

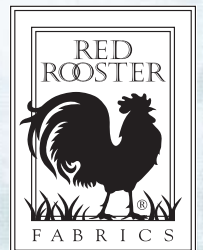

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

- A. Pattern #18422 – BRO1 (large floral border print):**
 - Cut two 6½" x width of fabric strips. Reserve for top and bottom outer border.
 - Cut two 6½" x length of fabric strips (approximately 68"). Reserve for side outer border.
- B. Pattern #18424 – BE11 (small flower print):**
 - For the background of the Flower Blocks, cut nine 2" x width of fabric strips. Crosscut one hundred seventy-six 2" squares.
- C. Pattern #18424 – CRE1 (small flower print):**
 - For the Hourglass Blocks, cut two 6¼" squares.
- D. Pattern #18424 – BLU1 (small flower print):**
 - For the Hourglass Blocks, cut two 6¼" squares.
- E. Pattern # 18424 – GOL1 (small flower print):**
 - For the Hourglass Blocks, cut two 6¼" squares.

- F. Pattern # 18425 – LTBE11 (stripe):**
 - For the Stem and Leaf Blocks, cut two 2¾" x width of fabric strips. Crosscut ten 2¾" x 5½" rectangles.
- G. Pattern # 18425 – MUL1 (stripe):**
 - For sash strips, cut seven 2½" x width of fabric strips.
- H. Pattern # 18426 – LTBLU1 (tone-on-tone):**
 - For Flower Blocks, cut two 4" x width of fabric strips. Crosscut sixteen 4" squares.
- I. Pattern #18426 – TUR1 (tone-on-tone):**
 - For Flower Blocks, cut two 4" x width of fabric strips. Crosscut sixteen 4" squares.
- J. Pattern #18426 – PIN1 (tone-on-tone):**
 - For Flower Blocks, cut two 4" x width of fabric strips. Crosscut sixteen 4" squares.
- K. Pattern #18426 – RED1 (tone-on-tone):**
 - For Flower Blocks, cut three 4" x width of fabric strips. Crosscut twenty-four 4" squares.
- L. Pattern #18426 – GOL1 (tone-on-tone):**
 - For the Flower blocks, cut two 4" x width of fabric strips. Crosscut sixteen 4" squares.
 - For red, blue, turquoise, and pink flower centers, cut three 1¼" x width of fabric strips. Crosscut seventy-two 1¼" squares.
- M. Pattern #18426 – BRO1 (tone-on-tone):**
 - For center of gold flowers, cut one 1¼" x width of fabric strip. Crosscut sixteen 1¼" squares.
 - For binding, cut seven 2½" x width of fabric strips.
- N. Pattern #18426 – DKGRE1 (tone-on-tone):**
 - For the Stem and Leaf Blocks, cut one 1" x width of fabric strip. Crosscut five 1" x 5½" rectangles.
- O. Pattern #18427 – BLU1 (small dots):**
 - For Hourglass Blocks, cut two 6¼" squares.
- P. Pattern #18427 – SAG1 (small dots):**
 - For Hourglass Blocks, cut two 6¼" squares.
- Q. Pattern # 18428 – BLU1 (circles):**
 - For Hourglass Blocks, cut two 6¼" squares.
- R. Pattern #18428 – GOL1 (circles):**
 - For Hourglass Blocks, cut two 6¼" squares.
- S. Pattern #18429 – LTBLU1 (swirls):**
 - For Hourglass Blocks, cut two 6¼" squares.
- T. Pattern #18429 – GRE1 (swirls):**
 - For Hourglass Blocks, cut two 6¼" squares.
 - For inner border, cut five 2½" x width of fabric strips.

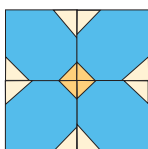
PIECING INSTRUCTIONS:

Flower Blocks

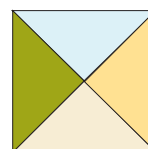
Make 22 Blocks: six #18426 – RED1, four #18426 – GOL1, four #18426 – PIN1, four #18426 – TUR1, and four #18426 – BLU1.

Note: The Flower Blocks are paper-pieced. Copy the template for the Flower Blocks so that you have 88 templates. Use 4 templates for each Flower Block. Paper-piece the blocks using your favorite method.

- Each flower is made from four 4" squares of the same color, eight 2" background squares, and four 1¼" squares for the flower centers. The gold flowers have brown centers and the remaining flowers have gold centers.
- After paper-piecing is completed, trim the units even with the outside line of the template. Units should measure 3" square.
- Arrange the units so that the flower centers meet (Figure 1). Sew units together.
- Remove the papers. Press. Blocks should measure 5½".

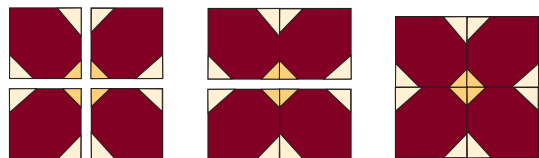

Hourglass Blocks

You have cut a total of eighteen 6¼" squares from the following fabrics: #18424 – CRE1, #18424 – BLU1, #18424 – GOL1, #18427 – BLU1, #18427 – SAG1, #18428 – BLU1, #18428 – GOL1, #18429 – LTBLU1, and #18429 – GRE1. When you sew the hourglass blocks together, mix up the fabrics for a scrappy look.

- Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of nine 6¼" squares (Figure 2).
- Place the square with the drawn line on top of another square, right sides facing. Using your ¼" sewing foot, stitch a ¼" seam allowance on each side of the drawn line, as in Figure 3.
- Cut apart between the rows of stitching to make two half-square triangle units (Figure 4). Press the seams. Repeat to make a total of eighteen half-square triangle units.

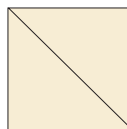

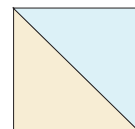
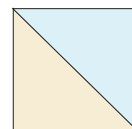

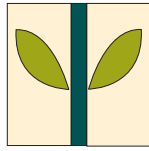


- Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of nine of the units from Figure 4, intersecting the seam.

- Pair the units with the drawn line, right sides together, with the remaining half-square triangle units, mixing colors. The seams of both units should be nestled into each other. Sew a 1/4" seam on each side of the drawn line.
- Cut apart between the rows of stitching to create two complete hour-glass blocks. Press seam allowance to one side. Repeat to complete eighteen blocks.

Leaf and Stem Blocks

- The Leaf and Stem Block is made by sewing two 2 3/4" x 5 1/2" light beige rectangles to either side of a 1" x 5 1/2" dark green rectangle (Figure 5). Press toward the dark green rectangle. Repeat to make five blocks.
- To appliqué the leaves to the blocks, trace ten leaves from the leaf template onto the paper side of fusible web. Rough cut around the leaves and fuse to the wrong side of #18427 - SAG1. Follow the manufacturer's instructions.
- Cut out the leaves on the line and fuse to the blocks as shown. Machine appliqué using the stitch of your choice.

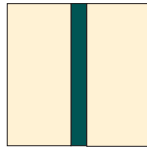

QUILT ASSEMBLY:

Blocks, Rows and Sash:

- Stitch together five vertical rows of nine blocks following the block placement in the Quilt Diagram. Press seams.

- Sew all seven of the 2 1/2"-wide sash strips together. Cut six lengths measuring 2 1/2" x 45 1/2". Sew to the vertical block rows following the placement in the Quilt Diagram. Press seams toward sash.

Inner Border:

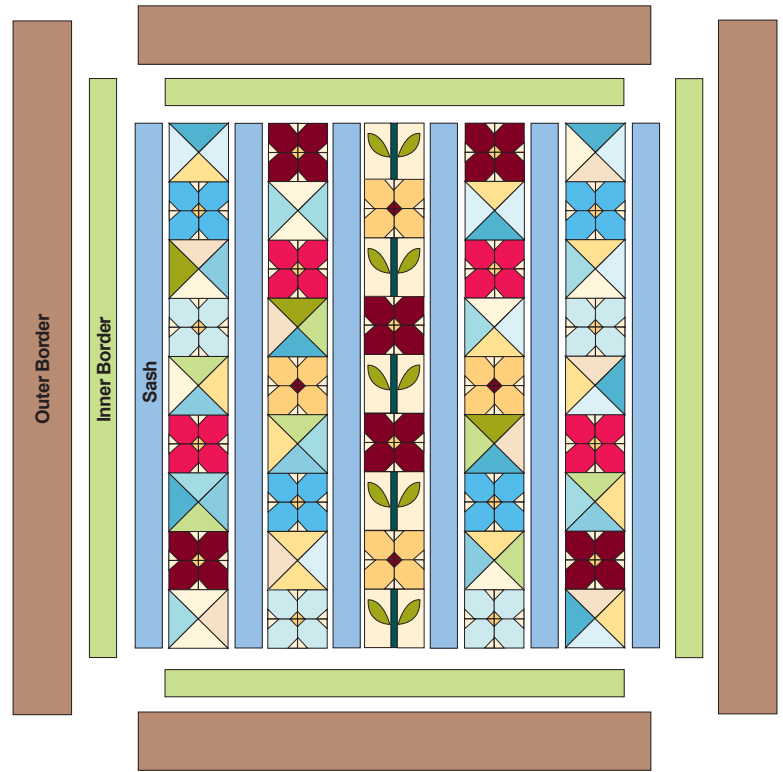
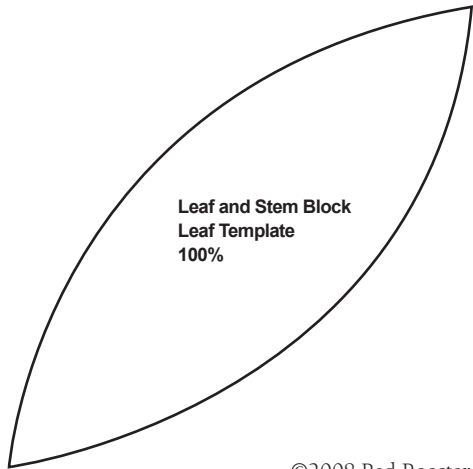
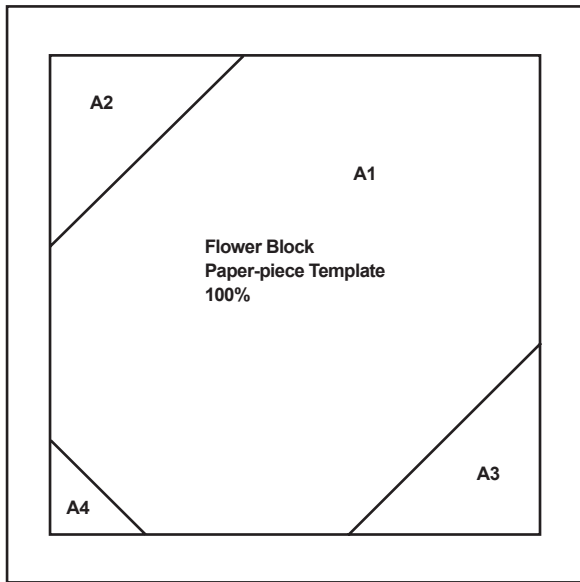
- Cut two of the 2 1/2" green strips to measure 2 1/2" x 37 1/2". Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press toward border.
- Sew the three remaining 2 1/2" green strips together, end to end. Cut two lengths measuring 2 1/2" x 49 1/2". Sew to the sides of the quilt. Press toward border.

Outer Border:

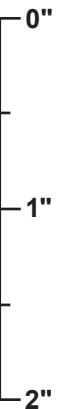
- Trim the length of the top and bottom outer border strips to measure 6 1/2" x 41 1/2". Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press toward the outer border.
- Trim the length of the side outer border strips to measure 6 1/2" x 61 1/2". Sew to the sides of the quilt. Press toward the outer border.

FINISHING:

- Prepare backing with a vertical seam to measure 59" x 67". Press seam open.
- Layer quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste layers together.
- Quilt as desired.
- Trim batting and backing even with quilt top.
- Join the binding strips with diagonal seams. Apply binding using your favorite method.



Scale Check for pdf files
