

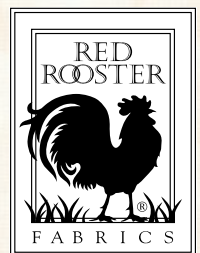
O' Snowy Night

Finished quilt size: 61" x 68"

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FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:

A. Pattern #19907 – MUL1	3/4 yard
B. Pattern #19913 – BLU1	1/8 yard
C. Pattern #19913 – RED1	1/4 yard
D. Pattern #19913 – GRE1	1/4 yard
E. Pattern #19910 – LTBLU1	3/8 yard
F. Pattern #19914 – BLU1	1/2 yard
G. Pattern #19909 – BLU1	1/2 yard
H. Pattern #19914 – GRE1	1/2 yard
I. Pattern #19912 – LTBLU1	1/2 yard
J. Pattern #19908 – MUL1	2 1/4 yards
K. Pattern #19914 – RED1	5/8 yard (binding)
L. Pattern #19913 – GOL1	4 yards (backing)
Batting.....	67" x 74"

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. 1/4" seam allowance is included in measurements and all strips are cut across the width of the fabric unless noted otherwise. Cut fabrics in order given.

A. Pattern #19907 – MUL1 (scenic):

1. Fussy cut one 18 1/2" square.

B. Pattern #19913 – BLU1 (plaid):

1. Cut two 1 1/2" strips, subcut into two 1 1/2" x 18 1/2" lengths and two 1 1/2" x 20 1/2" lengths.

C. Pattern #19913 – RED1 (plaid):

1. Cut two 3" strips; subcut into twenty 3" squares.

D. Pattern #19913 – GRE1 (plaid):

1. Cut two 3" strips; subcut into twenty 3" squares.

E. Pattern #19910 – LTBLU1 (animal toss):

1. Cut four 6 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles.
2. Cut two 2 1/2" strips; subcut twelve 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles and eight 2 1/2" squares.

F. Pattern #19914 – BLU1 (trees):

1. Cut five 2 1/2" strips; subcut eight 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles, eight 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles, eight 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles and eight 2 1/2" squares.

G. Pattern #19909 – BLU1 (snowman toss):

1. Cut four 10 1/2" squares.

H. Pattern #19914 – GRE1 (trees):

1. Cut eleven 1 1/2" strips. Sew together end-to-end and press seams open. Use to cut two 1 1/2" x 46" strips, four 1 1/2" x 52" strips and two 1 1/2" x 60" strips.

I. Pattern #19912 – LTBLU1 (garland stripe):

1. Cut six 2 1/2" strips. Sew together end-to-end and press seams open. Use to cut two 2 1/2" x 52" strips, and two 2 1/2" x 60" strips.

J. Pattern #19908 – MUL1 (border stripe):

1. Cut four 6 3/4" strips on the length of the fabric, centering the snowman motifs within each strip. From the remaining animal stripes, cut two 4" x 40 1/2", centering motifs within each strip.

K. Pattern #19914 – RED1 (trees):

1. Cut seven 2 1/2" strips for binding.

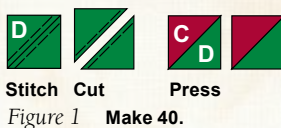
PIECING INSTRUCTIONS:

A. Frame the scenic print center square with the blue plaid:

1. Sew a 1 1/2" x 18 1/2" [B] strip to each side of the 18 1/2" [A] square. Sew a 1 1/2" x 20 1/2" [B] strip to the top and bottom of the [A] square. Press toward the strips.
- B. Make forty half-square triangle units using the red and green plaid:
 1. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of each 3" [D] square. Place marked squares right sides together with 3" [C] squares.

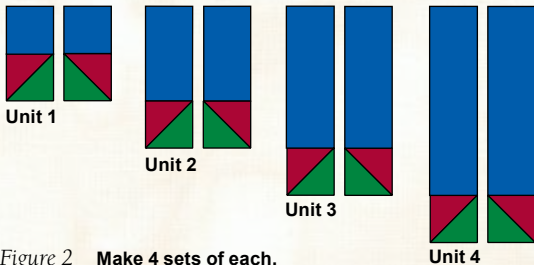


2. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the drawn line; cut apart on the line and press. Trim triangle units to $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square.

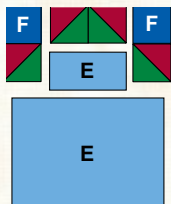


- C. Make four $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x $20\frac{1}{2}$ " stair step blocks for the sides of the center square:

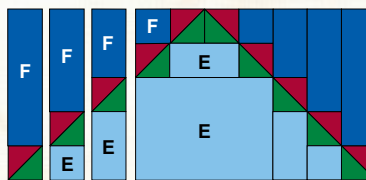
1. Sew a triangle unit from above to the end of each [F] rectangle and $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares to make *step units*. Position triangle units as shown in diagram. Press toward [F]. Make four and four reverse of each set.



2. Sew two of the remaining triangle units together as shown; press. Sew to an [E] $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle; press toward [E] rectangle. Sew a Unit 1 from Figure 1 to each side and press toward Unit 1.
3. Sew an [E] $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to bottom of the unit from step 2; press toward [E] rectangle. Make four units.
4. Sew the remaining [E] $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles to each Unit 2 strip. Press toward [E]. Make eight. Sew the remaining [E] $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares to each Unit 3 strip. Press toward [E]. Make eight.



5. Sew all units together as shown in Figure 4 and press. Make four side units.



- D. Sew a side unit to each side of the framed center square. Press toward center square. Sew a [G] $10\frac{1}{2}$ " square to each end of the remaining side units. Press toward the squares. Sew to the top and bottom of the center square.
- E. Sew a [J] 4 " x $40\frac{1}{2}$ " animal stripe to the top and bottom of the center. Press toward [J].

QUILT ASSEMBLY:

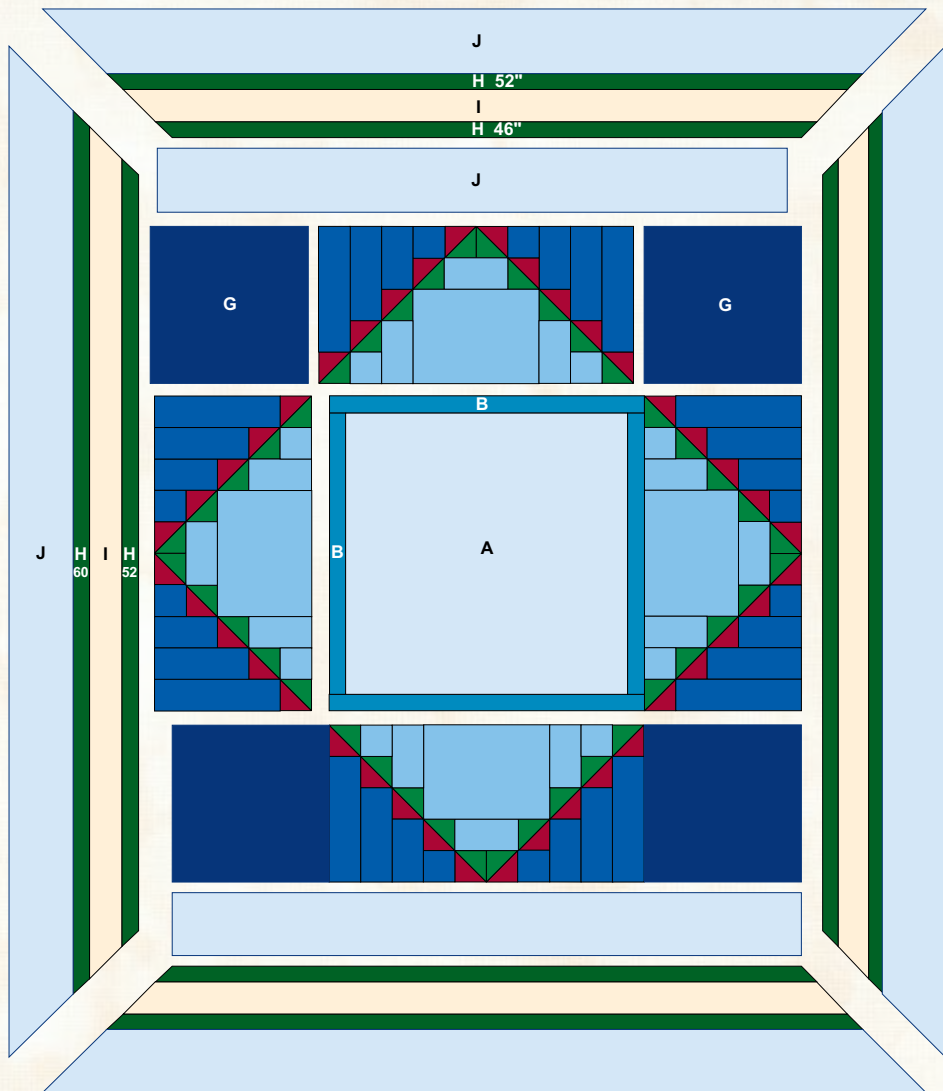
**Note that all border strips are first sewn together and then mitered with one seam.*

- A. Sew border strips [H, I, H, J] into four strip sets, matching centers of each strip. Press seams toward outer border.
- B. Center a side border set to one side of the quilt center. Sew border to quilt, beginning and ending a generous $\frac{1}{4}$ " from edge of quilt. Repeat for remaining side of quilt. Sew top and bottom borders to quilt in the same manner.
- C. Close corners with mitered seams. Trim seam allowances and press seams open. Press border seams toward borders

FINISHING:

- A. Prepare backing with a horizontal seam to measure 67 " x 74 ". Press seam open.
- B. Layer quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste layers together.
- C. Quilt as desired.
- D. Trim the batting and backing even with quilt top.
- E. Sew binding strips together and press seams open. Sew binding to quilt using your favorite method.
