COLOR COLLAGE

The Color Collage texture is a subtle, irregular stripe that is a “must-have” for any quilter’s stash! The ten colorways offer all kinds of possibilities. Think baskets, spools of thread, colorful houses, and evergreen trees. It’s especially interesting cut into triangles and would make a great flying geese border. Display a stack of fat quarters with some of the books suggested below and a basket or fabric bowl of decorative threads and fancy fibers. The Color Collage texture will be introduced at International Quilt Market in Minneapolis in May, 2006.
