## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:

Pattern #17020 – EGG1 .....	1/8 yard
17020 – LTBE11 .....	1/8 yard
17020 – GOL1 .....	1/3 yard
17020 – LTSAG1 .....	7/8 yard
17021 – OLI1 .....	1/2 yard
17021 – TEA1 .....	1/4 yard
17021 – GOL1 .....	1/4 yard
17021 – BE11 .....	1/8 yard
17021 – TAN1 .....	1/4 yard
17022 – SAG1 .....	1/4 yard
17022 – DKBE11 .....	1/4 yard

## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

### A. Pattern #17020 – LTBE11 (tone-on-tone):

1. Cut twelve 2 1/2" squares. Label eight squares D, and four squares H for Block Y.

### B. Pattern #17020 – GOL1 (tone-on-tone):

1. Cut one 4 1/2" x 42" strip. Crosscut eight 4 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles and one 4 1/2" square. Label four rectangles C, Block X, and four rectangles C, Block Y. Label the square A, Block Y.
2. From the remainder of the 4 1/2" strip, cut two 2 7/8" squares (F, Block X).
3. Cut two 2 1/2" x 42" strips. Crosscut twenty-four 2 1/2" squares. Label twelve squares G, Block X, and twelve squares G, Block Y.

### C. Pattern #17020 – LTSAG1 (tone-on-tone):

1. Cut one 4 1/2" x 42" strip. Crosscut four 4 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles (C, Block Y) and one 4 1/2" square (A, Block Y).
2. Cut one 2 1/2" x 42" strip. Crosscut twelve 2 1/2" squares (G, Block Y).
3. Cut five 3 1/2" x 42" strips for outer border.

### D. Pattern #17021 – OLI1 (star swirl):

1. Cut one 4 1/2" x 42" strip. Crosscut eight 4 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles and one 4 1/2" square. Label four rectangles C, Block Y, and four rectangles B, Block Y. Label the square A, Block Y.
2. Cut one 2 1/2" x 42" strip. Crosscut twelve 2 1/2" squares (G, Block Y).
3. Cut one 2 1/2" x 42" strip. Crosscut sixteen 2 1/2" squares for cornerstones.
4. Cut four 3 1/2" squares for outer border corners.

### E. Pattern #17021 – TEA1 (star swirl):

1. Cut one 2 1/2" x 42" strip. Crosscut eight 2 1/2" squares (D, Block X).
2. Cut one 4 1/2" x 42" strip. Crosscut eight 4 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles and one 4 1/2" square. Label four rectangles B, Block X, and four rectangles B, Block Y. Label the square A, Block X.
3. From the remainder of the 4 1/2" strip, cut two 2 7/8" squares (E, Block X).

### F. Pattern #17021 – GOL1 (star swirl):

1. Cut one 4 1/2" x 42" strip. Crosscut four 4 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles (C, Block Y) and one 4 1/2" square (A, Block Y).
2. Cut one 2 1/2" x 42" strip. Crosscut twelve 2 1/2" squares (G, Block Y).

### G. Pattern #17021 – TAN1 (star swirl):

1. Cut one 4 1/2" x 42" strip. Crosscut four 4 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles (C, Block X).
2. From the remainder of the 4 1/2" strip, cut two 2 7/8" squares (F, Block X).
3. Cut one 2 1/2" x 42" strip. Crosscut twelve 2 1/2" squares (G, Block X).

### H. Pattern #17022 – SAG1 (stars and sprigs):

1. Cut one 4 1/2" x 42" strip. Crosscut four 4 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles (C, Block Y) and one 4 1/2" square (A, Block Y).
2. Cut one 2 1/2" x 42" strip. Crosscut twelve 2 1/2" squares (G, Block Y).

### I. Pattern #17022 – DKBE11 (stars and sprigs):

1. Cut two 2 1/2" x 42" strips. Crosscut four 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles (C, Block X), twelve 2 1/2" squares (G, Block X), eight 2 1/2" squares (D, Block Y), and four 2 1/2" squares (H, Block Y).
2. Cut two 2 7/8" squares (F, Block X).

### J. Pattern #17022 – TEA1 (stars and sprigs):

1. Cut one 2 1/2" x 42" strip. Crosscut eight 2 1/2" squares (D, Block X).
2. Cut one 4 1/2" x 42" strip. Crosscut eight 4 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles and one 4 1/2" square. Label four rectangles B, Block X, and four rectangles B, Block Y. Label the square A, Block X.
3. From the remainder of the 4 1/2" strip, cut two 2 7/8" squares (E, Block X).

### K. Pattern #17022 – RED1 (stars and sprigs):

1. Cut one 2 1/2" x 42" strip. Crosscut eight 2 1/2" squares (D, Block X).
2. Cut one 4 1/2" x 42" strip. Crosscut eight 4 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles and one 4 1/2" square. Label four rectangles B, Block X, and four triangles B, Block Y. Label the square A, Block X.
3. From the remainder of the 4 1/2" strip, cut two 2 7/8" squares (E, Block X).
4. Cut twenty-four 2 1/2" x 12 1/2" sashing strips.

### L. Pattern #17023 – BE11 (star plaid):

1. Cut one 2 1/2" x 42" strip. Crosscut twelve 2 1/2" squares. Label eight squares D, Block Y, and four squares H, Block Y.

### M. Pattern #17023 – RED1 (star plaid):

1. Cut one 2 1/2" x 42" strip. Crosscut eight 2 1/2" squares (D, Block X).
2. Cut one 4 1/2" x 42" strip. Crosscut eight 4 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles and one 4 1/2" square. Label four rectangles B, Block X, and four triangles B, Block Y. Label the square A, Block X.
3. Cut two 2 7/8" squares (E, Block X).

### N. Pattern #17025 – YEL1 (flower toss):

1. Cut one 2 1/2" x 42" strip. Crosscut twelve 2 1/2" squares. Label eight squares D, Block Y, and four squares H, Block Y.

### O. Pattern #17025 – BE11 (flower toss):

1. Cut one 2 1/2" x 42" strip. Crosscut twelve 2 1/2" squares. Label eight squares D, Block Y, and four squares H, Block Y.

### P. Pattern #17025 – GRE1 (flower toss):

1. Cut one 4 1/2" x 42" strip. Crosscut four 4 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles (C, Block X).
2. From the remainder of the 4 1/2" strip, cut two 2 7/8" squares (F, Block X).
3. Cut one 2 1/2" x 42" strip. Crosscut twelve 2 1/2" squares (G, Block X).
4. Cut six 2 1/2" x 42" strips for binding.

## APPLIQUÉS:

[Note: The appliqué can be done using your favorite hand or machine method. Templates can be drawn onto template plastic, fusible web or freezer paper. Templates do not include seam allowances.]

1. **Pattern #17020 – EGG1 (tone-on-tone):** Cut five from Petal template 2.
2. **Pattern #17020 – BEI1 (tone-on-tone):** Cut one from Star template and one from Flower template.
3. **Pattern #17020 – GOL1 (tone-on-tone):** Cut one from Star template.
4. **Pattern #17021 – BEI1 (star swirl):** Cut one from Small Circle template.
5. **Pattern #17021 – OLI1 (star swirl):** Cut one from Star template and one from Large Circle template.
6. **Pattern #17022 – SAG1 (stars and sprigs):** Cut two from Small Circle template.
7. **Pattern #17023 – RED1 (star plaid):** Cut one from Small Circle template and four from Petal template 1.
8. **Pattern #17023 – LTBEI1 (star plaid):** Cut one from Star template.
9. **Pattern #17025 – YEL1 (flower toss):** Cut five from Petal template 3.

## PIECING INSTRUCTIONS:

Use 1/4" seam allowances.

**A. Block X:** Refer to photo for fabric combinations.

1. The Flying Geese Unit:



- a. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each D square.
- b. Position a D square right sides together with a C rectangle, corners matching. Stitch on the line. Cut 1/4" away from the stitching line. Press toward D (Figure 1).
- c. Position a second C square right sides together on the opposite corner of the unit. Stitch on the line. Cut 1/4" away from the stitching line. Press toward C (Figure 2). Repeat to make sixteen D/C/D units.

2. The E/F unit:



- a. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each F square (Figure 3).
- b. Position each F square right sides together with an E square. Stitch 1/4" to each side of the drawn line. Cut on the line.
- c. Press each unit toward E. Trim the "dog ears". Make sixteen E/F units.

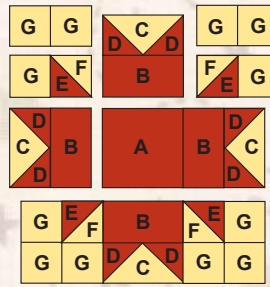
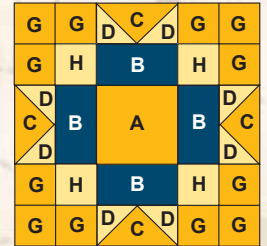

**B. Block Y:** Refer to photo for fabric combinations.

1. Follow the directions for Block X to make five Block Y. Notice that in Block Y, H squares replace the E/F units of Block X.

## QUILT ASSEMBLY:

Refer to quilt diagram and cover photo.

1. Arrange the blocks into three rows of three blocks each with sashing strips in between. Sew into rows. Press toward the sashing.
2. Arrange four rows of sashing and cornerstones. Sew together. Press toward the sashing.
3. Sew all rows together. Press toward the sashing rows.
4. Outer border:
  - a. Sew the outer border strips together end-to-end. Press seams open.
  - b. Cut four strips equal to the length and width of the quilt. Sew two strips to the sides of the quilt. Press toward the strips.
  - c. Sew the outer border corner squares to each end of the two remaining outer border strips. Press toward the strips. Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press toward the strips.



**FINISHING:**

1. Prepare the backing to measure 56" x 56".
2. Layer quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Trim the batting and backing even with the quilt top.
5. Join binding strips with a diagonal seam. Press seams open. Apply binding using your favorite method.
