



O' Snowy Night

The reverence of the Nativity is combined with the splendor of nature in this inaugural fabric collection from Carrie-Along-Quilts. The large-scale scenic features snow-people who stand in for the familiar, Nativity participants. Woodland animals come to pay homage at the crèche that is formed with tall, bowed evergreens. A lovely, multi-section repeating stripe will find many uses and has ample cutting space. A delightful print of all of the snow-people against a snowy background will lend itself as both a thematic all-over print but also can be fussy cut to highlight the motifs. A small-scale tossed woodland print is just darling with its soft background of drifted snow. A coordinate print of pine cone branches and berries is offered in beige, soft green and rich brown background colors. A small, ribbon-style stripe adds definition and is oh-so-usable! Its perfect not only for bindings but also for borders (cut it horizontally!) and striking sashing for a bar-style quilt. Finally, an extraordinary semi-tonal print features finely etched trees placed against a delicate snowy background. The five rich colorways will have this print flying off of your shelves! Extra! There are several new colors of Tokyo that were developed specifically to coordinate with this group.

Don't forget your display!

Set the stage by using our project quilt as your backdrop or draped over your table! Fashion some easy-to-make snow-people using white cotton batting (batting with scrim works best). Sew various sizes of tubes, softly stuff and then tie in two places with quilting thread, floss or twine. Create facial features with pigma pens, beads or buttons and add any other details that you wish. Offer a quick class or demo showing how to use both the striped prints to make easy tree skirts! Determine finished circle size of skirt; divide into eight wedges. Cut eight wedges horizontally across the stripe. Sew wedges together into circle. Quilt or tie with batting and backing. Cut open side and small center hole for tree trunk; bind. The small stripe makes an adorable skirt for a mini-tree and the large repeating stripe is perfect for a full-size tree. Consider using an actual wedge ruler to cut the pieces and create another add-on sale!

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
