Finished quilt size: 66" x 66"

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:

- A. Pattern #20237 – MUL1 2 yards
- B. Pattern #20238 – ORA1 1/4 yard
- C. Pattern #20238 – GRE1 5/8 yard
- D. Pattern #20239 – ORA1 3/8 yard
- E. Pattern #20240 – ORA1 7/8 yards
- F. Pattern #20243 – LTSAG1 7/8 yards
- G. Pattern #20243 – PIN1 1/2 yard
- H. Pattern #20243 – ORA1 1/2 yard
- I. Pattern #20244 – GOL1 3/4 yard
- J. Pattern #20244 – DKGRE1 1/2 yard

Tokyo Collection:

- K. Pattern #12615 – LIM1 5/8 yard (binding)
- Backing of choice 4 1/4 yards
- Batting 72" x 72"

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. 1/4" seam allowance is included in measurements and all strips are cut across the width of the fabric unless noted otherwise. Cut fabrics in order given.

A. Pattern #20237 – MUL1 (large floral):

1. Cut four 6 1/2" strips on the length of the fabric. Cut two 6 1/2" x 54 1/2" and two 6 1/2" x 66 1/2".

B. Pattern #20238 – ORA1 (orange medium floral):

1. Cut one 5 7/8" strip; subcut four 5 7/8" squares.
2. Use remainder of strip to cut one 5 1/2" square.

C. Pattern #20238 – GRE1 (green medium floral):

1. Cut one 4 3/8" strip; subcut eight 4 3/8" squares.
2. Cut two 6" strips; subcut sixteen 6" x 4 1/2" rectangles. Cut eight diagonally from the bottom left to the top right and eight diagonally from the bottom right to the top left.

D. Pattern #20239 – ORA1 (stripe):

1. Cut six 2" strips.

E. Pattern #20240 – ORA1 (orange circle print):

1. Cut one 3 3/8" strip; subcut eight 3 3/8" squares.
2. Cut two 4 7/8" strips; subcut sixteen 4 7/8" x 3 1/4" rectangles. Cut eight diagonally from the bottom left to the top right and eight diagonally from the bottom right to the top left.
3. Cut two 6 1/4" strips; subcut sixteen 6 1/4" x 3 1/8" rectangles. Cut eight diagonally from bottom left to top right and eight diagonally from bottom right to top left.

F. Pattern #20243 – LTSAG1 (tonal leaf print):

1. Cut one 3 3/8" strip; subcut eight 3 3/8" squares.
2. Cut two 4 7/8" strips; subcut sixteen 4 7/8" x 3 1/4" rectangles. Cut eight diagonally from bottom left to top right and eight diagonally from bottom right to top left.
3. Cut two 6 1/4" strips; subcut sixteen 6 1/4" x 3 1/8" rectangles. Cut eight diagonally from bottom left to top right and eight diagonally from bottom right to top left.

G. Pattern #20243 – PIN1 (tonal leaf print):

1. Cut four 3 7/8" strips; subcut thirty-two 3 7/8" squares.

H. Pattern #20243 – ORA1 (tonal leaf print):

1. Cut four 3 7/8" strips; subcut thirty-two 3 7/8" squares.

I. Pattern #20244 – GOL1 (large dot):

1. Cut one 5 7/8" strip; subcut two 5 7/8" squares. Cut diagonally in half to yield four half-square triangles.
2. Cut one 4 3/8" strip; subcut eight 4 3/8" squares.
3. Cut two 6" strips; subcut sixteen 6" x 4 1/2" rectangles. Cut eight diagonally from bottom left to top right and eight diagonally from bottom right to top left.

J. Pattern #20244 – DKGRE1 (large dot):

1. Cut one 5 1/2" strip; subcut four 5 1/2" squares.

2. Cut one 5 7/8" strip; subcut four 5 7/8" squares. Use the remainder of the strip to cut two 4 3/8" squares. Cut the 4 3/8" squares in half diagonally to yield four half-square triangles.

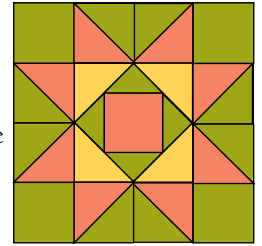
K. Pattern #12615 – LIM 1 (tonal mottled fabric):

1. Cut seven 2 1/2" strips for the binding.

PIECING INSTRUCTIONS:

A. Center Star

1. Referring to Figure 1, construct eight star point units using four [J] 5 7/8" squares and four [B] 5 7/8" squares. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each [J] square. With right sides together, pair each marked square with a [B] square. Stitch 1/4" on each side of the drawn line. Cut apart on drawn line. Press seams to one side. Makes eight half-square triangle units.

Make 1.

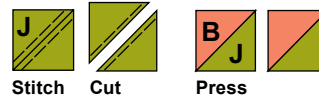

2. Construct the square-in-a-square unit for the star center.

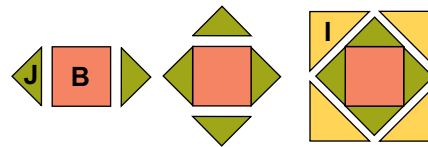


Figure 2 **Finished Unit Size: 10"**

 - a. Sew a [J] triangle to opposite sides of the [B] 5 1/2" square. Press seams toward the triangles. Sew the remaining [J] triangles to the remaining sides of the square. Press. (Figure 2.)

- b. Repeat the process using the [I] 5 7/8" triangles and sewing them to the unit completed above.
3. Sew two Step 1 units together to make one star point unit. Make four.
4. Sew a star point unit to each side of the center unit. Press toward the center unit.
5. Sew one [J] 5 1/2" square to each end of the remaining star point units. Press seams toward the squares. Sew to top and bottom to complete the Center Star Block. (Figure 3.)

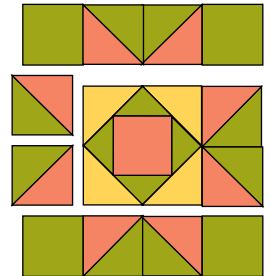

B. Border #1

Square-in-a-Square Blocks

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of eight [I] 4 3/8" squares. With right sides together, pair each marked square with a [C] 4 3/8" square. Stitch 1/4" on each side of the drawn line. Cut apart on drawn line. Press toward the [C] triangles. Make sixteen half-square triangle units. (Refer back to Figure 1 for detail.)
2. Sew four half-square triangle units together as shown in Figure 4 to complete one block. Press. Repeat to make four blocks.

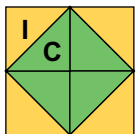

Diamond-in-a-Rectangle Blocks

TIP for sewing the triangles for all the rectangular blocks: When sewing the bias seams of these triangles, I found it easier to stabilize them first. Place a sheet of lightweight paper, such as unprinted newsprint, under a set of matched triangles and pin their bias edges to a straight edge of the paper. Pin one set of triangles to each edge of the paper. Sew 1/4" seams then rip away the paper.

1. Lay out all pieces of each block before sewing.
2. Sew one [C] 6" x 4 1/2" triangle to one [I] 6" x 4 1/2" triangle, matching

seam points. Press seam toward the [C] triangles.
Repeat for each set of triangles.

3. Sew four triangle units together as shown in Figure 5 to complete one block. Press. Repeat to make eight blocks.

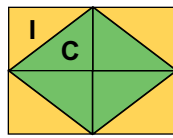

C. Border #2

1. Refer to Border #1, Square-in-a-Square Blocks. Use eight [F] 3¾" squares and eight [E] 3¾" squares to make four blocks. (Figure 6.)
2. Refer to Border #1, Diamond-in-a-Rectangle Blocks. Use four [F] 4⅞" x 3¼" triangles and four [E] 4⅞" x 3¼" triangles to make eight blocks. (Figure 7.)
3. Refer to Border #1, Diamond-in-a-Rectangle Blocks. Use four [F] 6¼" x 3¼" triangles and four [E] 6¼" x 3¼" triangles to make eight blocks. (Figure 8.)

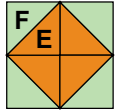

Make 4.

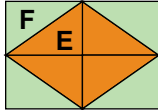

7½" x 5". Make 8.

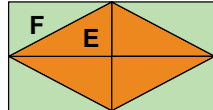

QUILT ASSEMBLY:

Completing Border #1

1. Sew Border #1 units together and sew to quilt as shown in Quilt Diagram. Press.

Constructing Border #2

1. Sew Border #2 units together and sew to quilt as shown in Quilt Diagram. Press.

Half-Square Triangle Border

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of thirty-two [G] 3⅞" squares. Pair each marked square with an [H] 3⅞" square. Stitch ¼" on each side of the drawn line. Cut apart on drawn line. Press seam toward [H] triangles. Make sixty-four half-square-triangle units. (Refer back to Figure 1 for detail.)
2. For each side border, sew fifteen triangle units together, as shown in quilt diagram and photo; press. Sew border to each side of quilt. Press seams toward borders.
3. For the top and bottom border, sew seventeen triangle units together; press. Sew top and bottom borders to quilt. Press seams toward borders.

Striped Border

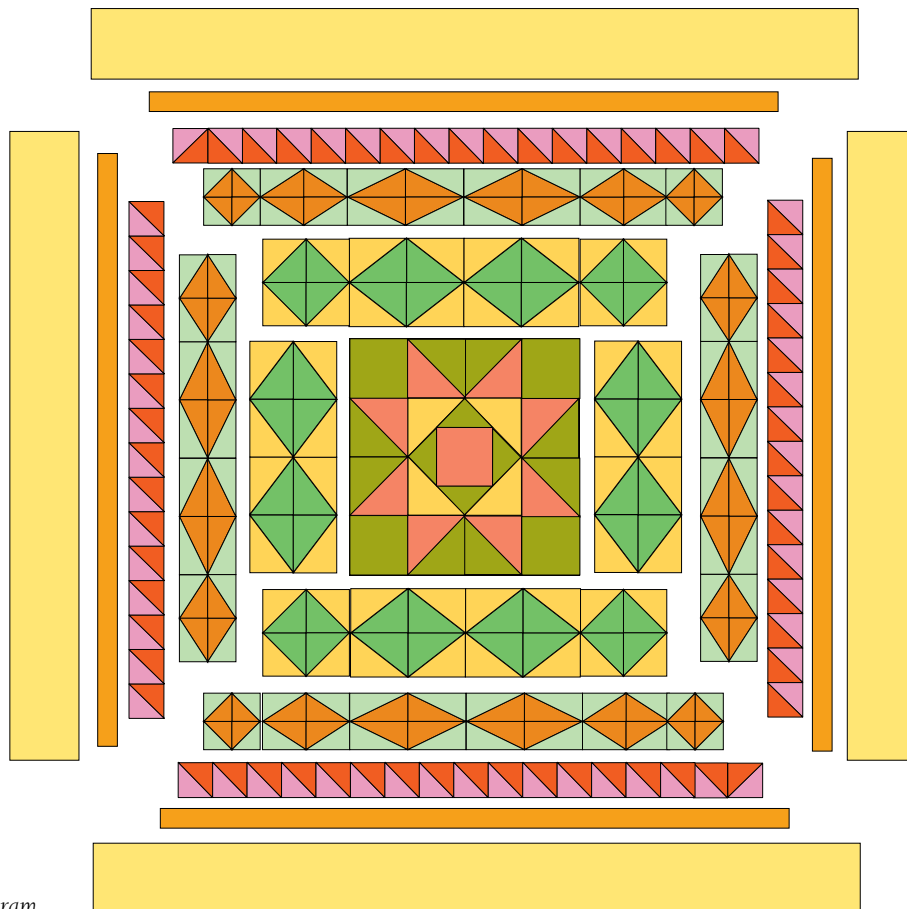
1. Sew the five [D] 2" strips together end to end; press. Cut two 2" x 51½" strips and two 2" x 54½" strips. Sew one 2" x 51½" strip to each side of the quilt. Press toward the borders. Sew one 2" x 54½" strip to the top and the bottom of the quilt. Press toward the borders.

Outer Border

1. Sew an [A] 6½" x 54½" to each side of the quilt. Press toward outer borders. Sew an [A] 6½" x 66½" to the top and bottom of the quilt; press.

FINISHING:

1. Prepare a backing using two widths of fabric. Press seam open.
2. Layer quilt top, batting, and backing; baste. Quilt as desired.
3. Trim batting and backing even with quilt top.
4. Join [K] binding strips. Sew binding to quilt using your favorite method.
