FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:

Pattern #19046 – BE11	1/2 yard
19047 – NAV1	2 1/4 yards
19048 – CRE1	3/8 yard
19049 – DKBLU1	7/8 yard
	(includes 2/3 yard for binding)
19049 – CRE1	3/8 yard
19049 – DKGRE1	1/4 yard
19049 – GRE1	1 1/4 yards
19049 – PIN1	1/2 yard
19049 – YEL1	3/4 yard
19050 – LTBE11	1 3/8 yards
19050 – SAG1	1/4 yard
19051 – CRE1	1/3 yard
19052 – YEL/CRE1	7/8 yard
Backing	4 1/2 yards
	fabric of choice
Batting	78" square

Additional Supplies:

Fusible web 2 3/4 yards

PREPARATION FOR APPLIQUÉ:

1. Trace the templates onto the paper side of fusible web. Follow directions for tracing vines and leaves.
2. Rough-cut around the shapes.
3. Fuse the shapes to the wrong side of fabrics as directed in the Cutting Instructions.
4. Cut out shapes on the line. Remove paper backing.

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

A. Pattern #19046 – BE11 (large print):

1. Cut one 4 1/2" x 42" strip. Crosscut four 4 1/2" squares. Label Q for the Chain Block.
2. Cut two 2 1/2" x 42" strips. Crosscut thirty-two 2 1/2" squares. Label S for the Chain Block.
3. Cut one 4 1/4" x 42" strip. Crosscut five 4 1/4" squares. Cut each square in half twice on the diagonal. Label C for the Flower Block.

B. Pattern #19047 – NAV1 (border stripe):

1. Cut four identical strips, 7 1/8" x length of fabric, for the outer border (Border #4).

C. Pattern #19048 – CRE1 (narrow stripe):

1. Cut four 2 1/2" x 42" strips for Border #1.

D. Pattern #19049 – DKBLU1 (dots):

1. Cut eight 2 1/2" x 42" strips for binding.

2. Cut eighty-four blueberries for the appliqué border (Border #2).

E. Pattern #19049 – CRE1 (dots):

1. Cut one 8 1/2" x 42" strip. Crosscut sixteen 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles. Label T for the Chain Block.

F. Pattern #19049 – DKGRE1 (dots):

1. Cut five 4 1/4" squares. Cut each square in half twice on the diagonal. Label D for the Flower Block.

G. Pattern #19049 – GRE1 (dots):

1. Cut four 40 1/2" vines for the appliqué border, following the directions given on the template page.
2. Cut thirty-two leaves from the leaf template and thirty-two leaves from the reverse image of the template for the appliqué border.

H. Pattern #19049 – PIN1 (dots):

1. Cut five flowers for the Flower Block.
2. Cut four heart petals for the appliqué Corner Squares.

I. Pattern #19049 – YEL1 (dots):

1. Cut one 7 1/4" x 42" strip. Crosscut twenty 2" x 7 1/4" rectangles. Cut a 45° angle off the ends of each rectangle as shown. (Use the 45° angle line on an acrylic ruler.) Label A for the Flower Block.



2. Cut six 2" x 42" strips for Border #3.
3. Cut five flower centers for the Flower Block.

J. Pattern #19050 – LTBE11 (swirls):

1. Cut two 9" x 42" strips. Crosscut five 9" squares. Label E for the Flower Block.
2. Cut three 8 1/2" x 42" strips. Crosscut twelve 8 1/2" squares for the applique border.

K. Pattern #19050 – SAG1 (swirls):

1. Cut one 4 1/2" x 42" strip. Crosscut sixteen 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles. Label R for the Chain Block.

L. Pattern #19051 – CRE1 (tossed fruit):

1. Cut one 7 1/4" x 42" strip. Crosscut twenty 2" x 7 1/4" rectangles. Cut a 45° angle off the ends of each rectangle as shown for rectangle A. Label B for the Flower Block



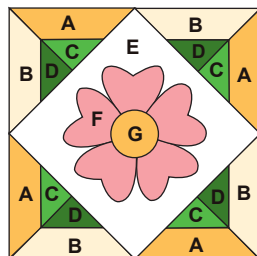
M. Pattern #19052 – YEL/CRE1 (scenic toile):

1. Cut three 8 1/2" x 42" strips. Crosscut twelve 8 1/2" squares for the appliqué border.

PIECING INSTRUCTIONS: Seam allowance is 1/4" unless noted.

A. Flower Block:

1. Sew a C triangle to A, matching centers. Press toward A. Make twenty.
2. Sew a D triangle to B, matching centers. Press toward D. Make twenty.
3. Sew A/C to B/D, matching seams. Press. Make twenty.
4. Fuse F to E. Machine applique in place. Make five.
5. Fuse G to F. Machine applique in place. Repeat to complete five flowers.
6. Sew the triangular A/B units to each side of the flower unit, matching centers. Press. Repeat to complete five Flower Blocks.



Flower Block
Finished block size:
12" square. Make 5.

B. Chain Block:

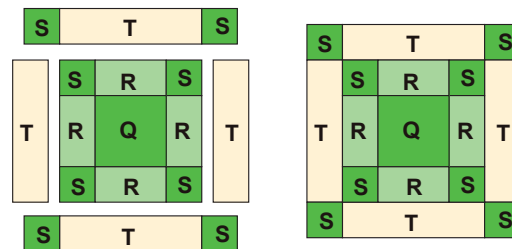


Figure 1 Finished block size: 12" square. Make 4.

1. Sew the pieces for each block together as shown in Figure 1. Press toward Q and S. Make five Chain Blocks.

C. Applique Border Strips (Border #3):

1. Sew three 8½" swirl squares to two 8½" scenic toile squares, alternating fabrics (Figure 2). Press toward the toile. Make four.

2. Fuse one vine, fourteen leaves, and eighteen blueberries to each applique border strip. (Refer to quilt photo for placement.)
3. Machine appliqué the shapes in place using your favorite method.

D. Corner Squares:

1. Referring to the quilt photo, fuse one heart petal, two leaves and three blueberries to each Corner Square.
2. Machine appliqué in place.

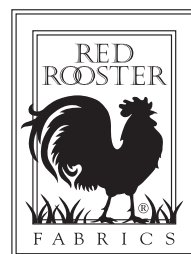
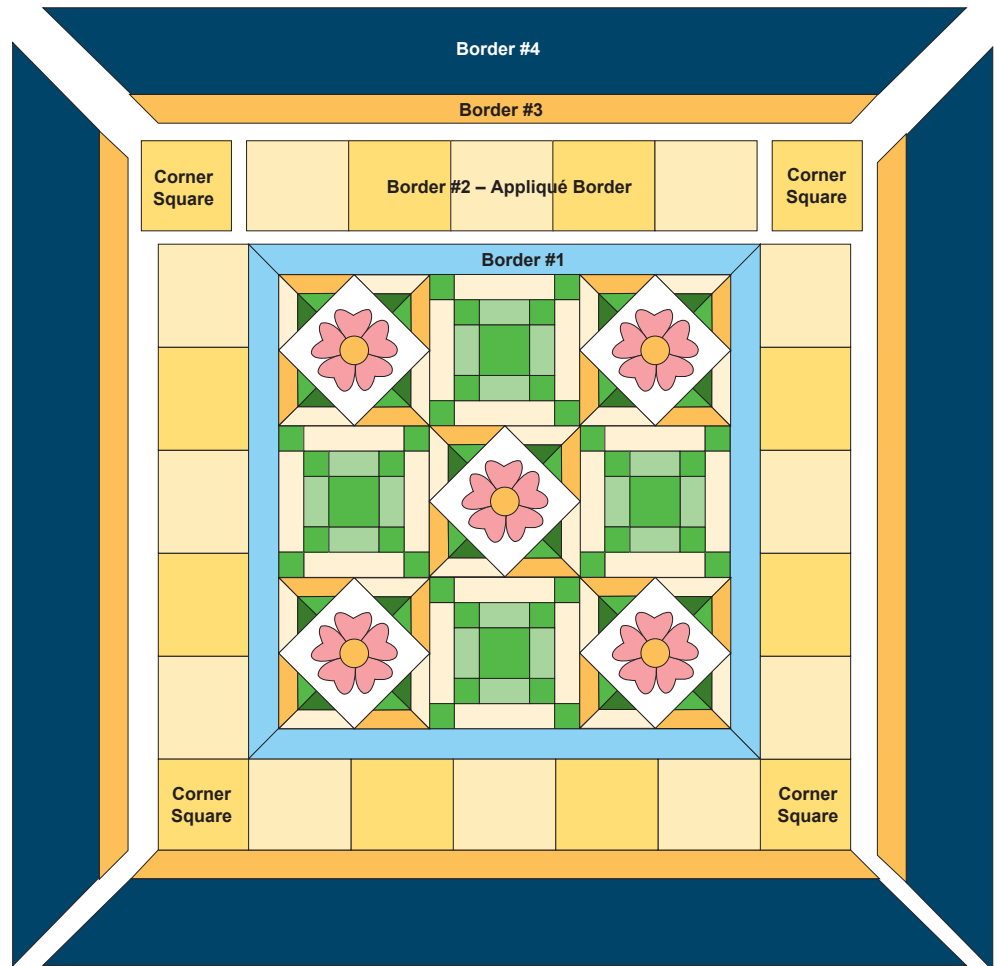
ASSEMBLY: Refer to quilt photo and Quilt Diagram.

1. Arrange three rows of three blocks each, alternating Flower Blocks and Chain Blocks.
2. Sew blocks together. Press toward the Chain Blocks.
3. Sew rows together. Press.
4. Border #1:
Sew a 2½" narrow stripe strip to each side of the quilt, matching centers. Start and stop sewing ¼" from each corner. Miter corners. Press.
5. Border #2:
 - a. Sew an appliquéd border strip to opposite sides of the quilt making sure that the leaves are facing in the correct direction. Press.
 - b. Sew a Corner Square to each end of the two remaining appliqué strips. Position the squares as shown in the photo. Sew the strips to the top and bottom of the quilt, matching seams. Press.
6. Borders #3 and #4:
 - a. Sew the six 2" gold strips together, end to end. Press seams open. Cut the joined strips into four equal lengths.

- b. Sew a gold strip to the cream side of each 7⅛" border stripe, matching centers. Press toward the gold strip.
- c. Sew the gold side of the border unit to each side of the quilt, matching centers. Start and stop sewing ¼" from each corner. Miter corners. Press.

FINISHING:

1. Prepare backing to measure 78" square. Press seam(s) open.
2. Layer quilt top, batting, and backing.
3. Baste layers together.
4. Quilt as desired.
5. Trim layers even with quilt top.
6. Join binding strips with diagonal seams. Press seams open. Attach binding to quilt using your favorite method.



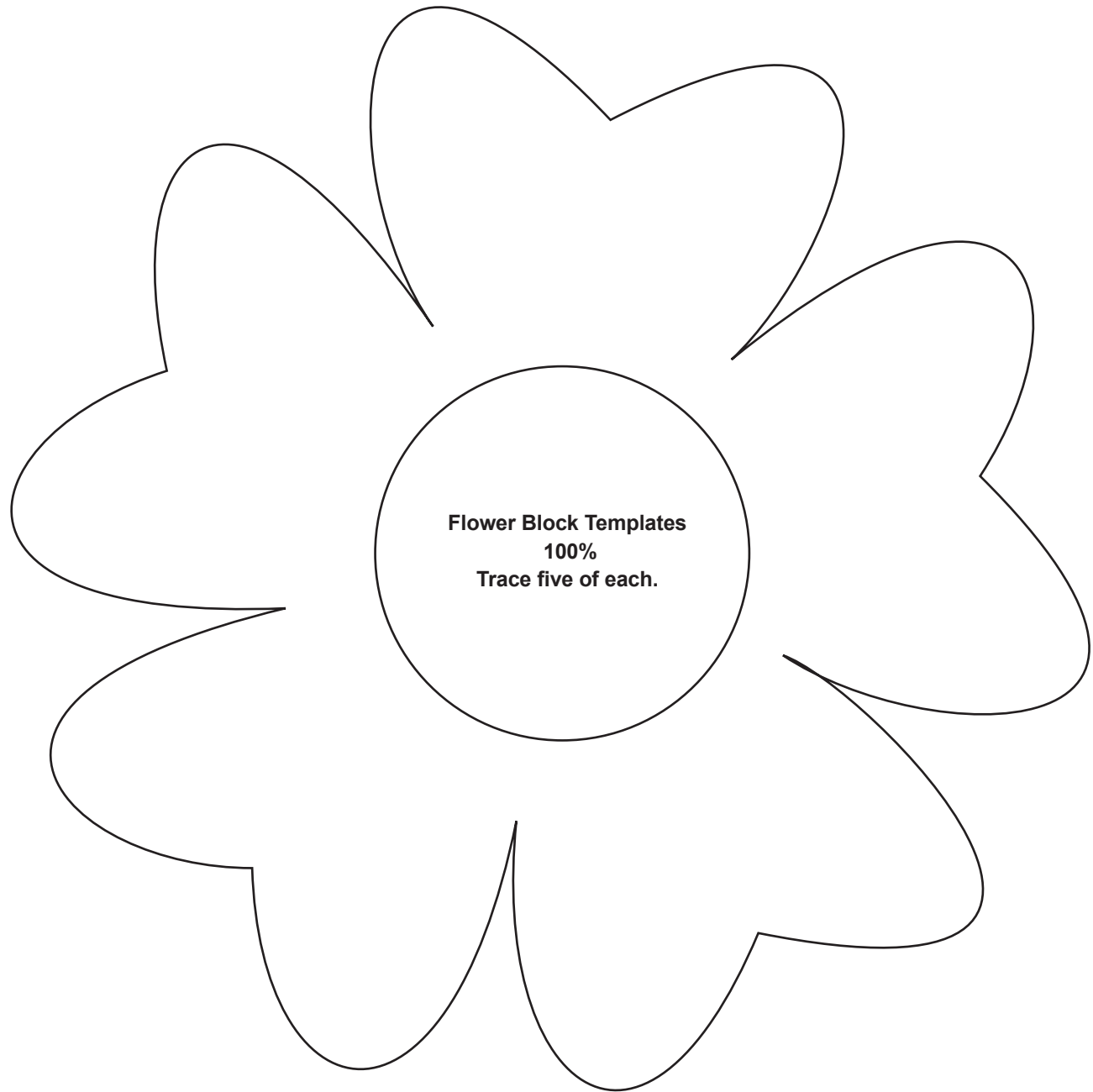
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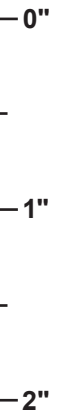
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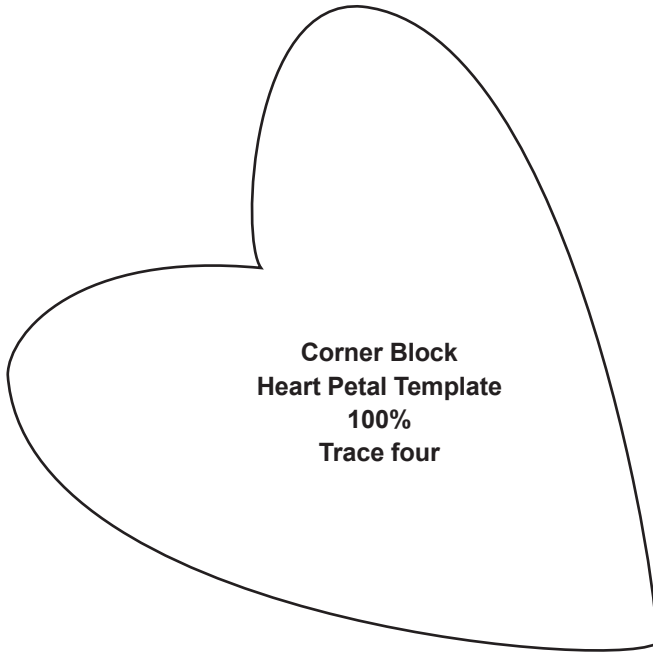

If it does not, change, "page scaling" to "none" in the print dialog box.



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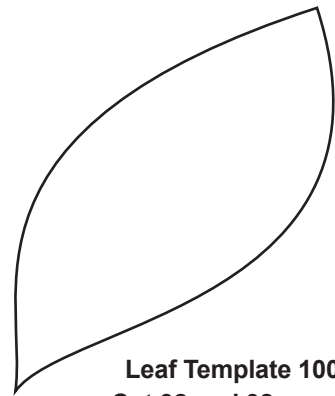


Corner Block
Heart Petal Template

Trace four

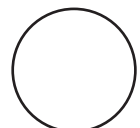
Vine Template
Enlarge 133%
Trace on the solid lines.
Add 1/4" at each end when
long vine is completed

Directions for cutting vine:

1. Cut a 42" length of fusible web to trace four 40 1/2" vines.
2. Trace three images of the vine (solid lines only), end to end, to make one long vine that measures 40".
3. Add 1/4" to each end of the completed 40" vine as shown by the dotted lines on the template. The vine will now measure 40 1/2".
4. Repeat to make four 40 1/2" vines.

Cut 32 and 32 reverse.
