## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Pattern #16024 – CRE1 .....	7/8 yard
16025 – BRO1 .....	1/4 yard
16025 – CRE1 .....	1/4 yard
16026 – PIN1 .....	1/2 yard
16027 – CRE1 .....	1/4 yard
16027 – PIN1 .....	1/4 yard
16027 – GRE1 .....	1/4 yard
16028 – CRE1 .....	1/4 yard
16028 – PIN1 .....	1/4 yard
16028 – GRE1 .....	1/4 yard
16028 – BRO1 .....	1/4 yard
16029 – PIN1 .....	1/4 yard
16029 – GRE1 .....	1/4 yard
16030 – BRO1 .....	1/4 yard
	plus 1/2 yard for binding
16030 – TAN1 .....	1/4 yard
16031 – GRE1 .....	1/4 yard
16031 – CRE1 .....	1/4 yard
Batting .....	56" x 56"
Backing .....	3 1/4 yards
	of fabric of your choice

## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

For each block choose 1 Brown, 1 Pink or Green and 1 Cream or Tan Background (from the 1/4 yard cuts). Cut as follows:

### A. Brown print:

1. Cut four 2 1/2" squares (W).
2. Cut two 5 1/2" squares. Cut these squares diagonally in both directions to yield eight triangles (Y).

### B. Pink or Green print:

1. Cut four 2 1/2" squares (U).
2. Cut one 4 1/2" square (Z).

### C. Cream or Tan Background prints:

1. Cut eight 2 1/2" squares (V).
2. Cut two 5 1/2" squares. Cut these squares diagonally in both directions to yield eight triangles (X).

### D. Sashing - Pink Plaid:

1. Cut eight 1 1/2" x 42" strips. Subcut two strips into three 12 1/2" segments each to yield six segments.

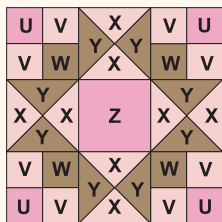
### E. Border - Large print:

1. Cut five 5" x 42" strips.

### F. Binding:

1. Cut six 2 1/2" x 42" strips.

## PIECING INSTRUCTIONS



Block size: 12" finished. Make 9 blocks.

### A. The 4-Patches:

1. Make a 4-Patch by sewing one U to one V and one V to one W (Figure 1). Press to U and W. Sew U/V to V/W. Press. Make four 4-Patches for each block.

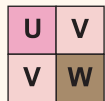

### B. The Quarter-Square Units:

1. Sew X to Y, matching corners. Press toward Y. Sew two XY units together, matching seams. Press. Repeat to make four quarter-square units as shown in Figure 2. Trim each unit to measure 4 1/2" square.

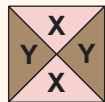

### C. Assembling the block:

1. Arrange the 4-Patches, quarter-square units, and a 4 1/2" (Z)

square as shown in Figure 3. Sew units together in rows. Press toward the quarter-square units. Join the rows to complete one block. Press. Repeat to make nine blocks.

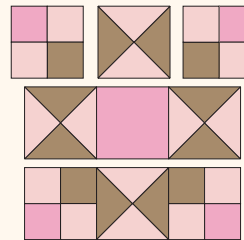

## QUILT ASSEMBLY

1. Lay out all nine blocks. Sew them together into rows with the 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" sashings in between the blocks.
2. Measure the width of the rows. Cut four sashing strips the same width. Sew the rows together with sashing in between. Sew a sashing strip to the top and bottom.
3. Measure the length of the quilt. Cut two sashing strips the same length. Sew to the sides of the quilt.
4. Attach the large print borders in the same manner.

## FINISHING

- A. Prepare the backing to measure 56" x 56". Press seams open.
- B. Layer quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste layers together.
- C. Quilt as desired.
- D. Trim edges even with quilt top.
- E. Join the binding strips with a diagonal seam. Press seams open. Apply binding to quilt using your favorite method.
