## The Quilt Shop

Barbara Lavalley is an Alaskan artist and award-winning illustrator of children's books. Her limited edition prints, note cards, needlework and cross stitch kits, and quilting patterns feature brightly colored, stylized characters. This is her first fabric collection for Red Rooster Fabrics. The Quilt Shop is bustling with excitement as quilters select fabrics and patterns, and show off their projects. Set these whimsical scenes in Attic Windows blocks, using the tiny paisley (Pattern #15341) and the texture (Pattern #15339) as window frames. Stitch up some comfy corded cushions for your quilt room with the button toss and floral stripe and make a cover for your sewing machine from the sewing notions print. Or, mix and match all the prints in a roomy tote for your quilting supplies. The Quilt Shop collection will be introduced at International Quilt Market in Minneapolis, MN in May, 2006.
