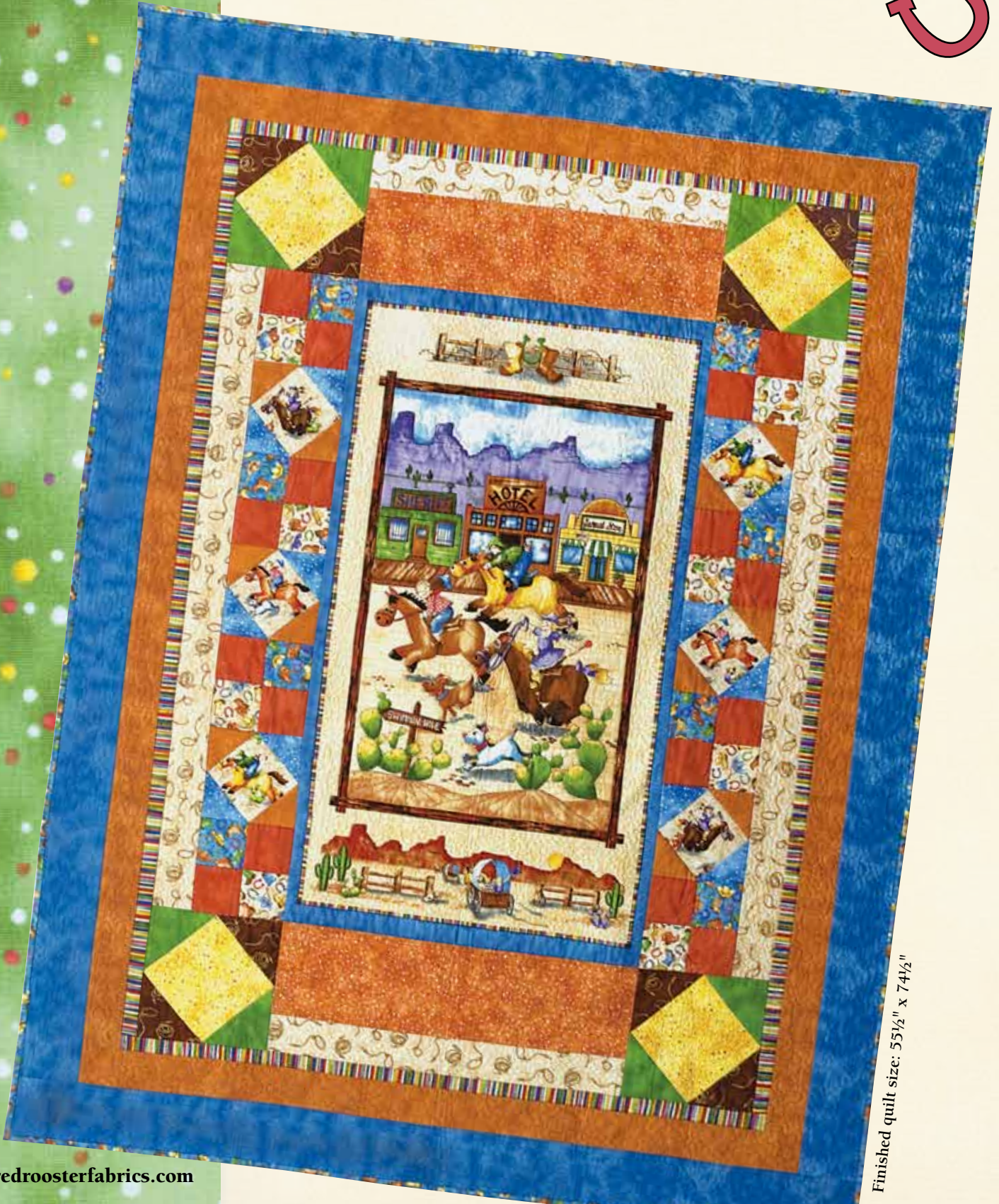


Horsing Around

Finished quilt size: 55 1/2" x 74 1/2"

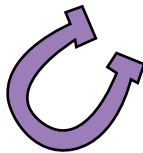
FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:

A. Pattern #19966 – BE11	1/8 yard
B. Pattern #19966 – BLU1	1/8 yard
C. Pattern #19965 – ORA1	1/4 yard
D. Pattern #19964 – BLU1	1/8 yard
E. Pattern #19965 – LTORA1	3/4 yard
F. Pattern #19962 – MUL1	1/2 yard
G. Pattern #20063 – BRO1	1/4 yard
H. Pattern #19965 – GRE1	1/4 yard
I. Pattern #19964 – YEL1	1/4 yard
J. Pattern #19964 – ORA1	1/2 yard
K. Pattern #20063 – CRE1	1/2 yard
L. Pattern #19967 – BLU1	1/4 yard
M. Pattern #19965 – DKBLU1	7/8 yard
N. Pattern #19961 – MUL1	1 panel
Backing of choice (pieced horizontally)	3 1/2 yards
Batting	62" x 80"

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. 1/4" seam allowance is included in measurements and all strips are cut across the width of the fabric unless noted otherwise. Cut fabrics in order given.

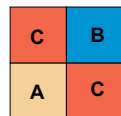
- A. Pattern #19966 – BE11 (tossed boots/hats):**
 1. Cut one 3 1/2" strip.
- B. Pattern #19966 – BLU1 (tossed boots/hats):**
 1. Cut one 3 1/2" strip.
- C. Pattern #19965 – ORA1 (denim):**
 1. Cut two 3 1/2" strips.
- D. Pattern #19964 – BLU1 (dots):**
 1. Cut one 3 7/8" strip; subcut six 3 7/8" squares. Cut each square in half diagonally to yield twelve half-square triangles.
- E. Pattern #19965 – LTORA1 (denim):**
 1. Cut one 3 7/8" strip; subcut six 3 7/8" squares. Cut each square in half diagonally to yield twelve half-square triangles.
 2. Cut six 3" strips; sew together end to end and press. Cut two 3" x 61 1/2" and two 3" x 47 1/2".
- F. Pattern #19962 – MUL1 (tossed kids):**
 1. Cut six 4 3/4" squares centering a motif (on point) within each one.
- G. Pattern #20063 – BRO1 (rope):**
 1. Cut one 5 1/8" strip; subcut four 5 1/8" squares. Cut each square in half diagonally to yield eight half-square triangles.
- H. Pattern #19965 – GRE1 (denim):**
 1. Cut one 5 1/8" strip; subcut four 5 1/8" squares. Cut each square in half diagonally to yield eight half-square triangles.
- I. Pattern #19964 – YEL1 (dots):**
 1. Cut one 6 1/2" strip; subcut four 6 1/2" squares.
- J. Pattern #19964 – ORA1 (dots):**
 1. Cut two 6 1/2" strips; subcut two 6 1/2" x 23 1/2" sections.
- K. Pattern #20063 – CRE1 (rope):**
 1. Cut four 3" strips. Trim the length of two strips to 3" x 23 1/2". Trim the remaining strips to 3" x 42 1/2".
- L. Pattern #19967 – BLU1 (stripe):**
 1. Cut five 1 1/2" strips; sew together end to end and press. Cut two 1 1/2" x 59 1/2" lengths and two 1 1/2" x 42 1/2" lengths.
- M. Pattern #19965 – DKBLU1 (denim):**
 1. Cut six 4 1/2" strips; sew together end to end and press. Cut two 4 1/2" x 66 1/2" lengths and two 4 1/2" x 55 1/2" lengths.
- N. Pattern #19961 – MUL1 (panel):**
 1. Trim panel to measure 23 1/2" x 42 1/2".



PIECING INSTRUCTIONS:

Four-Patch Block:

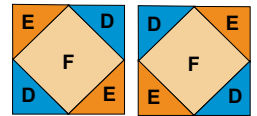
Sew one 3 1/2" [A] strip to one 3 1/2" [C] strip. Press toward [C]. Cut strip set into eight 3 1/2" segments. Repeat using one 3 1/2" [B] strip and one 3 1/2" [C] strip. Sew one [A/C] unit to one [B/C] unit to make one four-patch block. Repeat to make eight blocks.



Four-Patch Block
Finished size: 6" square
Make eight blocks

Diamond-in-a-Square Block:

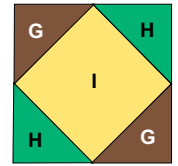
Refer to photo and diagram for fabric placement. Sew a [D] triangle to opposite sides of a [F] square. Press toward the triangles. Sew an [E] triangle to remaining sides of square; press. Make six blocks.



Diamond-in-a-Square Block
Finished size: 6" square
Make three blocks of each.

Diamond-in-a-Square Border Block:

Sew a [G] triangle to opposite sides of an [I] square. Press toward the triangles. Sew an [H] triangle to remaining sides of square; press. Make four blocks.



Diamond-in-a-Square Border Block
Finished size: 8 1/2" square
Make four blocks

QUILT ASSEMBLY:

Refer to Quilt Diagram below.

Sew one side block section together alternating four four-patch blocks with three diamond-in-a-square blocks. Press toward four-patch blocks. Repeat. Sew a 3" x 42 1/2" [K] strip to one side of each block section. Press toward [K] strip. Sew side sections to sides of panel. Press toward the panel. Sew together a 6 1/2" x 23 1/2" [J] strip to a 3" x 23 1/2" [K] strip. Press toward [J]. Repeat. Sew a border diamond-in-a-square block to ends of both sets. Press toward the blocks. Sew to top and bottom of panel unit.

BORDERS:

1st Border:

Sew one 1 1/2" x 59 1/2" [L] strip to each side of the quilt. Sew remaining [L] strips to the top and bottom. Press all seams toward the [L] borders.

2nd Border:

Sew one 3" x 61 1/2" [E] strip to each side of the quilt. Sew remaining [E] strips to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Press all seams toward the [E] borders.

3rd Border:

Sew one 4 1/2" x 66 1/2" [M] strip to each side of the quilt. Sew remaining [M] strips to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Press all seams toward the [M] borders.

FINISHING:

1. Prepare backing using two widths of fabric. Seam to be placed horizontally with quilt top.
2. Layer quilt top, batting and backing. Baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired and trim layers even with quilt top.
4. Prepare binding and sew to quilt using your favorite method.
5. Make a hanging sleeve and label if desired.
