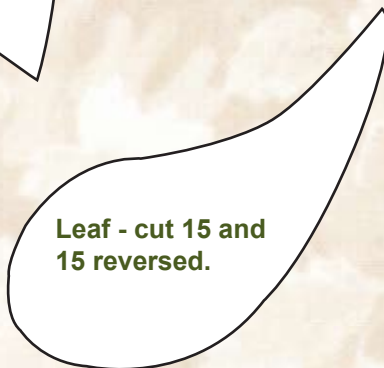
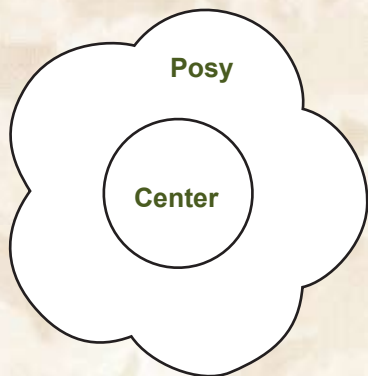
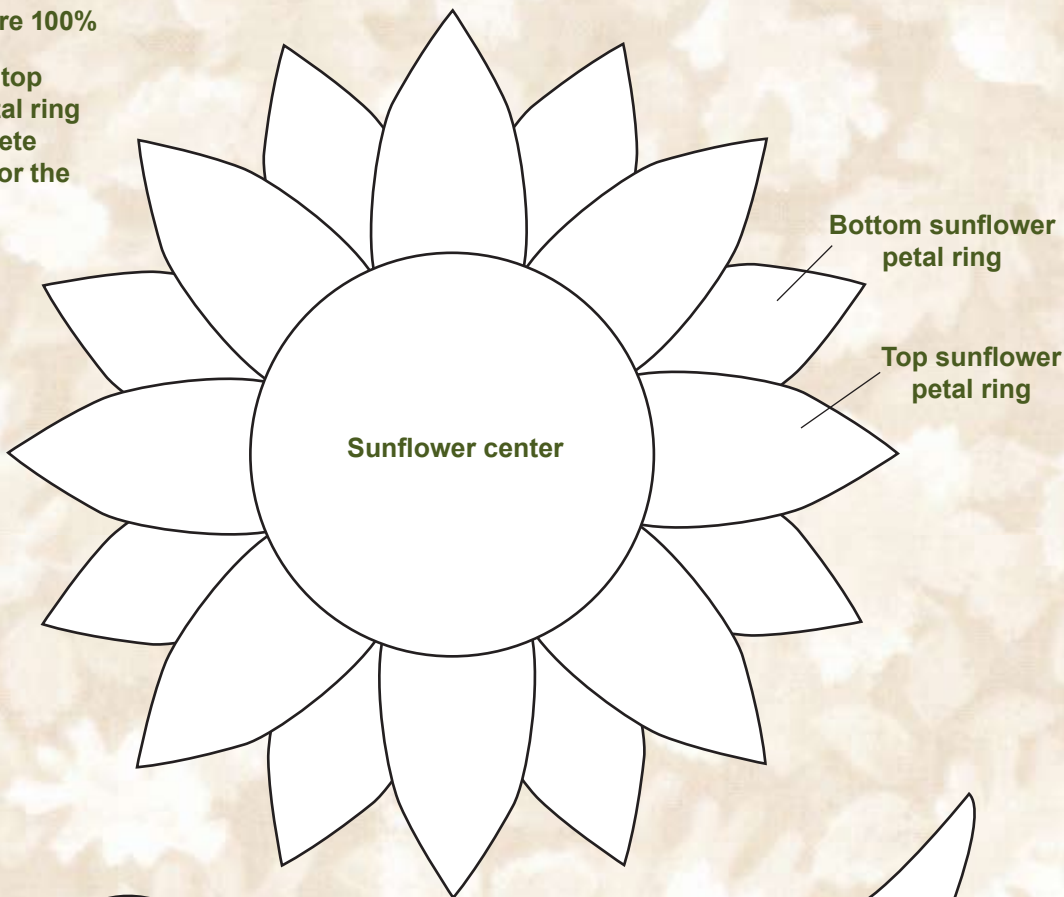

Note: Cut the top sunflower petal ring as one complete unit. Repeat for the bottom ring.



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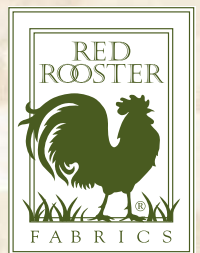

Pattern # 17747 – MUL1.....	2 yards
17749 – LTBE11	¾ yard
17750 – GRE1	1½ yards
17749 – LTYEL1	⅛ yard
17749 – YEL1	½ yard
17750 – ORA1	½ yard
17749 – DKGRE1	⅛ yard
17748 – BLA1	¼ yard
17749 – PUR1.....	¼ yard
17750 – LTBRO1	⅜ yard
17752 – BRO1	¾ yard
17749 – DKBRO1.....	¼ yard
17751 – PUR1.....	¼ yard
17751 – GRE1	⅓ yard
Muslin	1½ yards
Backing	4 yards of choice
Batting.....	66" x 70"

ADDITIONAL SUPPLIES:

- 1 roll ¼" wide Steam-A-Seam2® Double Stick
- 1 yard Steam-A-Seam2® Double Stick
- Appliqué pressing sheet

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

Note: Read and carefully follow the manufacturer's instructions for using fusible web to prepare the petal rings, centers, and leaves for appliqué, and ¼" fusible tape to prepare the stems and vines.

A. Pattern #17747 – MUL1 (large floral):

1. Cut four 6½" x length of fabric strips for outer border.

B. Pattern #17749 – LTBE11 (leaves):

1. Cut twenty-four 3⅞" squares. Cut once on diagonal. Yield: forty-eight triangles.
2. Cut twenty-four 2½" squares.
3. Cut twenty-four 2⅞" squares. Cut once on diagonal. Yield: forty-eight triangles.

C. Pattern #17750 – GRE1 (dot texture):

1. Cut eight 2½" x length of fabric strips.

D. Pattern #17749 – LTYEL1 (leaves):

1. Cut four 3⅞" squares. Cut once on diagonal. Yield: eight triangles.

E. Pattern #17749 – YEL1 (leaves):

1. Cut eight 3⅞" squares. Cut once on diagonal. Yield: sixteen triangles.
2. Apply fusible web and cut eighteen posy centers.
3. Apply fusible web and cut sixteen top sunflower petal rings.

F. Pattern #17750 – ORA1 (dot texture):

1. Cut four 3⅞" squares. Cut once on diagonal. Yield: eight triangles.
2. Apply fusible web and cut sixteen bottom sunflower petal rings.
3. Cut twelve 2⅞" squares. Cut once on diagonal. Yield: twenty-four triangles.

G. Pattern #17749 – DKGRE1 (leaves):

1. Cut twelve 2½" squares.

H. Pattern #17748 – BLA1 (pumpkin):

1. Cut twelve 3⅞" squares. Cut once on diagonal. Yield: twenty-four triangles.

I. Pattern #17749 – PUR1 (leaves):

1. Cut twelve 3⅞" squares. Cut once on diagonal. Yield: twenty-four triangles.

J. Pattern #17750 – LTBRO1 (dot texture):

1. Apply fusible web and cut sixteen sunflower center circles.
2. Cut as many scant ⅜"-wide diagonal strips as needed to equal at least 120" for vines and stems. Using the appliqué pressing sheet, apply the ¼" Double Stick tape to the wrong side of the strips, following the manufacturer's directions.

K. Pattern #17752 – BRO1 (stripe):

1. Cut six 2½" squares.
2. Cut seven 2¼" x 42" strips for binding.

L. Pattern #17749 – DKBRO1 (leaves):

1. Cut twelve 2⅞" squares. Cut once on diagonal. Yield: twenty-four triangles.

M. Pattern #17751 – PUR1 (swirls):

1. Cut six 2½" squares.
2. Apply fusible web and cut eighteen posies.

N. Pattern #17751 – GRE1 (swirls):

1. Apply fusible web and cut fifteen and fifteen reversed leaves.

O. Muslin:

1. Cut two 8½" x 48½" appliqué background strips.

PIECING INSTRUCTIONS:

Block A

1. Referring to Figure 1, sew a D triangle to an H triangle. Sew an H triangle to each side of D/H. Sew a B triangle to an F triangle. Sew a B triangle to each side of B/F. Sew the two large triangle units together to complete the block. Repeat to make eight A blocks.



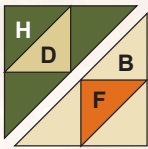

Make eight.

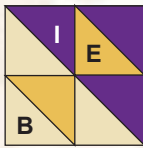

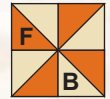

Block B

2. Sew an E triangle to an I triangle. Sew an I triangle to each side of E/I (Figure 2). Sew a B triangle to an E triangle. Sew a B triangle to each side of B/E. Sew the two large triangle units together to complete the block. Repeat to make eight B blocks.

Block C

3. Referring to Figure 3, sew a B square to an G square. Sew a K square to a B square. Sew B/G to K/B to complete the block. Repeat to make six C blocks.

Block D

4. Sew four B triangles to four L triangles. Sew the units together to complete the block (Figure 4). Repeat to make six D blocks.

Block E

5. Sew a B square to a G square. Sew an M square to a B square. Sew B/G to M/B to complete the block (Figure 5). Repeat to make six E blocks.

Block F

6. Sew four B triangles to four F triangles. Sew the units together to complete the block (Figure 6). Repeat to make six F blocks.

APPLIQUÉ INSTRUCTIONS:

Finished strip size: 8" x 48"

Make two.

1. Referring to the cover photo, arrange the petal rings, centers, and leaves on the two muslin strips (O).
2. Gently curve the vines. Arrange the stems to connect the flowers and leaves to the vines.
3. Press in place.
4. Machine appliqué using raw edge stitching now, or later when you quilt the layers together.

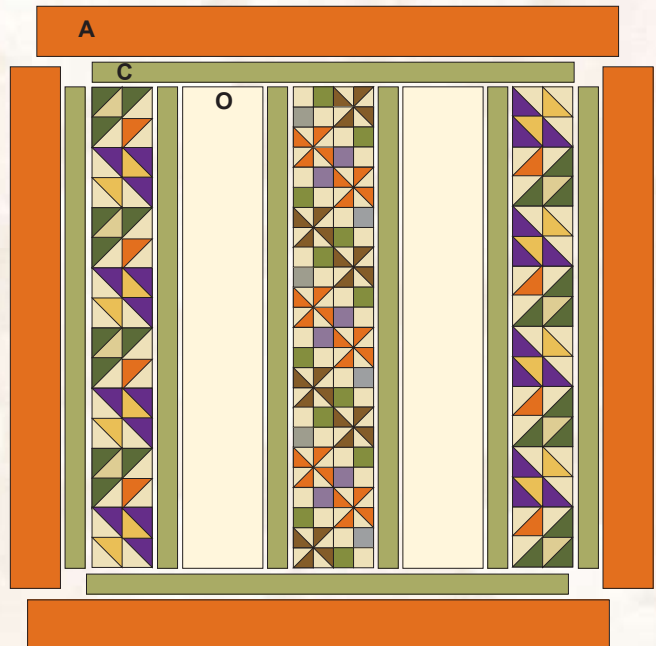
ASSEMBLY: Refer to Quilt Diagram.

1. Sew four A blocks and four B blocks into a vertical strip, alternating blocks. Make two.
2. Sew blocks C, D, E, and F into the center strip.
3. Trim the length of six C strips equal to the length of the pieced vertical strips.

4. Sew the five pieced vertical strips and the six C strips together, beginning and ending with a C strip.
5. Trim the length of the two remaining C strips equal to the width of the joined vertical rows. Sew the strips to the top and bottom.
6. Trim the length of two outer border strips equal to the length of the quilt. Sew to the sides of the quilt. Repeat with the top and bottom border strips.

FINISHING:

1. Prepare backing to measure 66" x 70".
2. Layer the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste layers together. Hand or machine quilt as desired.
3. Join binding strips with diagonal seams. Press seams open. Apply binding using your favorite method.
4. Make a hanging sleeve from leftover backing fabric and attach to the top of the back of the quilt.
