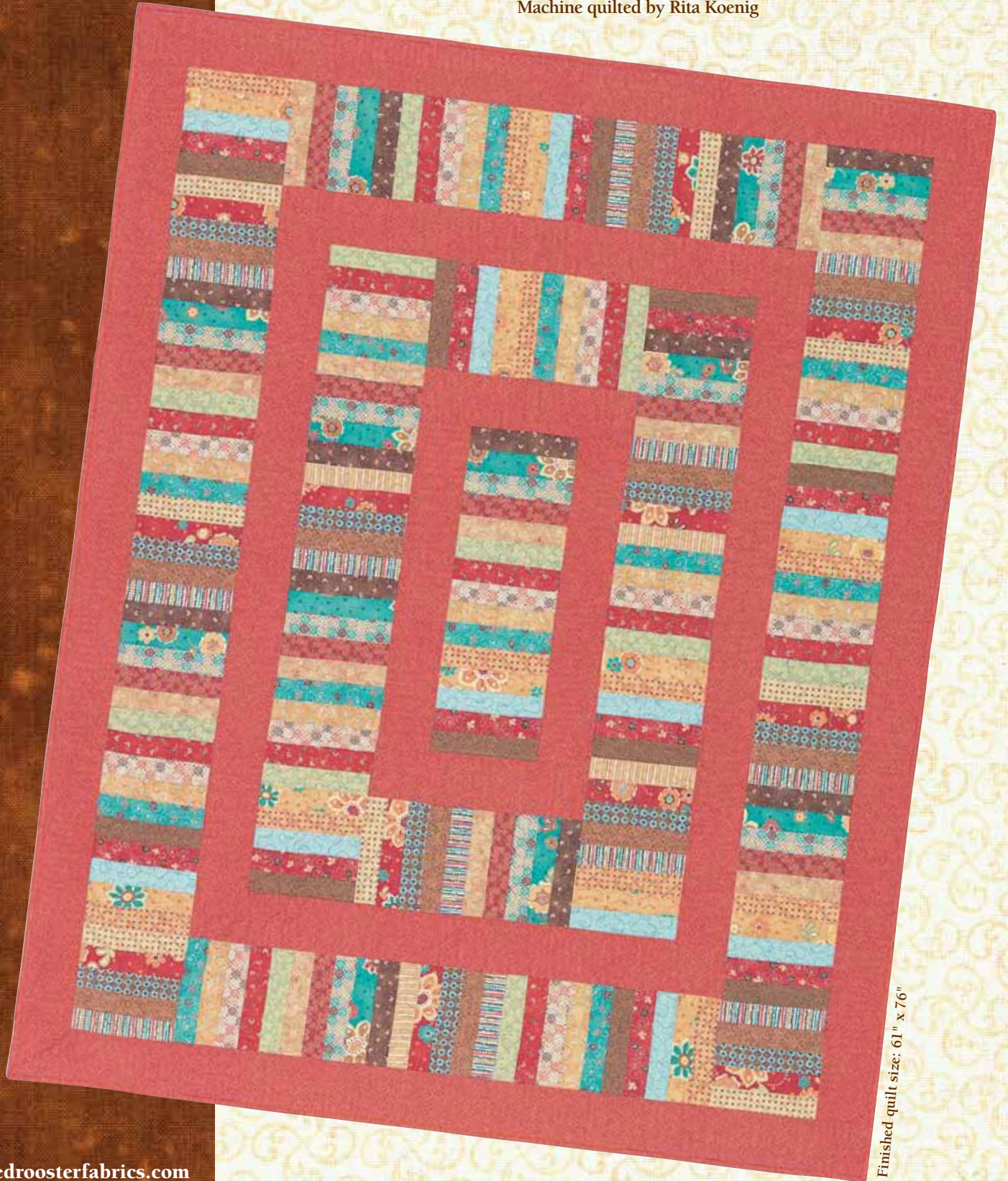


NEUTRAL TERRITORY

Finished quilt size: 61" x 76"

Fabric from the "Neutral Territory" collection (style #3595) by Liz Lois and Terry Atkinson for Red Rooster Fabrics.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:

Pattern #19422 – RED1..... 2¼ yards
(includes binding)

Plus one fat quarter of each of the following:

- #19416 – BLU1, GOL1, RED1
- #19417 – DKBEI1, MUL1, ORA1
- #19418 – GOL1, GRE1, ORA1, RED1
- #19419 – BLU1, GOL1, RED1
- #19420 – DKBEI1, LTBEI1, MUL1
- #19421 – BEI1, BRO1, RED1
- #19422 – BLU1, BRO1, GOL1

Backing (fabric of choice) 4⅞ yards

Batting 67" x 82"

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

Note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric.

Pattern #19422 – RED1:

1. Cut thirteen 4¼" strips.
2. Cut eight 2½" strips. Set aside for binding.

From each fat quarter:

1. Cut six 2" x 21" strips.

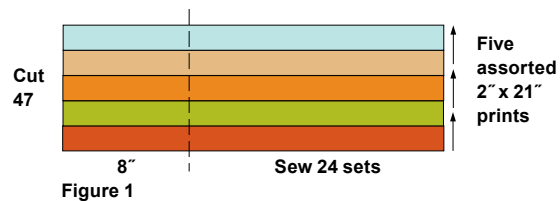


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PIECING INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Stitch twenty-four strip sets as shown in Figure 1, using five assorted 2" x 21" print strips for each set. Cut into forty-seven 8" squares.



QUILT ASSEMBLY:

Center Row and Round 1

1. Stitch three blocks together for the center row. Cut two 4¼" red strips to the exact length of the center row and stitch to the sides. Press. Cut two 4¼" red strips to the exact width of the center section and stitch to the top and bottom edges. Press.

Rounds 2 & 3

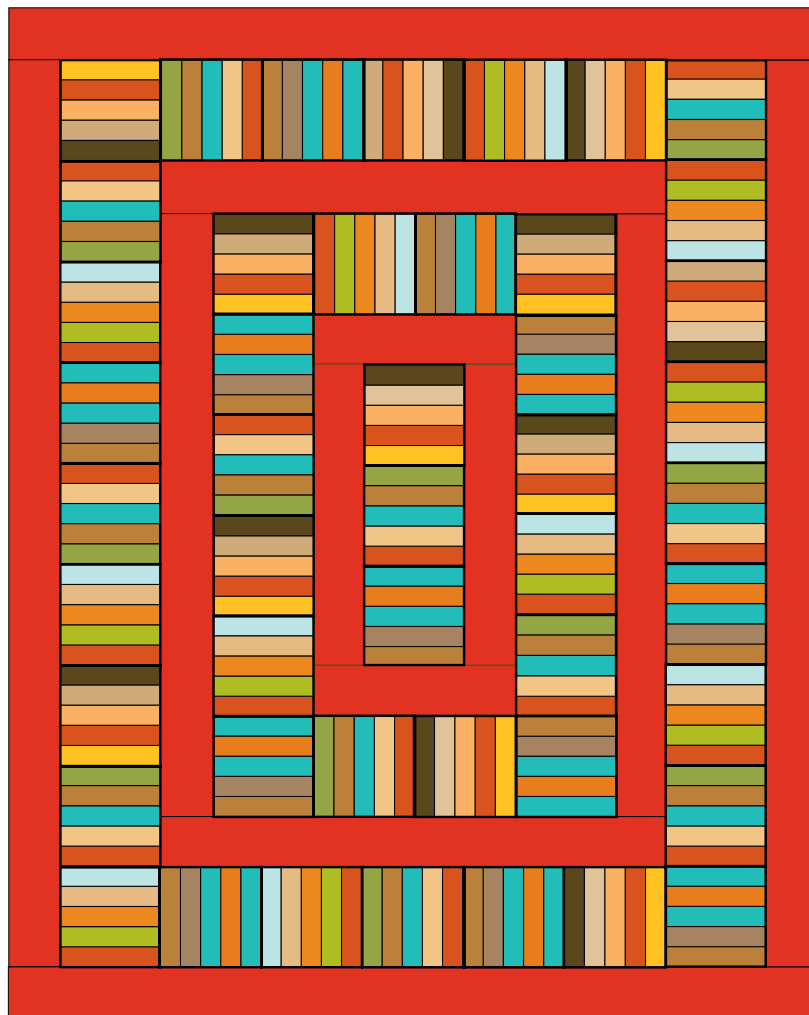
1. Add two blocks to the top and bottom, press, and then add six blocks to each side. (Note: adjust seams if needed to make them fit.) Press.
2. Stitch 4¼" red strips together as needed to make strips long enough for the quilt. Trim two strips to the exact length of the quilt. Stitch them to the sides of the quilt and press seams toward red strip. Trim two strips to the exact width of the quilt and stitch to the top and bottom edges. Press.

Rounds 4 & 5

1. Repeat rounds 2 and 3, using five blocks for the top and bottom rows and nine blocks for each side row.

FINISHING:

1. Prepare backing by joining two widths with a vertical seam. Press seam open.
2. Layer backing, batting, and quilt top. Baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Trim the batting and backing even with the quilt top.
5. Join binding strips with diagonal seams. Press seams open. Attach binding to quilt using your favorite method.
