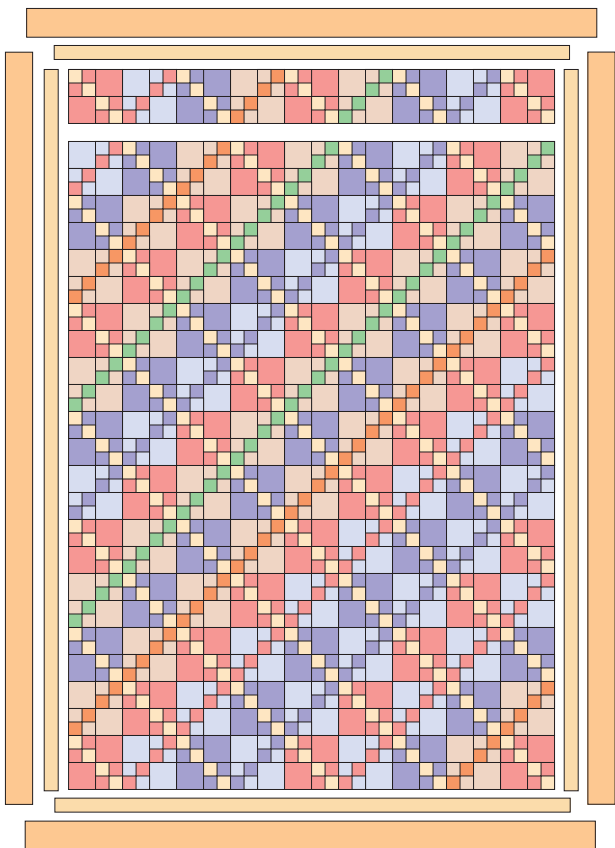


- E. Flat Piping: Make two strips measuring $1\frac{1}{8}$ " x $92\frac{1}{2}$ ". Press in half wrong sides together. Baste to each side edge of the quilt. Make two strips measuring $1\frac{1}{8}$ " x $68\frac{1}{2}$ ". Press in half wrong sides together. Baste to top and bottom edge of quilt.
- F. Bias Binding: Sew together the $2\frac{1}{2}$ " bias strips using diagonal seams until binding measures 340". Apply binding to quilt top using your favorite method.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Pattern #15932 – RED1.....	3 yards
15933 – PEA1.....	1 yard (bias binding)
15934 – PEA1.....	5½ yards (backing)
15935 – ORA1.....	½ yard
15935 – LTGRE1.....	¼ yard
15935 – BLU1.....	¼ yard
15935 – RED1.....	¼ yard
15936 – BLU1.....	½ yard
15936 – RED1.....	½ yard
15937 – RED1.....	1½ yards
15937 – BLU1.....	1 yard
15939 – PIN1.....	1 yard
15939 – BLU1.....	1 yard
Batting.....	74" x 98"

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS *Cut fabrics in order given.*

A. Pattern #15932 – RED1 (large floral print):

1. Top and Bottom Outer Borders: Cut four 5½" strips x width of fabric centering large floral design. Reserve for top and bottom outer borders.
2. Side Outer Borders: Cut two 5½" strips x length of fabric centering large floral design. Reserve for side outer borders.

B. Pattern #15933 – PEA1 (floral stripe):

1. Bias Binding: Cut one 33½" square. Cut enough 2½" strips across bias to equal 340" when sewn.

C. Pattern #15935 – ORA1 (tone on tone):

1. Cut three 2" x 42" strips. Crosscut into sixty 2" squares.
2. Cut eight 1⅛" x 42" strips for flat piping.

D. Pattern #15935 – LTGRE1 (tone on tone):

1. Cut three 2" x 42" strips. Crosscut into sixty 2" squares.

E. Pattern #15935 – BLU1 (tone on tone):

1. Cut three 2" x 42" strips. Crosscut into fifty-six 2" squares.

F. Pattern #15935 – RED1 (tone on tone):

1. Cut three 2" x 42" strips. Crosscut into fifty-six 2" squares.

G. Pattern #15936 – BLU1 (small light floral):

1. Cut six 2" x 42" strips. Crosscut into one hundred twenty 2" squares.

H. Pattern #15936 – RED1 (small light floral):

1. Cut six 2" x 42" strips. Crosscut into one hundred sixteen 2" squares.

I. Pattern #15937 – RED1 (medium jacquard rose print):

1. Inner Border: Cut seven 2½" x 42" strips. Reserve for inner border.
2. Cut six 2" x 42" strips. Crosscut into one hundred twenty 2" squares.
3. Cut five 3½" x 42" strips. Crosscut into sixty 3½" squares.

J. Pattern #15937 – BLU1 (medium jacquard rose print):

1. Cut six 2" x 42" strips. Crosscut into one hundred twelve 2" squares.
2. Cut five 3½" x 42" strips. Crosscut into fifty-six 3½" squares.

K. Pattern #15939 – PIN1 (medium flower dark ground):

1. Cut six 2" x 42" strips. Crosscut into one hundred twenty 2" squares.
2. Cut five 3½" x 42" strips. Crosscut into sixty 3½" squares.



L. Pattern #15939 – BLU1 (medium flower dark ground):

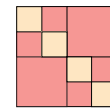
1. Cut six 2" x 42" strips. Crosscut into one hundred sixteen 2" squares.
2. Cut five 3½" x 42" strips. Crosscut into fifty-eight 3½" squares.

PIECING THE BLOCKS

(Read through all of the piecing instructions before you begin.)

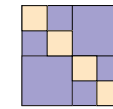
A. Double 4-Patches:

Finished Block Size: 6".



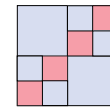
Make 30.

with #15936-BLU1



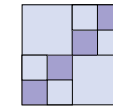
Make 29.

with #15936-RED1



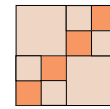
Make 14.

with #15935-RED1



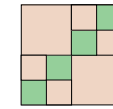

1. For each Double 4-Patch block sew together four 2" squares to make one four-patch unit, as in Figure 1. Make two four-patch units per block. Press toward the darker fabric.
2. Sew each 4-patch unit to a 3½" square. Sew block together (Figure 2). Press seams toward the 3½" square.
3. Repeat to make 117 Double 4-Patch blocks, following the specified number (above) for each color combination.

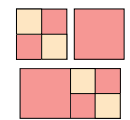

QUILT ASSEMBLY

1. Lay out blocks in rows following the color arrangement indicated in the quilt. Sew the blocks together in rows, pressing seams in one direction. Alternate the directions of the seams in each row.
2. Inner borders: Sew strips together to make two 2½" x 78½" strips for side borders. Sew to sides of quilt. Sew strips to make two 2½" x 58½" strips for top and bottom borders. Sew to top and bottom of quilt. Press all seams toward borders.
3. Outer Borders: Trim length of 5½" x length of grain strip to 5½" x 82½". Sew to sides of quilt. Press seams toward outer border. Sew together strips for top and bottom borders. Trim to measure 5½" x 68½". Sew to top and bottom of quilt. Press seams toward outer border.

FINISHING

1. Prepare backing with vertical seam to measure 74" x 98". Press seam in one direction.
2. Layer quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Trim the batting and backing even with the quilt top.
