FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:

Pattern #18178 – MUL1	1 panel
18179 – RED1	1½ yards
18180 – MUL1	¾ yard
18181 – MUL1	⅔ yard
18182 – RED1	⅔ yard
18182 – YEL1	⅔ yard
18183 – DKBLU1	1 yard
18292 – MUL1	1 yard
Backing	3½ yards
Batting	55" x 64"

ADDITIONAL SUPPLIES:

•For turned edge machine appliqué method:

Template plastic or freezer paper
Basting glue
Invisible thread
Ten 8" squares of tear-away stabilizer

•For hand appliqué method:

Template plastic

PREPARATION FOR HAND OR MACHINE APPLIQUÉ:

- Trace a 6½" circle onto the template plastic. Seam allowance is not included. If you need a circle template, you can download one from the Tiny Tots' quilt pattern page at: www.redroosterfabrics.com/quilt/

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

Cut fabrics in order given.

A. Pattern #18178 – MUL1 (panel):

- For either the hand or machine appliqué method, use the 6½" circle template to trace the circular motif on the wrong side of each "page" of the panel. The seam allowance is not included on the template. Cut out the circle motifs, leaving a ¼" seam allowance.

B. Pattern #18179 – RED1 (tossed toys):

- Cut two strips, 6" x 54" (length of fabric), for side outer borders.
- Cut four strips, 6" x remaining width of fabric (approximately 30"), for top and bottom outer borders.

C. Pattern #18180 – MUL1 (dots):

- Cut one 10¼" x 42" strip. Crosscut three 10¼" squares. Cut each square twice on the diagonal (A).
- Cut one 9⅞" x 42" strip. Crosscut two 9⅞" squares (E).

D. Pattern #18181 – MUL1 (stripe):

- Cut as many 2½" bias strips as needed to equal 230" (binding).

E. Pattern #18182 – RED1 (tossed outlines):

- Cut one 10¼" x 42" strip. Crosscut three 10¼" squares. Cut each square twice on the diagonal (B).

F. Pattern #18182 – YEL1 (tossed outlines):

- Cut one 10¼" x 42" strip. Crosscut three 10¼" squares. Cut each square twice on the diagonal (C).
- Cut one 9⅞" x 42" strip. Crosscut two 9⅞" squares (F).

G. Pattern #18183 – DKBLU1 (stars):

- Cut one 10¼" x 42" strip. Crosscut two 10¼" squares. Cut each square twice on the diagonal (D).
- Cut two 5" x 42" strips. Crosscut twelve 5" squares (G).
- Cut five 2" x 42" strips (inner border).

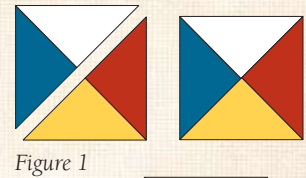
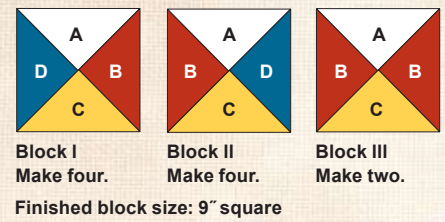
H. Pattern #18292 – MUL1 (tossed children):

- Fussy cut twelve 5" squares from desired images (H).

PIECING INSTRUCTIONS:

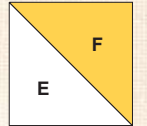
A. Quarter-square triangle Blocks I, II and III:

- Referring to Figure 1, sew triangles A, B, C and D together to make Blocks I, II, and III, as shown. Make the number of blocks indicated. Press so that seams are opposing. (Two A triangles and two C triangles will be leftover.)
- Appliquing the circle motifs:
 - Turn under the edges of each circle using your favorite method.
 - Center the circles on the quarter-square triangle blocks. Refer to photo for positioning. Pin, baste, or glue-baste in place.
 - Appliqué the circles to the blocks by hand or machine.
 - From the wrong side, trim away the center of the quarter-square triangle blocks, ¼" inside the appliqué stitching.



B. Half-square triangle Block IV:

- Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the E squares. Pair each E square, right sides together, with an F square. Stitch ¼" away from each side of the drawn line. Cut apart on the line. Press toward F. Make four of Block IV.



C. Checkerboard (refer to photo):

- Sew two 5" blue G squares to two 5" H squares, alternating squares (Figure 2). Press toward G. Make six rows. Make three GHGH rows and three HGHG rows.
- Sew the rows together as shown in the cover photo to complete the checkerboard. Press.

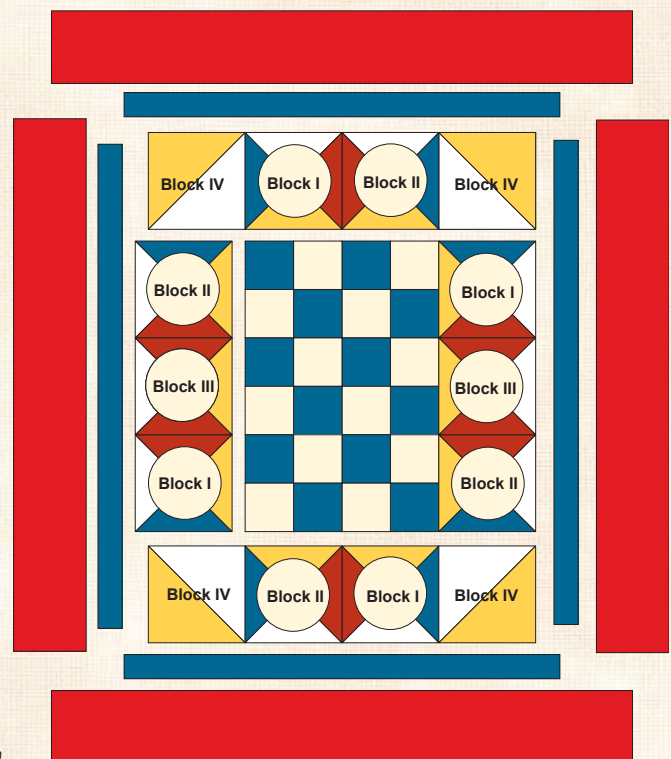


QUILT ASSEMBLY:

- Arrange blocks and checkerboard as shown in Quilt Diagram. Refer to cover photo for positioning.
- Sew together the top row and bottom row of blocks. Press the center seam open and the remaining seams toward Block IV.
- Sew together the side rows of blocks. Press seams open.
- Sew the side rows of blocks to each side of the checkerboard. Press toward the checkerboard.
- Sew the top and bottom rows of blocks to the top and bottom of the checkerboard unit. Press toward the checkerboard.
- Inner Border:
 - Sew the five 2" inner border strips together, end to end. Press seams open.
 - Cut two lengths equal to the length of the quilt. Sew to the sides of the quilt. Press toward the border strips.
 - Cut two lengths equal to the width of the quilt. Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press toward the border strips.
- Outer Border: [Note: the outer border fabric is directional.]
 - Cut the two 6" x 54" outer border strips equal to the length of the quilt top. Sew to the sides of the quilt. Press toward the outer border strips.
 - Sew two 6" x approximately 30" outer border strips together end to end. Cut the length equal to the width of the quilt top. Sew to the top of the quilt. Press toward the outer border strip. Repeat with the two remaining 6" x 30" strips for the bottom outer border.

FINISHING:

- Prepare backing with a horizontal seam to measure 55" x 64". Press seam open.
- Layer quilt top, batting and backing.
- Quilt as desired.
- Trim layers even with quilt top.
- Join binding strips with diagonal seams. Press seams open. Apply binding to quilt using your favorite method.
- Make a label and sew to the back of the quilt.
