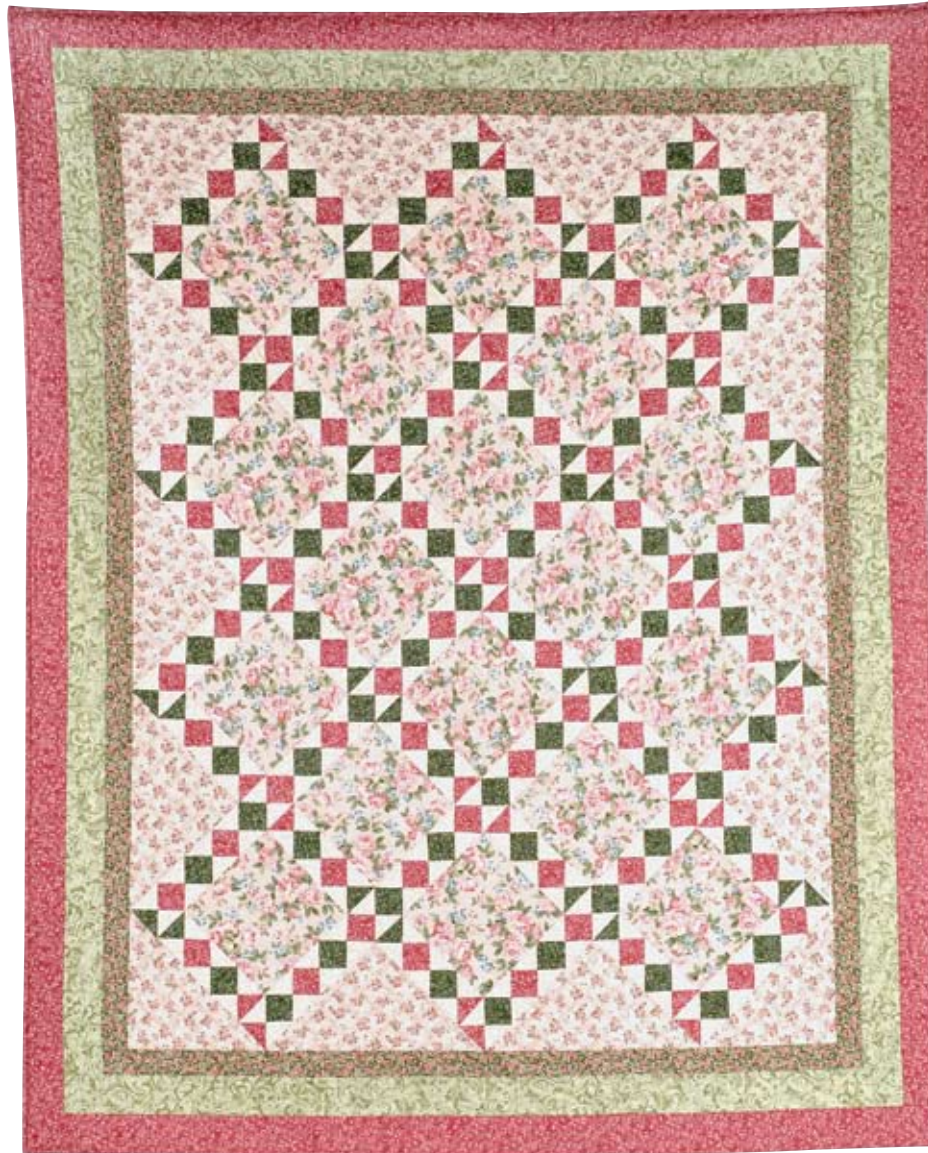


Katelyn's Garden

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Pattern #16239 – PIN1	1½ yards
16240 – PEA1	5½ yards (backing)
16241 – PIN1	1½ yards
16243 – DKPEA1	⅝ yard
16244 – BEI1	1⅜ yards
16244 – DKPIN1	2¼ yards (includes ⅝ yard for binding)
16244 – DKGRE1	¾ yard
16245 – GRE1	⅞ yard
Batting	78" x 95"

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS *Cut fabrics in order given.*

A. Pattern #16239 – PIN1 (large floral):

1. Cut five 9½" x 42" strips. Crosscut eighteen 9½" squares (A).

B. Pattern #16241 – PIN1 (lattice floral):

1. Cut two 18¼" x 42" strips. Crosscut three 18¼" squares. Cut the squares in half twice on the diagonal. Yield: twelve setting triangles (E).

2. Cut two 12" squares from the remaining fabric. Cut the squares in half once on the diagonal. Yield: four corner triangles (F).

C. Pattern #16243 – DKPEA1 (small blossoms):

1. Cut seven 2½" x 42" strips for first border (G).

D. Pattern #16244 – BEI1 (tone-on-tone leaves):

1. Cut ten 4¼" x 42" strips. Crosscut eighty-eight 4¼" squares (B).

E. Pattern #16244 – DKPIN1 (tone-on-tone leaves):

1. Cut five 4¼" x 42" strips. Crosscut forty-four 4¼" squares (C).

2. Cut eight 3½" x 42" strips for third border (I).

3. Cut nine 2½" x 42" strips for binding.

F. Pattern #16244 – DKGRE1 (tone-on-tone leaves):

1. Cut five 4¼" x 42" strips. Crosscut forty-four 4¼" squares (D).

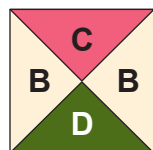
G. Pattern #16245 – GRE1 (scroll):

1. Cut seven 3½" x 42" strips for second border (H).

PIECING INSTRUCTIONS

Blocks for pieced sashing:

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each 4¼" beige B square as in Figure 1.
2. Place a beige B square on top of each C and D square, right sides facing. Sew ¼" from each side of drawn line, as in Figure 2.



Finished block size: 3"
Make 175.

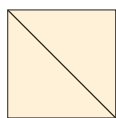

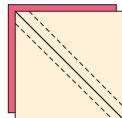
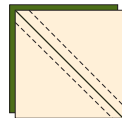

3. Cut between rows of stitching to make two half-square triangles. Press seams toward dark fabric. Yield: forty-four dark green and forty-four dark pink half-square triangle units, as in Figure 3.

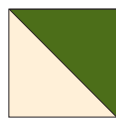
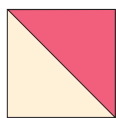

4. Draw a diagonal line, perpendicular to the seam, on the wrong side of the pink units from Step 3.
5. Place a pink unit right sides together with a green unit, with seams matching and the pink and green triangles each facing a beige triangle. Sew ¼" from each side of the drawn line.
6. Cut between rows of stitching to create two hourglass units. Press seam allowance to one side. Yield: 176 hourglass units. You will use 175 units for the pieced sashing.

ASSEMBLY

1. For the block rows, sew together three hourglass units for each side sash unit as shown in Figure 4. Make twenty-four. Referring to Figure 5, sew the side sash units and 9½" large floral squares into rows, alternating the direction of the pink and green triangles, and beginning and ending each row with a side sash unit, as shown. Press seams toward A.
2. For the sashing rows, sew together the following number of hourglass units:
 - Rows 1 and 6: 5 units each
 - Rows 2 and 5: 13 units each
 - Rows 3 and 4: 21 units each
 - Middle row: 25 units
3. Complete the rows by sewing the setting triangles (E) to the beginning and end of each row. Press toward E. Sew one F triangle to each corner, matching centers. Press toward F.
4. Sew the rows together, matching seams.
5. Trim edges of quilt if necessary.
6. First border: Sew the seven 2½" strips together end-to-end. Press seams open. Cut two strips equal to the length of the quilt and sew to sides of quilt. Press seams toward borders. Repeat for top and bottom of quilt.
7. Second border: Sew the seven 3½" strips together end-to-end. Press seams open. Cut two strips equal to the length of the quilt and sew to sides of quilt. Press seams toward borders. Repeat for top and bottom of quilt.
8. Third border: Sew the eight 3½" strips together end-to-end. Press seams open. Cut two strips equal to the length of the quilt and sew to sides of quilt. Press seams toward borders. Repeat for top and bottom of quilt.

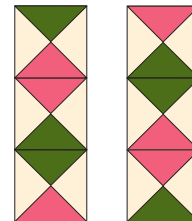

FINISHING:

- A. Prepare backing with vertical seams to measure 78" x 95".
Press seams open.
- B. Layer quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste layers together.

- C. Quilt as desired.
- D. Trim batting and backing even with the quilt top.
- E. Join binding strips with diagonal seams. Apply binding using your favorite method.

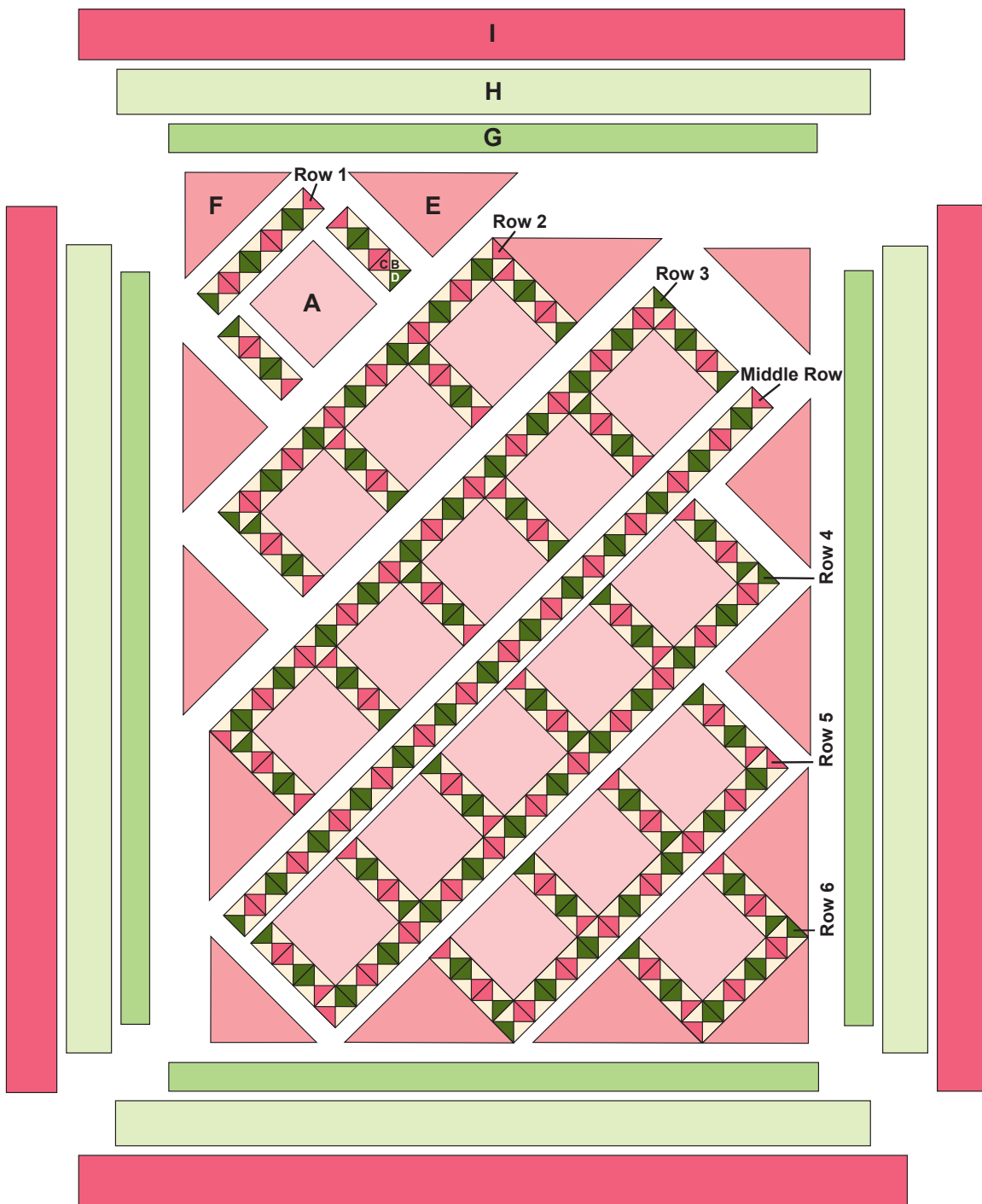

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Pattern #16239 – BLU1.....	1/3 yard
16240 – BLU1.....	1¾ yards (backing)
16241 – BLU1.....	5/8 yard
16244 – BE11.....	7/8 yard
16244 – GRE1.....	1/2 yard
16244 – DKBLU1.....	7/8 yard (includes 1/2 yard for binding)
Batting.....	29" x 63"

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS *Cut fabrics in order given.*

- A. Pattern #16239 – BLU1 (large floral):**
1. Cut one 9½" x 42" strip. Crosscut three 9½" squares (A).
- B. Pattern #16241 – BLU1 (lattice floral):**
1. Cut one 18¼" square. Cut the square in half twice on the diagonal. Yield: four setting triangles (E).
- C. Pattern #16244 – BE11 (tone-on-tone leaves):**
1. Cut six 4¼" x 42" strips. Crosscut forty-six 4¼" squares (B).
- D. Pattern #16244 – GRE1 (tone-on-tone leaves):**
1. Cut three 4¼" x 42" strips. Crosscut twenty-three 4¼" squares (D).
- E. Pattern #16244 – DKBLU1 (tone-on-tone leaves):**
1. Cut three 4¼" x 42" strips. Crosscut twenty-three 4¼" squares (C).
2. Cut four 2½" x 42" strips for binding.

PIECING INSTRUCTIONS

Follow Piecing Instructions #1–6 for the quilt to make the hourglass units. Make forty-six.

ASSEMBLY

- Sew together three hourglass units for each of the six side sash units (see Figure 4). Sew the side sash units to the 9½" squares and the setting triangles (E), as shown in the photo at left.
- For the sashing rows, sew together the following number of hourglass units:
Rows 1 and 4: 5 units each
Rows 2 and 3: 9 units each
- Sew the rows together, matching seams.
- Trim the edges of the table runner if needed.

FINISHING:

- Cut backing fabric to measure 29" x 63".
- Layer quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste layers together.
- Quilt as desired.
- Trim batting and backing even with the table runner top.
- Join binding strips with diagonal seams. Apply binding using your favorite method.



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
