FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:

Pattern #18935 – YEL1	1½ yards
18936 – LTYELL	2½ yards
18941 – DKGRE1	½ yard
18941 – GRE1	½ yard
18941 – GOL1	⅝ yard
18941 – BEI1	1⅓ yards
18941 – PIN1	¾ yard
18941 – RED1	½ yard
18938 – DKGOL1	1 yard
18937 – GRE1	½ yard
18937 – YEL1	5 yards
	(backing)
18940 – PIN1	⅔ yard
	(binding)
Batting	72" x 90"

ADDITIONAL SUPPLIES:

Fusible web for appliqué 1½ yards



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APPLIQUÉ INSTRUCTIONS:

A. For Blocks A and B:

- Following the manufacturer's directions, trace the appliqué templates onto the fusible web and fuse to fabric before cutting.

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

Cut fabrics in order given.

A. Pattern #18935 – MUL1 (floral):

- Fussy cut six 12½" squares.

B. Pattern #18936 – LTYEL1 (floral stripe):

- Fussy cut four 6½" x length of fabric strips for outer border.

C. Pattern #18941 – DKGRE1 (texture):

- Cut the number of leaves indicated on appliqué templates. Refer to color photo.

D. Pattern #18941 – GRE1 (texture):

- Cut the number of leaves and stems indicated on appliqué templates.

E. Pattern #18941 – GOL1 (texture):

- Cut six 2" x width of fabric (wof) strips.
- Use remainder to cut flower centers as indicated on appliqué templates.

F. Pattern #18941 – BEI1 (texture):

- Cut twelve 12½" squares.

G. Pattern #18941 – PIN1 (texture):

- Cut roses and rose buds as indicated on appliqué templates.

H. Pattern #18941 – RED1 (texture):

- Cut roses and rose buds as indicated on appliqué templates.

I. Pattern #18938 – DKGOL1 (small floral):

- Cut five 3½" x wof strips. Recut into ten 3½" x 18¼" strips. Use your ruler markings to cut both ends of each strip at a 45° angle. Refer to diagram below.

- Cut two 9⅜" squares. Cut in half once on diagonal to make four corner triangles.

J. Pattern #18937 – GRE1 (paisley):

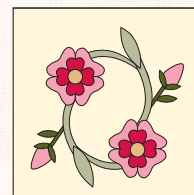
- Cut three 12¼" squares. Cut in half twice on diagonal to make four triangles from each square (10 are needed).

K. Pattern #18940 – PIN1 (stripe):

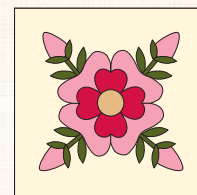
- Binding: cut eight 2¼" x wof strips. Sew together end-to-end for binding.

PIECING INSTRUCTIONS:

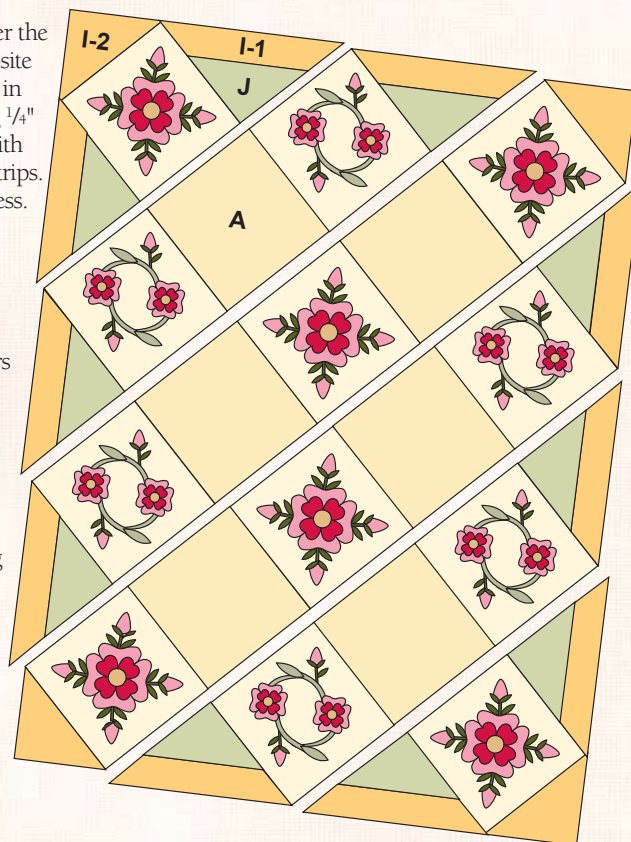
- Appliqué blocks: Referring to the block diagrams, fuse, then stitch the appliqué pieces in place on the F background squares. Make six A blocks and six B blocks.
- Sew the I-1 strips to the long side of the J triangles to make a large triangle unit. Make ten.
- The quilt is sewn together in diagonal rows. The four small floral triangles (I-2) are to square off the corners. The ten I/J triangles are to square off the sides of the quilt. Refer to the diagram for diagonal row assembly.
- Sew the E strips together end-to-end. Trim two lengths equal to the length of the quilt. Sew to the sides of the quilt. Cut two lengths equal to the width of the quilt. Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt.
- Mitered outer border: Center the outer border strips on opposite sides of the quilt top. Stitch in place, stopping and starting ¼" from each corner. Repeat with the two remaining border strips. Miter the corners. Trim excess.

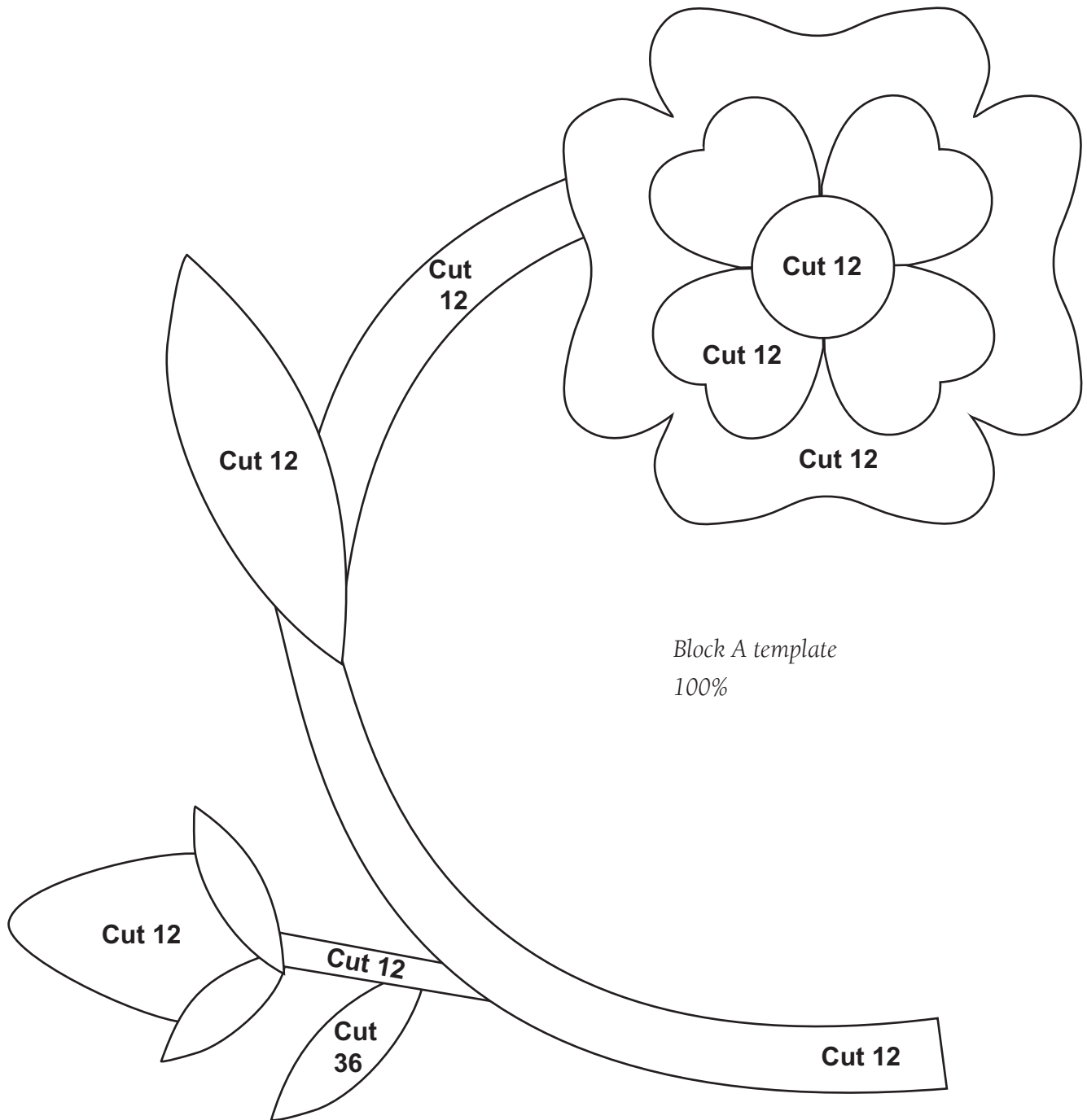
Block B

FINISHING:

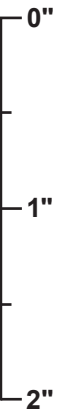
- Prepare backing to measure 72" x 90".
- Layer the quilt top, batting and backing. Baste the layers together, then quilt.
- Trim layers even with quilt top.
- Fold the binding with right sides together, lengthwise, and press the fold line. Match raw edges of binding to raw edges of quilt top then sew in place. Turn binding to back of quilt and stitch in place.

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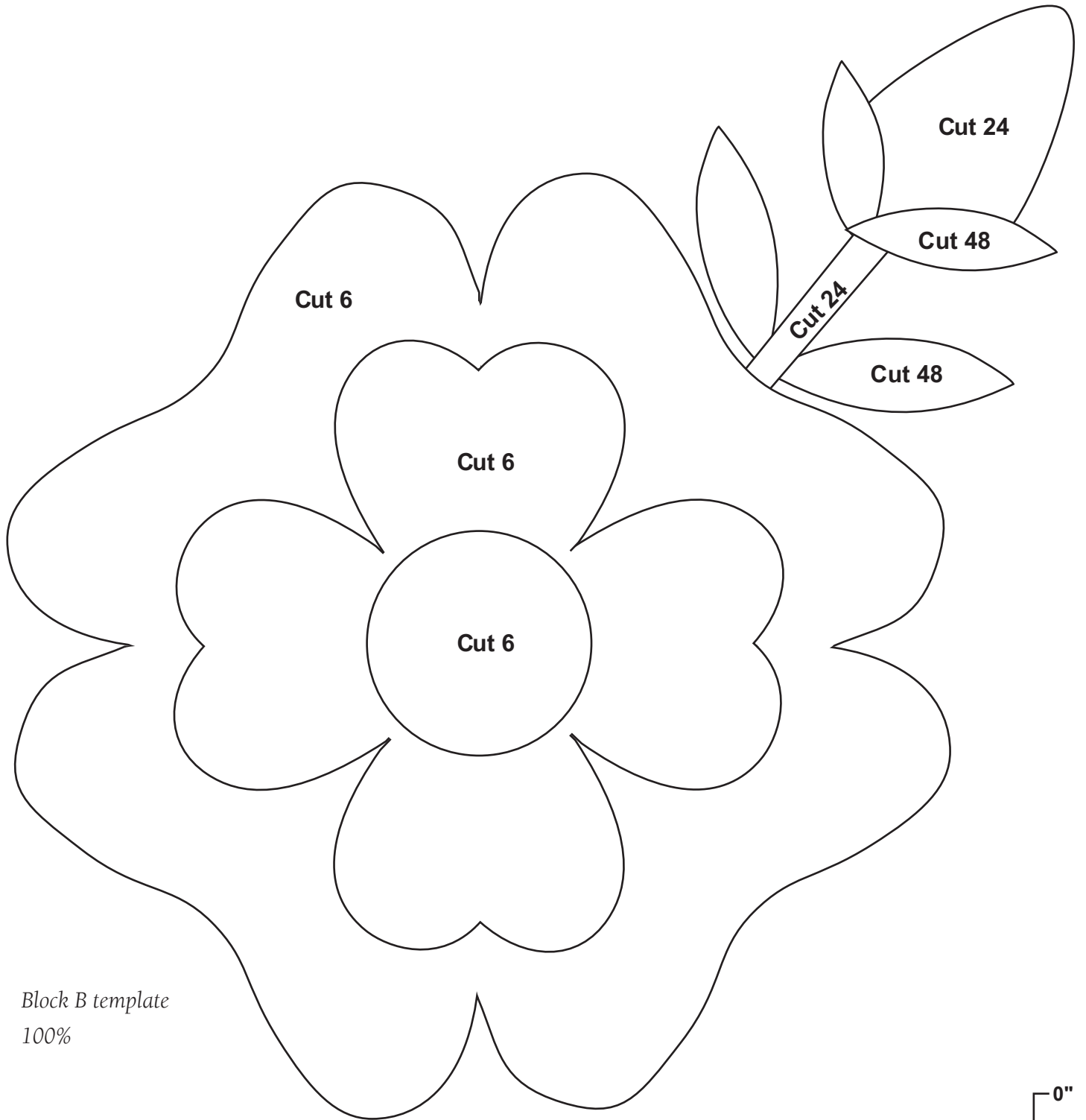


Block A template
