ILLUSION

Illusion is a stylish new texture with amazing depth. The little squares appear to be floating on the glowing background! These not-quite-monochromatic textures make great prints to feature in a contemporary quilt or to use as blenders. Cut a few fat quarter packs from the Illusion texture and place them on a table covered with black fabric. Add some books about color and contemporary design and C&T's 3-in-1 Color Tool to inspire your customers. Arrange a basket of blended-color threads from Sulky, Valdani, or YLI, a selection of beads, and crystals and an applicator wand on the table to make an eye-catching display. Place the nine bolts of Illusion in front of the table, and mix in some bolts of the Deep Sea and Color Collage textures from our Spring lines.
