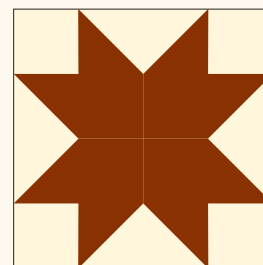
Finished Size: 77" x 77"



All fabrics are from the Isabella Collection by Red Rooster Fabrics.

Fabric Requirements:

Pattern #13789 BRO1	3/8 yard, for star centers
Pattern #13789 RED1	3/8 yard, for star centers
Pattern #13789 DkBLU1	3/8 yard, for star centers
Pattern #13790 BEI1	5 1/2 yards, for backing and sleeve
Pattern #13791 RED1	2 1/4 yards, for outer border
Pattern #13793 BRO1	1 7/8 yards, for sashing, first border, and binding
Pattern #13794 BEI1	1 yard, for 6" squares
Pattern #13795 BRO1	5/8 yard, for star points
Pattern #13795 RED1	7/8 yard, for star points
Pattern #13795 DkBLU1	5/8 yard, for star points
Pattern #13796 LtBRO1	1 1/8 yards, for background of brown star blocks
Pattern #13796 GRE1	1 1/8 yards, for background of red star blocks
Pattern #13796 ROS1	1 1/8 yards, for background of blue star blocks



Star Block

Cutting Instructions:

A. Pattern #13789 (*large floral*)

1. BRO1:
 - a. Cut four 6 1/2" squares for star centers in 12" block.
 - b. Cut eight 3 1/2" squares for star centers in 6" block.
2. RED1:
 - a. Cut five 6 1/2" squares for star centers in 12" block.
 - b. Cut eight 3 1/2" squares for star centers in 6" block.
3. DKBLU1:
 - a. Cut four 6 1/2" squares for star centers in 12" block.
 - b. Cut eight 3 1/2" squares for star centers in 6" block.

B. Pattern #13790 (*small floral*)

1. BEI1:
 - a. Cut two 8 1/2" x 42" strips for sleeve.
 - b. Backing, 83" x 83" (*see Finishing*).

C. Pattern #13791 (*border stripe*)

1. RED1:
 - a. Cut four 6 3/4" x 77" strips for second border.

D. Pattern #13793 (*small paisley*)

1. BRO1:
 - a. Cut two 1 1/4" x 65" strips for sides of first border.
 - b. Cut six 1 1/4" x 63 1/2" strips for sashing between rows and top and bottom of first border.
 - c. Cut five 2 1/2" strips x length of fabric for binding.
 - d. Cut twenty 1 1/4" x 12 1/2" strips for sashing.

E. Pattern #13794 (*toile*)

1. BEI1:
 - a. Cut twenty-four 6 1/2" squares, for alternate block.



F. Pattern #13795 (*tone-on-tone*)

1. BRO1:

- Cut three $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42" strips. Crosscut into thirty-two $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares for star points in 12" blocks.
- Cut four 2" x 42" strips. Crosscut into sixty-four 2" squares for star points in 6" blocks.

2. RED1:

- Cut four $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42" strips. Crosscut into forty $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares for star points in 12" blocks.
- Cut four 2" x 42" strips. Crosscut into sixty-four 2" squares for star points in 6" blocks.

3. DKBLU1:

- Cut three $3\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Crosscut into thirty-two $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares for star points in 12" blocks.
- Cut four 2" x 42" strips. Crosscut into sixty-four 2" squares for star points in 6" blocks.

G. Pattern #13796 (*small print*)

1. LT BRO1:

- Cut two $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42" strips. Crosscut into sixteen $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares for background in large brown floral 12" blocks.
- Cut two 2" x 42" strips. Crosscut into thirty-two 2" squares for background in large brown floral 6" blocks.
- Cut three $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42" strips. Crosscut into sixteen $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles for background in large brown floral 12" blocks.
- Cut three 2" x 42" strips. Crosscut into thirty-two 2" x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles for background in large brown floral 6" blocks.

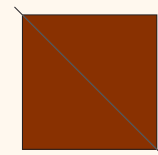

2. GRE1:

- Cut two $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42" strips. Crosscut into twenty $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares for background in red 12" star blocks.
- Cut two 2" x 42" strips. Crosscut into thirty-two 2" squares for background in red 6" star blocks.
- Cut four $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42" strips. Crosscut into twenty $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles for background in red 12" star blocks.
- Cut three 2" x 42" strips. Crosscut into thirty-two 2" x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles for background in red 6" star blocks.

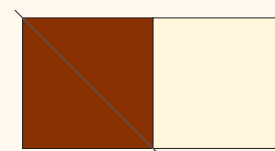

3. ROS1:

- Cut two $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42" strips. Crosscut into sixteen $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares for background in blue 12" star blocks.
- Cut two 2" x 42" strips. Crosscut into thirty-two 2" squares for background in blue 6" star blocks.
- Cut three $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42" strips. Crosscut into sixteen $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles for background in blue 12" star blocks.
- Cut three 2" x 42" strips. Crosscut into thirty-two 2" x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles for background in blue 6" star blocks.

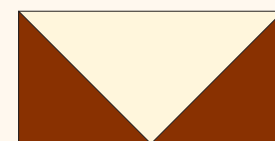

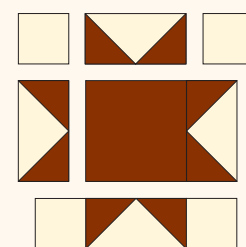

Block Construction:

Make 13 Large Star Blocks – 4 Brown, 5 Red and 4 Blue – Finished Size: 12" x 12"

Make 24 Small Star Blocks – 8 Brown, 8 Red and 8 Blue – Finished Size: 6" x 6"

- Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each of the $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares (*for the 12" block star points*) and each of the 2" squares (*for the 6" block star points*) as shown in Figure 1.
- Sew one $3\frac{1}{2}$ " star point to one $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " background rectangle on drawn diagonal line for all 12"

brown tone-on-tone sew to brown small print, blue tone-on-tone sew to rose small print, and red tone-on-tone sew to green small print. Sew a 2" star point to one 2" x 3 1/2" background rectangle on drawn diagonal line for all 6" blocks, following same color combinations as in 12" blocks, as in Figure 2. Press. Trim excess fabric from middle. Repeat on opposite corner. Make four, as in Figure 3, for each block in the quilt.

3. Sew thirteen 12" blocks using four 3 1/2" background squares in each corner, four 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles, as in Figure 3, and one 6 1/2" square for center of block. Sew all blocks together as shown in Figure 4. Press all seams well. Repeat above to sew twenty-four 6" blocks using four 2" background squares in each corner, four 2" x 3 1/2" rectangles, as in Figure 3, and one 3 1/2" square for center of block. Press all seams well.

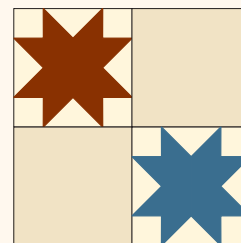

4. Alternate Blocks: Sew twenty-four Alternate blocks, as in Figure 5, using two 6" star blocks and two 6" beige toile squares. Follow color combinations for blocks needed as shown in sample quilt.

Quilt Construction:

1. Join the blocks together, alternating the blocks with the 1 1/4" x 12" small brown paisley sashing strips (Figure 6). Press seams toward sashing.
2. Sashing and first border: Sew one 1 1/4" x 63 1/2" small brown paisley sashing strip between each block row and one 1 1/4" x 63 1/2" small brown paisley sashing strip to the top and bottom of the quilt for the first border. Press.
3. First Border: Sew one 1 1/4" x 65" small brown paisley strip to each side of the quilt to complete the first border. Press.
4. Second Border: Mark the center of each second border strip of the red border stripe. Mark the center of each side of the quilt. Sew one 6 3/4" x 77" strip of red border stripe to each side of quilt matching marked centers. Miter each corner using your favorite method.

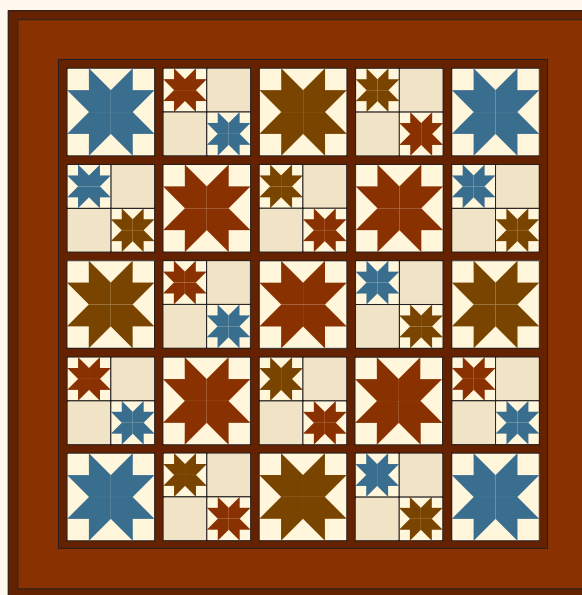

Finishing:

1. Prepare backing with vertical seams to measure 83" x 83".
2. Layer quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste layers together. Hand or machine quilt as desired.
3. Join binding strips. Apply binding using your favorite method.
4. Make a hanging sleeve from the two 8 1/2" x 42" strips and attach to the top of the back of the quilt.
