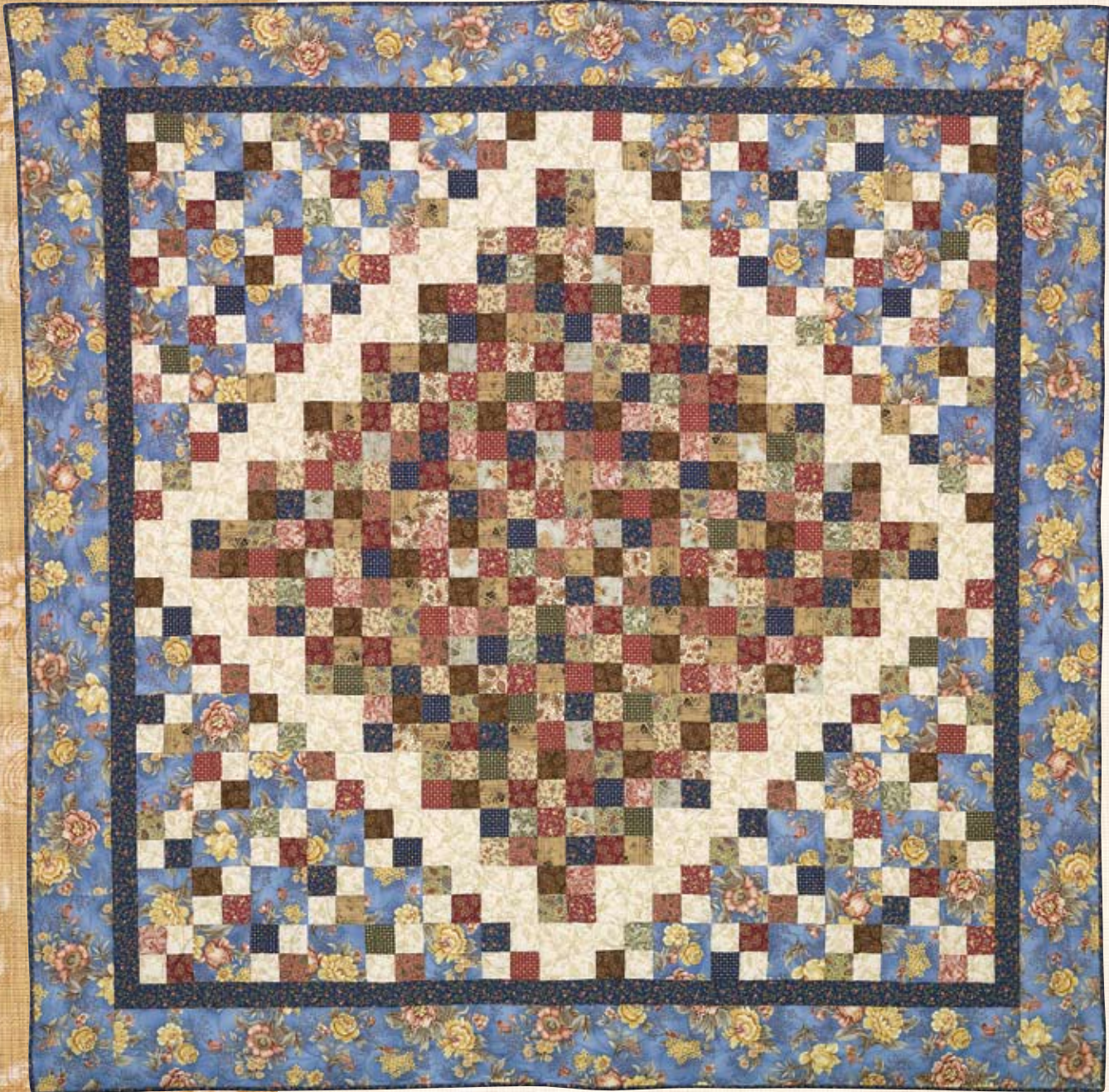


# Canterbury

Fabric, quilt design and piecing by Robert Callaham

Melissa Reyes of BearPaw Quilting



Finished quilt size: 80" x 80"

Fabric from the "Canterbury" collection (style #3353) by Robert Callahan for Red Rooster Fabrics.

### FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:

- Pattern #18170 – BLU1 ..... 3¼ yards  
 18172 – BLU1 ..... 1½ yards  
 (includes binding)  
 18174 – LTBE11 ..... 1⅔ yards  
 Plus ⅓ yard of each of the following:  
 18171 – SAG1  
 18172 – BE11, DKPIN,  
 18173 – DKBLU1, OLI1, RED1  
 18174 – CRE1, PIN1, SAG1  
 18175 – GRE1, PIN1  
 18176 – BRO1, RED1  
 18177 – BRO1, GRE1

Backing (fabric of choice) ..... 7¼ yards  
 Batting ..... 86" x 86"

### CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

Canterbury is a scrappy quilt. Use the cover photo to help choose the color fabrics (from the ⅓ yard cuts) to use in the scrappy four-patch units.

#### Pattern #18170 – BLU1 (large floral):

1. Cut six 5" x 42" strips. Crosscut into forty-eight 5" squares (A).
2. Cut ten 7" x 42" strips for outer border (B).

#### Pattern #18172 – BLU1 (calico):

1. Cut eight 2½" x 42" strips for inner border (C).
2. Cut nine 2½" x 42" strips for binding.

#### Pattern #18174 – LTBE11 (paisley):

1. Cut four 5" x 42" strips. Crosscut into twenty-eight 5" squares (D).
2. Cut eleven 2¾" x 42" strips. Crosscut sixty-four 2¾" x 6" sections (E).

#### From remainder of fabric:

1. Cut 2¾" x 42" strips. From the assorted prints, crosscut 2¾" x 6" sections.

### PIECING INSTRUCTIONS:

#### Background Four-Patch Unit:

1. Sew a 2¾" x 6" strip (E) to sixty-four of the 2¾" x 6" assorted prints. Cut into two 2¾" x 5" sections. You will need sixty-four assorted combinations. Sew these 2¾" x 5" sections together randomly into four-patch units (Figure 1). Make sixty-four. Press.

#### Scrappy Four-Patch Unit:

1. In the same manner as the background unit, sew two different 2¾" x 6" print strips together. Cut into 2¾" x 5" sections. Sew these 2¾" x 5" sections together randomly into scrappy four-patch units (Figure 2). Make eighty-five. Press.

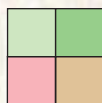

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### QUILT ASSEMBLY:

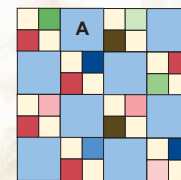


Figure 3 Make four.

1. Piece together eight background four-patch units and eight 5" floral squares (A). Referring to Figure 3, carefully position each background four-patch unit as shown. Make four. Press.

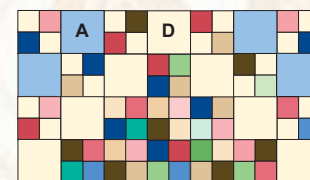


Figure 4 Make four.

2. Piece four 5" floral squares, seven 5" background squares (D), eight background four-patch units, and nine scrappy four-patch units as shown (Figure 4). Make four. Press.

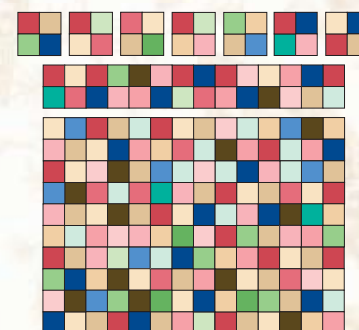
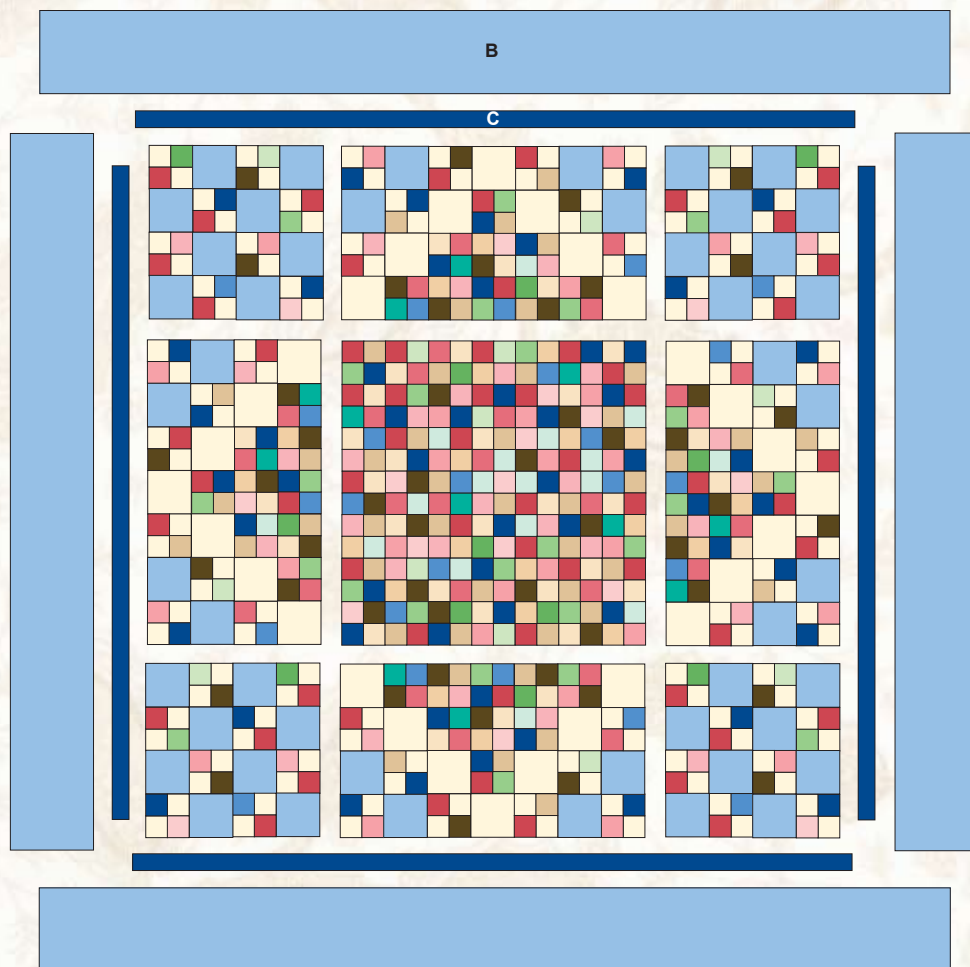


Figure 5 Make one.

3. Randomly sew together forty-nine scrappy four-patch units in seven rows of seven (Figure 5). Press.
4. Arrange the nine completed units as shown in the Quilt Diagram. Sew the units together.
5. **Inner Border:** Sew two 2½" x 42" strips together to make one long strip (C). Make four. Cut two lengths equal to the length of the quilt. Sew to sides of quilt. Press toward border. Cut two lengths equal to width of quilt. Sew to top and bottom of quilt. Press toward border.
6. **Outer Border:** Sew two 7" x 42" strips together to make one long strip (B). Make two. Cut two lengths equal to the length of the quilt. Sew to sides of quilt. Press toward border.  
 Sew three 7" x 42" strips together to make one long strip (B). Make two. Cut two lengths equal to width of quilt. Sew to top and bottom of quilt. Press toward border.
