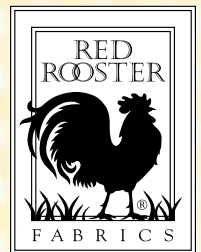

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FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:

A. Pattern #20245 – RED1	one panel
B. Pattern #20246 – MUL1	1/2 yard
C. Pattern #20247 – RED1	1/4 yard
D. Pattern #20247 – YEL1	1/8 yard
E. Pattern #20248 – RED1	3/4 yard
F. Pattern #20249 – GRE1	1/8 yard
G. Pattern #20249 – LTBLU1	1/8 yard
H. Pattern #20249 – PIN1	1/8 yard
I. Pattern #20249 – RED1	3/8 yard
J. Pattern #20250 – LTBLU1	1/8 yard
K. Pattern #20250 – PIN1	1/8 yard
L. Pattern #20250 – RED1	7/8 yard
M. Pattern #20252 – YEL1	1/8 yard
N. Pattern #20252 – GRE1	1/8 yard
O. Pattern #20253 – RED1	1/4 yard
P. Pattern #20254 – BLU1	1/8 yard
Q. Pattern #20254 – PIN1	1/8 yard
R. Pattern #20458 – CRE1	1 1/4 yards
Backing	3 1/4 yards
Batting	57" x 70"

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

Cut fabrics in the order given.

All fabrics are cut across the width of fabric.

A. Pattern #20245 – RED1 (panel):

1. Fussy cut thirteen 6 1/2" square redwork images.

B. Pattern #20246 – MUL1 (tossed images):

1. Cut six 2 1/2" strips for Block II (Label B).

C. Pattern #20247 – RED1 (red check):

1. Cut four 1 1/2" strips for Block I.

D. Pattern #20247 – YEL1 (yellow check):

1. Cut one 2 1/2" strip. Crosscut twelve 2 1/2" squares for Block II (F).

E. Pattern #20248 – RED1 (red stripe):

1. Cut three 2" strips for inner border.
2. Cut seven 2 1/2" strips for binding.

F. Pattern #20249 – GRE1 (green medium floral):

1. Cut one 2 1/2" strip. Crosscut sixteen 2 1/2" squares for Block II (E).

G. Pattern # 20249 – LTBLU1 (blue medium floral):

1. Cut one 2 1/2" strip. Crosscut sixteen 2 1/2" squares for Block II (E).

H. Pattern #20249 – PIN1 (pink medium floral):

1. Cut one 2 1/2" strip. Crosscut sixteen 2 1/2" squares for Block II (E).

I. Pattern #20249 – RED1 (red medium floral):

1. Cut one 6 1/4" square. Cut square in half twice on diagonal to yield four small triangles for pieced outer border.
2. Cut eight 4" squares for pieced outer border.

J. Pattern #20250 – LTBLU1 (blue small floral):

1. Cut one 2 1/2" strip. Crosscut eight 2 1/2" squares for Block II (D).

K. Pattern #20250 – PIN1 (pink small floral):

1. Cut one 2 1/2" strip. Crosscut eight 2 1/2" squares for Block II (D).

L. Pattern #20250 – RED1 (red small floral):

1. Cut nine 1 1/2" strips for Block I.
2. Cut three 11 1/4" squares. Cut each square in half twice on diagonal to yield twelve large triangles for pieced outer border. You will only need ten triangles.

M. Pattern #20252 – YEL1 (yellow animal toss):

1. Cut one 2 1/2" strip. Crosscut eight 2 1/2" squares for Block II (D).

N. Pattern #20252 – GRE1 (green animal toss):

1. Cut one 2 1/2" strip. Crosscut eight 2 1/2" squares for Block II (D).

O. Pattern #20253 – RED1 (small flowers on check):

1. Cut three 2 1/2" strips. Crosscut forty-eight 2 1/2" squares for Block II (A).

P. Pattern #20254 – BLU1 (stitched-edge flowers):

1. Cut one 2 1/2" strip. Crosscut into eight 2 1/2" squares for Block II (D).

Q. Pattern #20254 – PIN1 (stitched-edge flowers):

1. Cut one 2 1/2" strip. Crosscut into eight 2 1/2" squares for Block II (D).

R. Pattern #20458 – CRE1 (cream solid):

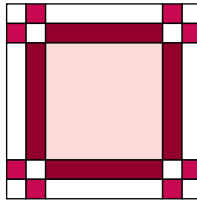
1. Cut thirteen 1 1/2" strips for Block I.
2. Cut three 2 1/2" strips for Block II (C).
3. Cut five 6 1/4" squares. Cut each square in half twice on diagonal to yield twenty small triangles for pieced outer border.



PIECING INSTRUCTIONS:

A. Block I

1. Sew a 1½" red check strip to a 1½" cream strip. Press toward the red check strip. Make four. Crosscut one-hundred four 1½" segments. Sew two segments together to make a 4-Patch. Press. Make fifty-two 4-Patches.
2. Sew a 1½" red small floral strip to a 1½" cream strip. Press toward the red strip. Make nine. Crosscut fifty-two 6½" segments.

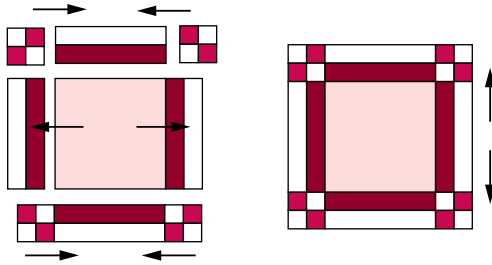
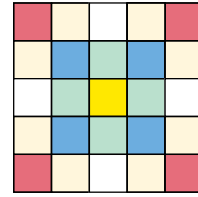


Figure 1 Make 13.

3. For each block, assemble four of each unit from steps 1 and 2 with a 6½" panel square (Figure 1). Sew units together. Press in direction of arrows.

B. Block II

1. Sew a B strip to each side of a C strip to make a B/C/B strip set. Press toward B. Make three strip sets. Crosscut a total of forty-eight 2½" B/C/B units.

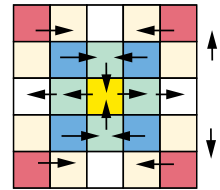
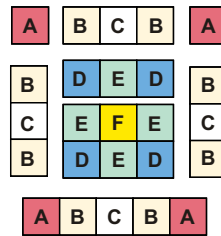
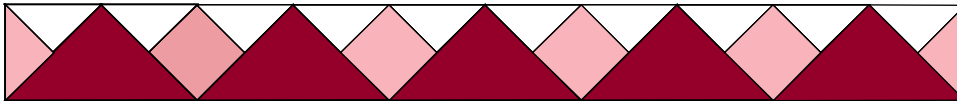


Figure 2 Press in direction of arrows. Make 12.

2. For each block arrange four A squares, four B/C/B units, one F square, four D squares of the same fabric, and four E squares of the same fabric. Sew together as shown in Figure 2. Press in direction of arrows. Make a total of twelve blocks with a variety of D and E fabric combinations.

C. Pieced Border



Pieced Border Make 2.

1. Sew two small cream triangles to a red square as shown in Figure 3. Press toward cream triangles. Make eight.

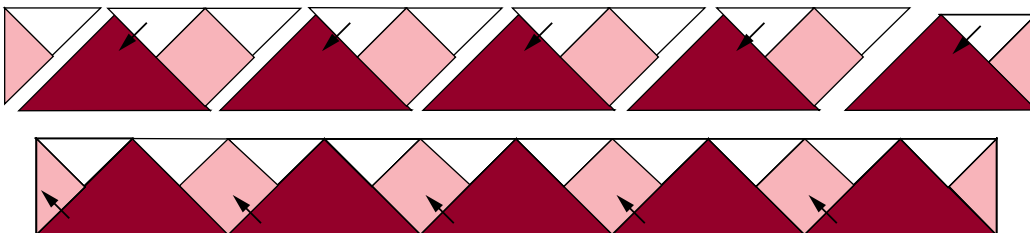


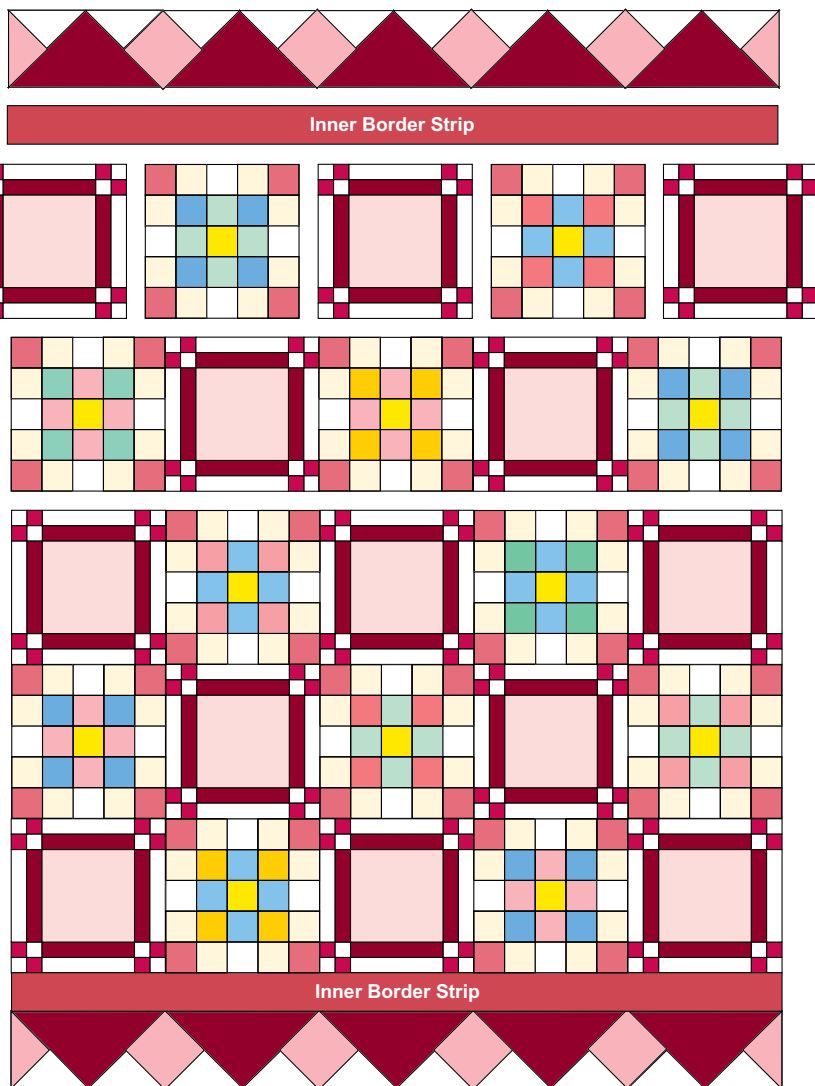
Figure 4 Press in direction of arrows. Make 2.

2. Arrange two small red triangles, two small cream triangles, five large red triangles and four units from step 1 for each pieced outer border strip. Sew together (Figure 4). Press in direction of arrows.

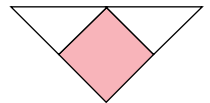

Make 8 units.

QUILT ASSEMBLY:

1. Arrange blocks into five rows of five blocks each as shown in Quilt Diagram.
2. Sew blocks together into rows. Press toward Block II.
3. Sew rows together. Press.
4. Sew the three 2" inner border strips together end to end. Press seams open. Cut two lengths equal to the width of the quilt. Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press toward the inner border.
5. Sew the outer border strips to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press toward the inner border.

FINISHING:

1. Prepare the backing with a horizontal seam to measure 57" x 70". Press seam open.
2. Layer quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Trim layers even with quilt top.
5. Prepare binding strips and attach to quilt using your favorite method.
