**FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:**

A. Pattern #19691 – MUL1 .....	One Panel
B. Pattern #19694 – RED1 .....	Fat Quarter
C. Pattern #19694 – GRE1 .....	Fat Eighth
D. Pattern #19695 – CRE/PIN1 .....	1/4 yard
E. Pattern #19695 – CRE/BLU1 .....	1/4 yard
F. Pattern #19695 – CRE/GRE1 .....	1/4 yard
G. Pattern #19695 – CRE/RED1 .....	1/3 yard
H. Pattern #19695 – PIN1 .....	1/4 yard
I. Pattern #19695 – BLU1 .....	1 1/3 yards
J. Pattern #19695 – DKGRE1 .....	1/2 yard

**CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:**

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. 1/4" seam allowance is included in measurements and all strips are cut across the width of the fabric unless noted otherwise. Label pieces and keep together until ready to sew.

**A. Pattern #19691 – MUL1 (panel):**

1. Cut panel 23" x 42 1/2". **NOTE:** If your panel measurements are slightly different, cut the frame strips (Fabric J) slightly larger and trim to size noted in step 1 of Quilt Assembly.

**B. Pattern 19694 RED1 (checks):**

1. Cut four 3 1/2" squares and four 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.
2. Cut one 4 1/4" square, cutting diagonally in both directions to yield four quarter-square triangles (Card Trick Block #3).
3. Cut two 3 7/8" squares, cutting diagonally in half to yield four half-square triangles (Card Trick Block #3).

**C. Pattern #19694 – GRE1 (checks):**

1. Cut one 4 1/4" square, cutting diagonally in both directions to yield four quarter-square triangles (Card Trick Block #3).
2. Cut two 3 7/8" squares, cutting diagonally in half to yield four half-square triangles (Card Trick Block #3).

**D. Pattern #19695 – CRE/PIN1 (dots):**

1. Cut two 1 1/4" x 42 1/2" strips.
2. Cut one 4 1/4" strip; subcut two 4 1/4" squares, cutting diagonally in both directions to yield eight quarter-square triangles (Card Trick Block #3).
3. Trim remaining 4 1/4" strip to 3 7/8". Cut four 3 7/8" squares, cutting diagonally in half to yield eight half-square triangles (Card Trick Block #3).

**E. Pattern #19695 – CRE/BLU1 (dots):**

1. Cut one 4 1/4" strip; subcut two 4 1/4" squares, cutting diagonally in both directions to yield eight quarter-square triangles (use for two of four Card Trick Block #2a)
2. Trim remaining 4 1/4" strip to 3 7/8". Cut four 3 7/8" squares, cutting diagonally in half to yield eight half-square triangles (use for two of four Card Trick Block #2a).

**F. Pattern #19695 – CRE/GRE1 (dots):**

1. Cut one 4 1/4" strip; subcut two 4 1/4" squares, cutting diagonally in both directions to yield eight quarter-square triangles (use for two of four Card Trick Block #2b).
2. Trim remaining 4 1/4" strip to 3 7/8". Cut four 3 7/8" squares, cutting diagonally in half to yield eight half-square triangles (use for two of four Card Trick Block #2b).

**G. Pattern #19695 – CRE/RED1 (dots):**

1. Cut one 4 1/4" strip; subcut four 4 1/4" squares, cutting diagonally in both directions to yield sixteen quarter-square triangles (Card Trick Block #1).
2. Cut one 3 7/8" strip; subcut eight 3 7/8" squares, cutting diagonally in half to yield sixteen half-square triangles (Card Trick Block #1).

**H. Pattern #19695 – PIN1 (dots):**

1. Cut one 3 1/2" strip; subcut four 3 1/2" squares and four 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.

**I. Pattern #19695 – BLU1 (dots):**

1. Cut six 3 1/2" strips. Sew end to end; press. Cut four 3 1/2" x 57 1/2" strips.
2. Cut seven 2 1/2" strips for binding.
3. Cut one 4 1/4" strip; subcut two 4 1/4" squares, cutting diagonally in both directions to yield eight quarter-square triangles (Card Trick Block #1).
4. Trim remaining 4 1/4" strip to 3 7/8". Cut four 3 7/8" squares, cutting diagonally in half to yield eight half-square triangles (Card Trick Block #1).

**J. Pattern #19695 – DKGRE1 (dots):**

1. Cut four 2" strips. Cut two 2" x 27 1/2" strips and two 2" x 42 1/2" strips.
2. Cut one 3 1/2" strip; subcut four 3 1/2" squares and four 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.
3. Cut one 4 1/4" strip; subcut two 4 1/4" squares, cutting diagonally in both directions to yield eight quarter-square triangles (Card Trick Block #1).
4. Trim remaining 4 1/4" strip to 3 7/8". Cut four 3 7/8" squares, cutting diagonally in half to yield eight half-square triangles (Card Trick Block #1).

**K. Pattern #19695 – RED1 (dots):**

1. Cut two 3 1/2" strips; subcut twenty 3 1/2" squares and two 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of sixteen of the squares.

**L. Pattern #19696 – YEL1 (stripes):**

1. Cut one 3 1/2" strip; subcut four 3 1/2" squares and four 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles. Cut one 3" strip; subcut sixteen of the squares.
  - a. Position two squares as shown in Figure 1. Stack and cut squares diagonally from bottom right to top left corner to yield four triangles (small triangles for Card Trick Block #1).
  - b. Stack and cut two squares diagonally from bottom left corner to top right corner to yield four triangles (small triangles for Card Trick Block #1).
2. Cut one 4" strip. Using template material, make a template for a 3" finished triangle with the pattern provided. Position template on stripe as shown in Figure 2. Trace and cut eight triangles (large triangles for Card Trick Block #1).

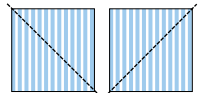

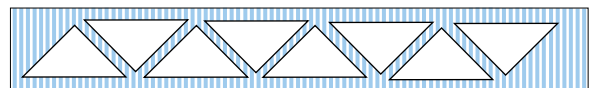

**M. Pattern #19696 – GREY (stripes):**

1. Cut one 3½" strip; subcut four 3½" squares and four 3½" x 6½" rectangles.
2. Cut one 3" strip; subcut four 3" squares.
  - a. Position two squares as shown in Figure 1. Stack and cut squares diagonally from bottom right to top left corner to yield four triangles (small triangles for Card Trick Block #2).
  - b. Stack and cut two squares diagonally from bottom left corner to top right corner to yield four triangles (small triangles for Card Trick Block #2).
3. Cut one 4" strip. Using template material, make a template for a 3" finished triangle with the pattern provided. Position template on stripe as shown in Figure 2. Trace and cut eight triangles (large triangles for Card Trick Block #2a and b).

**N. Pattern #19696 – RED1 (stripes):**

1. Cut one 3" strip; subcut four 3" squares.
  - a. Position two squares as shown in Figure 1. Stack and cut squares diagonally from bottom right to top left corner to yield four triangles (small triangles for Card Trick Block #1).
  - b. Stack and cut two squares diagonally from bottom left corner to top right corner to yield four triangles (small triangles for Card Trick Block #1).
2. Cut one 4" strip. Using template material, make a template for a 3" finished triangle with the pattern provided. Position template on stripe as shown in Figure 2. Trace and cut eight triangles (large triangles for Card Trick Block #1).

**O. Pattern #19696 – BLU1 (stripes):**

1. Cut one 3" strip; subcut four 3" squares.
  - a. Position two squares as shown in Figure 1. Stack and cut squares diagonally from bottom right to top left corner to yield four triangles (small triangles for Card Trick Block #2).
  - b. Stack and cut two squares diagonally from bottom left corner to top right corner to yield four triangles (small triangles for Card Trick Block #2).
2. Cut one 4" strip. Using template material, make a template for a 3" finished triangle with the pattern provided. Position template on stripe as shown in Figure 2. Trace and cut eight triangles (large triangles for Card Trick Block #2a and b).

**P. Pattern #19697 – PIN1 (small floral print):**

1. Cut one 3½" strip; subcut four 3½" squares and four 3½" x 6½" rectangles.
2. Cut one 4¼" strip; subcut three 4¼" squares, cutting diagonally in both directions to yield twelve quarter-square triangles (Card Trick Blocks #2 and 3).
3. Trim remaining 4¼" strip to 3⅞". Cut six 3⅞" squares, cutting diagonally in half to yield twelve half-square triangles (Card Trick Blocks #2a, 2b and 3).

**Q. Pattern #19697 – YEL1 (small floral print):**

1. Cut one 3⅞" strip; subcut six 3⅞" squares, cutting diagonally in half to yield 12 half-square triangles (Card Trick Blocks #2a, 2b and 3).
2. Trim remaining 3⅞" strip to 3½". Cut two 3½" squares.
3. Cut one 4¼" strip; subcut three 4¼" squares, cutting diagonally in both directions to yield twelve quarter-square triangles (Card Trick Blocks #2a, 2b and 3).



**R. Pattern #19698 – BE11 (toile fabric):**

1. Using template material, make a 6½" square template, as in Figure 3. Draw the diamond inside of the square. Trace and cut four 6½" squares centering a motif within the diamond shape.

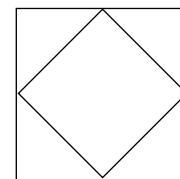

**PIECING INSTRUCTIONS:**

**Corner Blocks (Square-in-a-Square Blocks)**

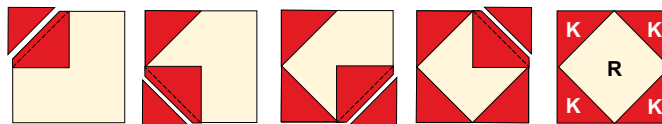
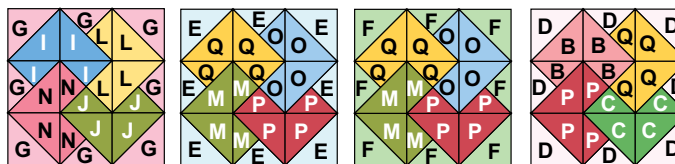


Figure 4. Make 4. Finished Size 6"

1. With right sides together, place a marked [K] 3½" square in the corner of a [R] 6½" square. Sew on the diagonal line; press toward corner and trim seam allowance (Figure 4). Repeat for all corners of [R] to complete one Square-in-a-Square Block. Make a total of four blocks.

**Card Trick Blocks**



#1 Make 4. #2a Make 2. #2b Make 2. #3 Make 2. Card Trick Blocks: Finished size: 9".

1. Refer to photo and above diagrams for fabric placement. Sew half-square triangles (large triangles) together; press toward dark fabric (Figure 5). Make four units per block.
2. Sew quarter-square triangles (small triangles) together; press toward dark fabric. Sew one half-square triangle to this to complete one unit (Figure 6). Make four units per block.
3. Sew four quarter-square triangles together to make one center unit for each block (Figure 7).
4. Join units together in rows. Sew rows together to complete ten Card Trick Blocks (Figure 8).

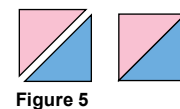

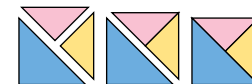

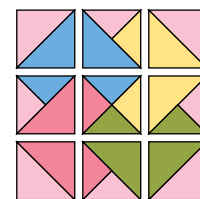

**QUILT ASSEMBLY:**

This is a medallion style quilt with quilt assembly beginning in the center of the quilt. Refer to the Quilt Diagram on the following page.

1. Sew a [D] 1¼" x 42½" strip to each side of the [A] panel. Press seams toward strips. **NOTE:** Center should measure 24½" x 42½".
2. Sew a [J] 2" x 42½" strip to each side of the center. Sew a [J] 2" x 27½" strip to the top and bottom. Press all seams toward the border. Panel unit should measure 27½" x 45½".
3. Sew Card Trick Blocks into two strips of five blocks, following color placement in photo and diagram. Press seams in one direction.
4. Sew the Card Trick rows to each side of quilt. Press seams toward green border.
5. Squares Border: Sew together two rows of fifteen 3½" squares, following color placement in photo and diagram. Press seams in one direction. Sew to each side of quilt. Press seams toward squares.
6. Rectangles Border and Corner Blocks: Sew together two rows of thirteen 3½" x 6½" rectangles following color placement in photo and diagram. Press seams in one direction. Sew the corner blocks to both ends

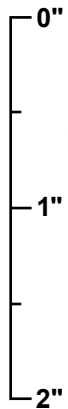
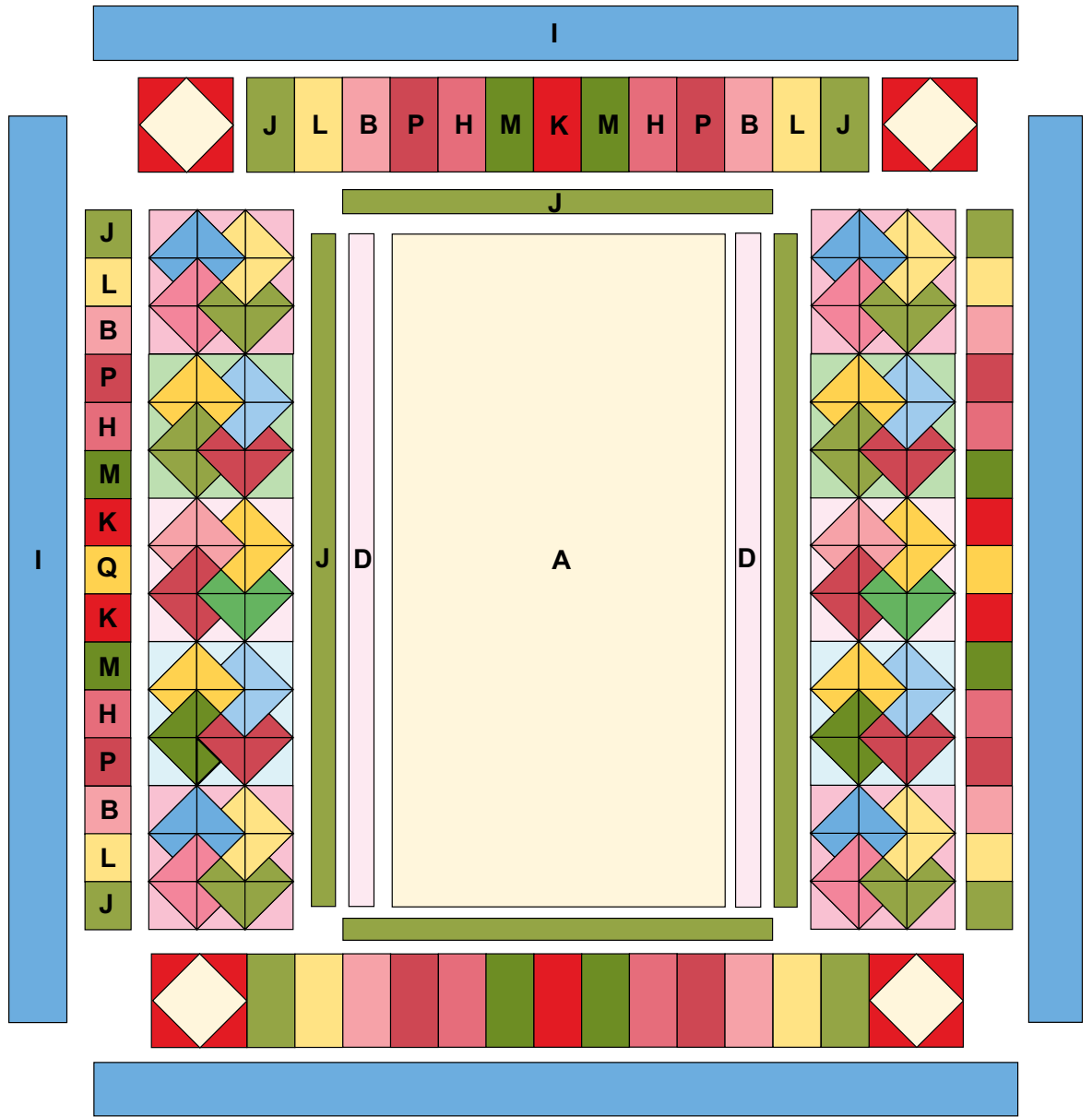


of each rectangle row. Press seams toward rectangles. Sew borders to top and bottom of quilt. Press seams toward the borders.

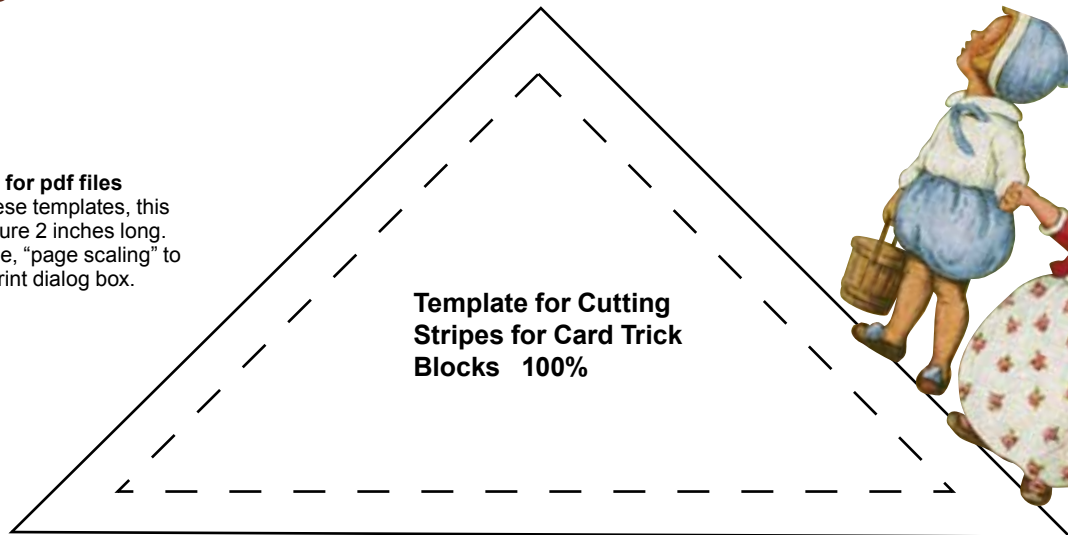
- Outer Border: Sew a [I]  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $57\frac{1}{2}$ " strip to each side of the quilt. Sew a  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $57\frac{1}{2}$ " strip to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press seams toward border.

**FINISHING:**

- Prepare backing with a vertical seam to measure 63" x 69".
- Layer quilt top, batting and backing.
- Baste layers together.
- Quilt as desired.
- Trim layers even with quilt top.
- Join binding strips and sew binding to quilt using your favorite method.
- Make a hanging sleeve, if desired, and a label and attach to back of quilt.



**Scale Check for pdf files**
