DIAGONAL CORNER TECHNIQUE:

This method is used in the piecing directions that follow. Draw a diagonal line on reverse side of a small square. Place right sides together on a larger square or rectangle (Figure a). Stitch on the diagonal line. Trim to a 1/4" seam allowance. Press seam open (Figure b). All seam allowances are 1/4".

MOON APPLIQUÉ BLOCK:

Pattern #17725 – GRE1 (pumpkin toss):

Cut one 10 1/2" square.

Pattern #16277 – GOL1 (dots): Moon.

Pattern #12615 – BLA1 (Tokyo texture):

Letters, eye.

1. Prepare appliqué shapes using your favorite method.
2. Position moon, eye, and letters as shown.
3. Hand or machine appliqué.

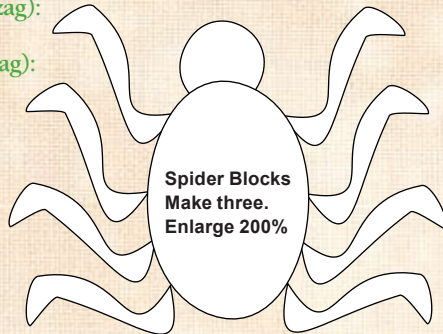
BAT AND SPIDER APPLIQUÉ BLOCKS:

Pattern #16278 – GRE1 (zigzag):

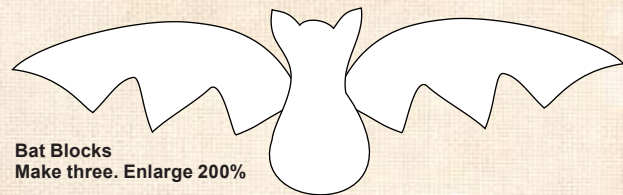
Cut two 5 1/2" squares.

Pattern #16278 – YEL1 (zigzag):

Cut two 5 1/2" squares.

Pattern #17727 – ORA1 (stars):

Cut two 5 1/2" squares.

Pattern #12615 – BLA1 (Tokyo texture):

Bat wings and spider heads.

Pattern #16278 – BLA1 (zigzag):

Bat bodies and spider legs.

Pattern #16277 – BLA1 (dots):

Spider bodies.

1. Prepare 3 bat and 3 spider appliqué shapes.
2. Position bats and spiders on background squares. Refer to photo.
3. Hand or machine appliqué.
4. Embroider the spiders' strings with a Chain Stitch using 3 strands of black embroidery floss.



Finished block size: 5"
Make three each.

PINWHEEL BLOCKS:

Pattern #16277 – DKORA1 (dots):

Cut four 3 1/2" squares (A).

Pattern #16277 – GOL1 (dots):

Cut four 3 1/2" squares (B).

Pattern #17725 – GOL1 (pumpkin toss):

Cut four 3 1/2" squares (C).

Pattern #16278 – BLA1 (zigzag):

Cut one 3 1/2" x 42" strip. Crosscut twelve 3 1/2" squares (D).



Finished block size: 5"
Make two of each color.



1. Draw a diagonal line on wrong side of A, B, and C squares.
2. Pair four A/D, four B/D, and four C/D squares right sides together.
3. Stitch 1/4" away from each side of drawn line (Figure 1).
4. Cut units apart on drawn line (Figure 2). Press seams open. Square up units to 3" (Figure 3). Each pair yields 2 half-square triangle units.

Finished unit size: 3"
Make eight each of A/D, B/D, and C/D.

5. Sew four A/D units together to complete two pinwheel blocks. Press seams in direction of arrows (Figure 4). Repeat with B/D and C/D.

PUMPKIN BLOCKS:

Pattern #17726 – ORA1 (word toss):

Cut one 8 1/2" x 9 1/2" rectangle (A).

Pattern #16278 – YEL1 (zigzag):

Cut one 1 1/2" square (C).

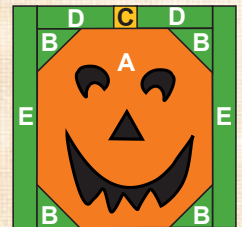
Pattern #17725 – GRE1

(pumpkin toss):

Cut two 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" rectangles (E).

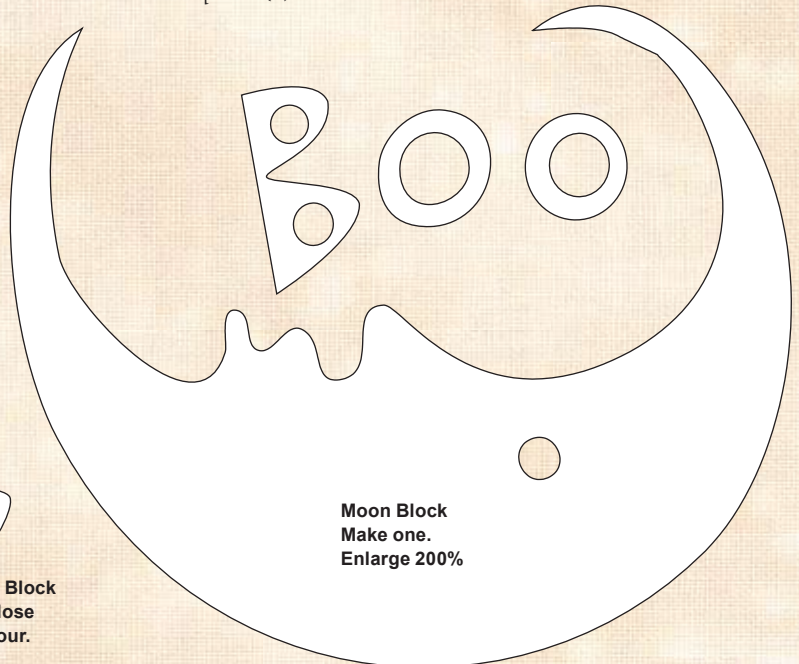
Cut two 1 1/2" x 4" rectangles (D).

Cut four 2 1/2" squares (B).

Pattern #16278 – ORA1 (zigzag):

Cut one 8½" x 9½" rectangle (A).

Pattern #17727 – ORA1 (stars):

Cut one 8½" x 9½" rectangle (A).

Pattern #16278 – GRE1 (zigzag):

Cut two 1½" squares (C).

Pattern #17726 – BEH1 (word toss):

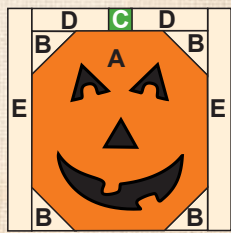
Cut one 1½" x 42" strip. Crosscut four 1½" x 10½" rectangles (E).

Cut one 1½" x 42" strip. Crosscut four 1½" x 4" rectangles (D).

Cut one 2½" x 42" strip. Crosscut eight 2½" squares (B).

Pattern #12615 – BLA1 (Tokyo texture): Eyes, noses, mouths.

1. For all faces, diagonally sew four B squares to the A rectangles (Figure 5). Trim and press seams open.



Side Pumpkin

Finished block size: 10" Make two.

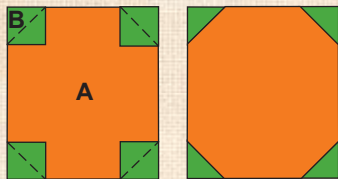

2. Sew two D rectangles to the C square for each pumpkin block (Figure 6). Press seams open.
3. Prepare appliqué shapes and position as shown (Figure 7). Hand or machine appliqué.
4. Sew D/C/D to the top of each unit. Press. Sew an E strip to the sides of each unit. Press.

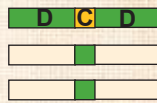
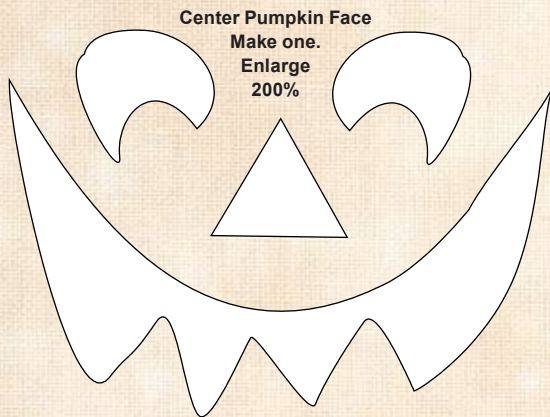

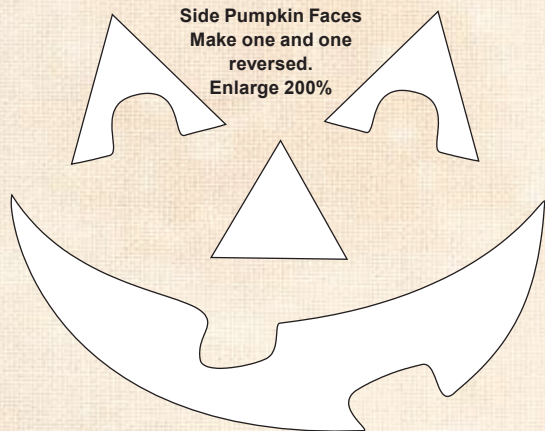


Inner Eye

OWL BLOCKS:

Pattern #16277 – DKORA1 (dots):

Cut two 5½" x 6½" rectangles (A).

Pattern #16278 – BLA1 (zigzag):

Cut eight 3½" squares (B).

Cut two 1" x 3" rectangles (D).

Pattern #17725 – BEI (pumpkin toss):

Cut eight 1¾" squares (C).

Cut four 1" x 1¾" rectangles (E).

Cut four 1" x 3" rectangles (H).

Cut four 3" x 9½" rectangles (I).

Cut two 1½" x 10½" rectangles (J).

Pattern #16277 – BLA1 (dots):

Cut two 3" x 5½" rectangles (F).

Pattern #16278 – ORA1 (zigzag):

Cut four 2½" x 3" rectangles (G).

Pattern #17725 – GOL1 (pumpkin toss): Eyes.

Pattern #12615 – BLA1 (Tokyo texture): Eyes.

1. Diagonally sew four B squares to each A rectangle (Figure 8). Trim and press seams open.

2. Diagonally sew four C squares to the A/B units (Figure 9). Trim and press seams open.

3. Sew two E rectangles to one D rectangle (Figure 10). Press seams open. Sew E/D/E to the top of A/B/C (Figure 11). Press toward E/D/E.

4. Sew H and G rectangles together (Figure 12). Press seams open.

5. Diagonally sew an H/G unit to the left side of each F rectangle (Figure 13). Press toward H/G. Repeat with remaining H/G units on opposite end (Figure 14).

6. Sew head units to the body units. Press toward the body.

7. Sew one I rectangle to each side of the owl units. Press toward I.

- Sew J rectangles to top of each unit. Press toward J.

8. Hand or machine appliqué eyes.

STANDING CAT BLOCKS:

Pattern #16277 – BLA1 (dots):

Cut two 1½" x 42" strips. Crosscut eight 1½" squares (D),

two 1½" x 3" rectangles (L),

two 1½" x 7¾" rectangles (E), and

two 1½" x 9½" rectangles (G).

Cut two 3¾" x 4¾" rectangles (A).

Cut two 3¾" squares (I).

Pattern #17724 – GRE1 (owl toss):

Cut two 1½" x 42" strips. Crosscut ten 1½" squares (B),

two 1½" x 3¼" rectangles (J),

two 1½" x 7" rectangles (K), and

two 1½" x 10½" rectangles (M).

Cut two 4½" x 4¾" rectangles (C).

Cut two 2¼" x 5¾" rectangles (F).

Cut two 3¼" x 5¾" rectangles (H).

1. Diagonally sew two B squares to the A rectangles (Figure 15). Diagonally sew two D squares to the C rectangles (Figure 16). Diagonally sew two B squares to the I squares (Figure 17). Press seams open.

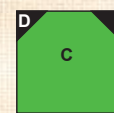
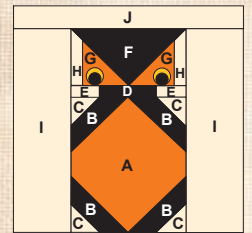

2. Diagonally sew B squares to the E rectangles. Make one left and one right (Figure 18). Diagonally sew D squares to the H rectangles. Make one left and one right (Figure 19). Diagonally sew D squares to the J rectangles. Make one left and one right (Figure 20). Press seams open.

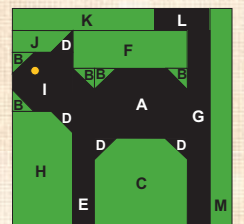

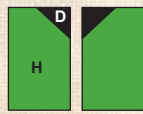

- Sew K and L rectangles together (Figure 21). Press seams open. Make two.
- Sew a B/A unit to each D/C unit (Figure 22). Press seam toward B/A. Make two.
- Sew B/E units to body unit (Figure 23). Make one left and one right. Press toward B/E. Sew an F rectangle to the top and a G rectangle to the side of each body unit. Press toward F and G.
- Sew B/I units to D/H and D/J units (Figure 24). Press toward D/H and D/J.

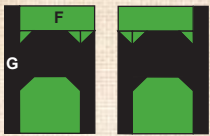

- Sew head units to body units. Press seams toward body. Sew K/L to top of each unit. Press seams toward K/L. Sew M to side of each unit. Press seams open.

CENTER CAT BLOCK:

Pattern #16278 – BLA1 (zigzag):

Cut one 6½" x 7½" rectangle (A), two 2½" squares (D), and one 2½" x 7½" rectangle (F).

Pattern #17724 – BEI1 (owl toss):

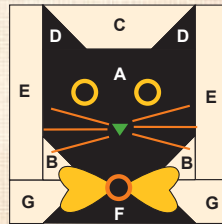
Cut two 2½" squares (B), one 2½" x 7½" rectangle (C), two 2" x 8½" rectangles (E), and two 2½" x 4" rectangles (G).

Pattern #17725 – GRE1 (pumpkin toss):

Pattern #17725 – GOL1 (pumpkin toss):

Pattern #12615 – BLA1 (Tokyo texture):

- Diagonally sew two B squares to the A rectangle (Figure 25). Trim and press seams open.
- Diagonally sew two D squares to the C rectangle (Figure 26). Trim and press seams open.
- Sew D/C/D to the top of B/A/B (Figure 27). Press seam toward B/A. Sew E rectangles to each side of the head unit (Figure 28). Press toward E.
- Diagonally sew two G rectangles to the F rectangle (Figure 29). Press seams open.
- Sew unit G/F/G to the bottom of head unit.
- Embroider the cats' whiskers with the Stem Stitch using three strands of orange embroidery floss.
- Appliqué the eyes and nose.

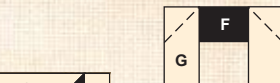

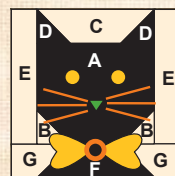
CORNER CAT BLOCKS:

Pattern #16277 – BLA1 (dots):

Cut four 3½" x 4" rectangles (A), eight 1½" squares (D), and four 1½" x 4" rectangles (F).

Pattern #17727 – BEI1 (stars):

Cut eight 1½" squares (B), four 1½" x 4" rectangles (C), eight 1¼" x 4½" rectangles (E), and eight 1½" x 2½" rectangles (G).



Finished block size: 5"
Make four.

Pattern #17725 – GRE1 (pumpkin toss):

- Repeat Center Cat Block instructions to make four corner cat blocks.

Note: The corner cats' eyes are buttons. See FINISHING: 5.d.

ASSEMBLY:

Pattern #17726 – BLA1 (word toss):

Cut two 1½" x 40½" strips (side inner border).
Cut two 1½" x 32½" strips (top and bottom inner border).

Pattern #17724 – ORA1 (owl toss):

Cut two 5½" x 42½" strips (side outer border).
Cut two 5½" x 32½" strips (top and bottom outer border).

- Sew the blocks together in rows as follows (Figure 30). Press seams in opposing directions.
Row 1 - two owls and one moon.
Row 2 - two bats, one spider, three pinwheels.
Row 3 - two standing cats and center cat.
Row 4 - two spiders, one bat, three pinwheels.
Row 5 - three pumpkins.
- Sew rows together, matching seams. Press.
- Sew two 1½" x 40½" strips to the sides of the quilt top. Press toward border strips.
- Sew two 1½" x 32½" strips to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Press toward border strips.
- Sew two 5½" x 42½" strips to the sides of the quilt top. Press toward outer border strips.
- Sew corner cat blocks to the 5½" x 32½" strips. Press toward strips. Sew to top and bottom of quilt. Press toward outer border strips.

FINISHING:

Pattern #16278 – GRE1 (zigzag):

Binding:
Cut as many 2½" bias strips as needed to equal at least 204" for the binding.

Pattern #16278 – YEL1 (zigzag):

Bow ties:
Cut one 4½" square for large cat block.
Cut four 3" squares for corner cat blocks.

- Prepare backing with a horizontal seam to measure 48" x 58".
- Layer backing, batting and quilt top. Baste layers together.
- Hand or machine quilt.
- Join binding strips with diagonal seams. Press seams open. Bind using your favorite method.
- Embellishing:
 - Fold the large and small bow tie fabrics in half with right sides together. Sew around all edges leaving 1" opening in the middle of the longest edge (Figure 31). Turn right side out.
 - With needle and thread, gather the center of the rectangles. Sew a double-stacked 1" orange and ½" black button on each bow tie at the center of the five cat blocks.
 - Sew one ⅜" gold button for eye on each standing cat.
 - Sew two ⅜" gold buttons for eyes on each corner cat.
