*additional 1 yard for outer border & binding. (Optional color choices for border & binding: Pattern #13870 – GRE1, BLU1 or YEL1.)
 13870 – BLU1**½ yard
 13871 – GRE1one fat quarter
 13871 – BLU1one fat quarter
 13871 – YEL1one fat quarter
 13871 – RED1one fat quarter
 16283 – YEL12⁷/₈ yards for quilt backing with horizontal seam
 16284 – GRE1one fat quarter
 16285 – BLU17⁷/₈ yard

*Border and binding color can be easily changed to GRE1, BLU1 or YEL1 of Pattern #13870 with an additional 1 yard of the color of choice.

**There is sufficient yardage to change the blue texture accent strip (as shown in the photo) to the green, yellow or red textures.

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS *Cut fabrics in order given.*

A. Pattern #13866 – MUL1 (scenic print):

1. Fussy cut eighteen 6½" squares (A) for the Snowball blocks.

B. Pattern #13870 – GRE1 (green texture):

1. Cut two 2½" x 42" strips. Crosscut into eighteen 2½" squares (B) for the Snowball blocks.
2. Cut one 2⁷/₈" x 42" strip. Crosscut into eight 2⁷/₈" squares (C) for the Friendship Star blocks.
3. Cut one 2⁷/₈" x 42" strip. Crosscut into eleven 2⁷/₈" squares (I) for the Sawtooth border.

C. Pattern #13870 – YEL1 (yellow texture):

1. Cut two 2½" x 42" strips. Crosscut into eighteen 2½" squares (B) for the Snowball blocks.
2. Cut one 2⁷/₈" x 42" strip. Crosscut into eight 2⁷/₈" squares (C) for the Friendship Star blocks.
3. Cut one 2⁷/₈" x 42" strip. Crosscut into eleven 2⁷/₈" squares (I) for the Sawtooth border.

D. Pattern #13870 – RED1 (red texture):

1. Cut two 2½" x 42" strips. Crosscut into eighteen 2½" squares (B) for the Snowball blocks.
2. Cut one 2⁷/₈" x 42" strip. Crosscut into ten 2⁷/₈" squares (C) for the Friendship Star blocks.
3. Cut one 2⁷/₈" x 42" strip. Crosscut into eleven 2⁷/₈" squares (I) for the Sawtooth border.
4. From the additional 1 yard of red texture:
 - *a. Cut five 3" x 42" strips for outer border.
 - *b. Cut five 2½" x 42" strips for binding.

E. Pattern #13870 – BLU1 (blue texture):

1. Cut two 2½" x 42" strips. Crosscut into eighteen 2½" squares (B).
2. Cut one 2⁷/₈" x 42" strip. Crosscut into eight 2⁷/₈" squares (C).
3. Cut one 2⁷/₈" x 42" strip. Crosscut into eleven 2⁷/₈" squares (I).
4. Cut four 1" x 42" strips (G) for the accent strips.

F. Pattern #13871 – GRE1 (green check):

1. Cut three 2⁷/₈" x 21" strips. Crosscut into twenty 2⁷/₈" squares. Label nine squares E (Friendship Star blocks) and eleven squares J (Sawtooth border).

G. Pattern #13871 – BLU1 (blue check):

1. Cut three 2⁷/₈" x 21" strips. Crosscut into twenty 2⁷/₈" squares. Label nine squares E (Friendship Star blocks) and eleven squares J (Sawtooth border).

H. Pattern #13871 – YEL1 (yellow check):

1. Cut three 2⁷/₈" x 21" strips. Crosscut into twenty 2⁷/₈" squares. Label nine squares E (Friendship Star blocks) and eleven squares J (Sawtooth border).

I. Pattern #13871 – RED1 (red check):

1. Cut three 2⁷/₈" x 21" strips. Crosscut into twenty 2⁷/₈" squares. Label nine squares E (Friendship Star blocks) and eleven squares J (Sawtooth border).

J. Pattern #16284 – GRE1 (green daisy print):

1. Cut three 2½" x 21" strips. Crosscut into seventeen 2½" squares (F) for the Friendship Star blocks.

K. Pattern #16285 – BLU1 (blue mini flower print):

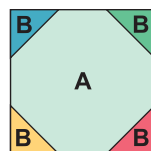
1. Cut five 2⁷/₈" x 42" strips. Crosscut into sixty-eight 2⁷/₈" squares (D) for the Friendship Star blocks.
2. Cut four 2" x 42" strips (H) for the spacer strips.



PIECING INSTRUCTIONS

A. The Snowball Block:

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each of the 2½" blue, green, red and yellow texture B squares.
2. Position a B square of each color on the corners of an A square, right sides together (Figure 1). Arrange colors as shown for each block with the scene of the A square facing up-

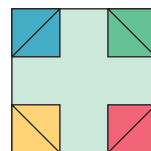
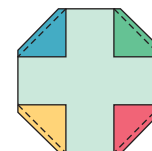
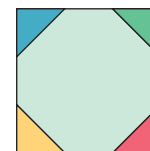

Make 18 Snowball blocks.

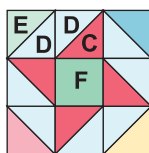


right. Stitch on the line. Trim ¼" away from stitching. Press each seam toward A. Make eighteen blocks.

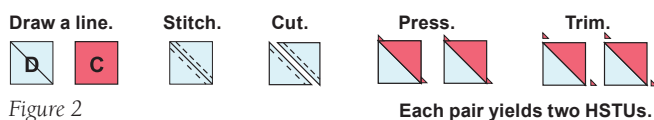
B. The Friendship Star Block:

1. The C/D Half-Square Triangle Units (HSTUs):

- Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the $2\frac{7}{8}$ " D squares (Figure 2).
- Position each D square right sides together with a $2\frac{7}{8}$ " C square. Stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of the drawn line. Cut on the line. Press each unit toward C. Trim the "dog ears". Repeat with the remaining D and C squares to make sixteen each of green, yellow and blue HSTUs, and twenty red HSTUs. (Each pair of C/D squares yields two HSTUs.)



Finished block size: 6" square. Make 4 yellow, 4 blue, 4 green and 5 red star blocks.



- The D/E Half-Square Triangle Units (HSTUs):
 - Follow the directions for the C/D HSTUs to construct the D/E units. Press toward E. Make seventeen HSTUs of each color.

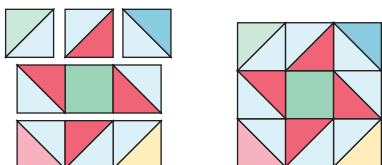


Figure 3 Make 17 Friendship Star blocks.

- For one Friendship Star block, assemble four C/D HSTUs of the same color, four different colored D/E HSTUs and one F square as shown in Figure 3. Position the colors of the D/E units the same in each block. Stitch units together. Press. Make a total of seventeen Friendship Star blocks.

C. The Sawtooth Border:

- Make the I/J HSTUs for the Sawtooth border by following the directions for the C/D HSTUs in the Friendship Star blocks. Pair I (texture) and J (check) squares of the same color to construct the units. Press toward I. Make twenty-one HSTUs of each color.

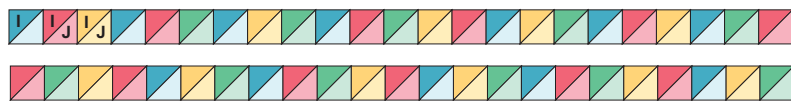


Figure 4 Make two side borders.

- For the side Sawtooth borders, sew two strips of twenty-three HSTUs each with the units positioned as shown in Figure 4, alternating colors as desired. Press seams in one direction.

- For the top and bottom Sawtooth borders, sew two strips of nineteen HSTUs each with the units positioned as shown in Figure 5, alternating colors as desired. Notice the direction of the first unit on the left side of each strip, as shown below. Press seams in one direction.

QUILT ASSEMBLY

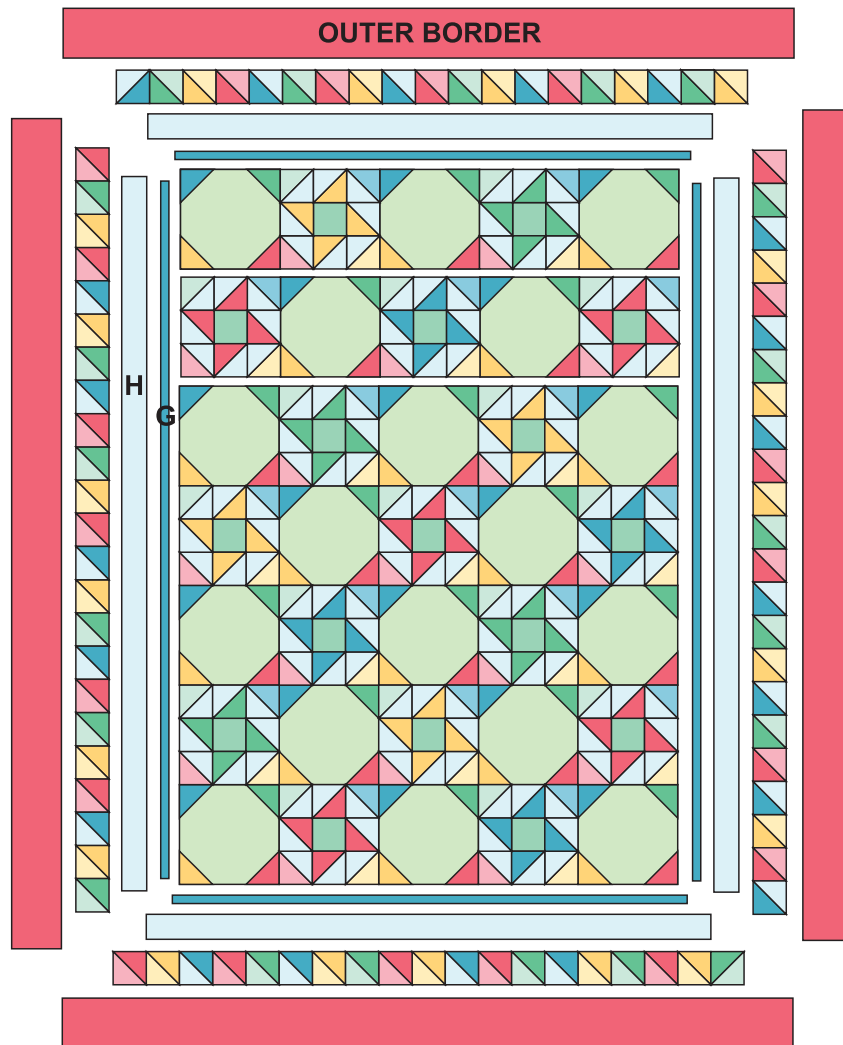


Figure 6



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

Refer to Figure 6 (on next page) for the following steps.

A. The Rows:

- Arrange the Snowball blocks and Friendship Star blocks into seven rows of five blocks each. Alternate blocks as shown.
- Sew blocks into rows. Press seams toward the Snowball blocks in each row.
- Join rows together, matching seams. Press seams in one direction.

B. The Accent Strip and Borders:

- Sew the 1" accent strips (G) together, end to end. Press seams open. Cut two lengths equal to the length of the quilt. Sew to the sides of the quilt. Press toward G. Cut two lengths of G equal to the width of the quilt. Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press toward G.
- Sew the 2" spacer strips (H) together, end to end. Press seams open. Sew to the quilt, following the directions for the accent strip.

C. The Sawtooth Border:

- Arrange the Sawtooth borders around the edges of the quilt in the position shown. Pin the side Sawtooth borders to the quilt and stitch. Press toward H. Repeat with the top and bottom Sawtooth borders. Press toward H.

D. The Outer Border:

- Sew the red outer border strips together, end to end. Sew to the quilt following the directions for the accent strip (G).



FINISHING

1. The backing:
 - a. Prepare the backing with a horizontal seam to measure 49" x 61". Press the seam open.
2. Layer the quilt top, batting and backing.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Trim the batting and backing even with the edges of the quilt top.
5. The binding:
 - a. Join the binding strips with diagonal seams. Press seams open.
 - b. Press binding in half lengthwise, wrong sides together.
 - c. Attach binding to quilt using your favorite method.
6. Make a label and attach it to the back of the quilt.
