Country Cousins

Country Cousins features a collage of angels, daisies, sheep and roosters, birdhouses, stars, hearts, stars, and butterflies in the master print. There's a toss of angels and one of birdhouses and hearts, a stripe, a check, a vine with hearts and flowers, a daisy print, a toss of sheep and chickens, a print with densely packed flowers, and a toss of tiny flowers and bees. Try this collection with its warm country reds, blues, yellows, and browns in a traditional Rail Fence, Nine Patch, or Irish Chain quilt. It's also a natural for folk art projects. Cut the collage print into 6" x 4" postcards, fuse to cardstock, and embellish with buttons for a quick display.

A pattern featuring two pieced country cousins holding hands, sheep, roosters, birdhouses, and hearts, designed by Pearl Pereira of P3 Designs, is available for this collection. It makes a very cute wall hanging or lap-size quilt.
