Koi glisten in the sunlight as they splash through waterfalls that tumble over mountain sides. This sets the stage for this stunning Asian fabric collection and is the focus of the large panel design. This collection is offered in two color stories – dramatic black and red as well as soft blue and brown – that contain rich color as well as gold metallic accents. An extraordinary repeating stripe perfectly complements the focal panel and the large-scale floral toss that is set against a dark, shadow-print ground. The koi medallion print is truly unique and offers many ideas for use. The medallions can be cut out and used as block centers or appliquéd to pillows, garments, tablecloths, etc. while full yardage would look wonderful as curtains, bedskirts, shower curtains and quilt backs! Two tonal prints balance the bolder, thematic prints. A small flower design is simply created with delicate flower outlines in metallic pigment on richly, mottled grounds. The subtle wave pattern provides lots of texture within the soft color stories. Hang our project quilt on a wall and it will provide a dynamic focal point for any room in the house! *6 patterns/20 sku's.*

From the bookshelf...

- ✿ *Happy Hour* by Atkinson Designs. Relax and enjoy these super simple quilts. The large pieces are perfect to showcase the *Kingyo* fabrics. Also includes a tote bag, table runner, and pillow
- ✿ *Strips & Curves* by Louisa L. Smith. C & T Publishing. The combination of straight lines and gentle curves creates zingy but easy-to-make quilts.

To the pattern rack...

- ✿ *Asian Nights Pj's* by Indigo Junction. Pajama pattern with three different sleeve and pant variations. The top pulls easily over the head even while buttoned.
- ✿ *Shadowbox* by Mountainpeek Creations. Simple design with incredible dimension and visual impact! This quilt's dynamic style will perfectly complement the *Kingyo* fabrics.

And, don't forget your display!

Place fresh (very inexpensive) or dried bamboo stalks in a vase to create a tall, visual accent for your display table. Hang our project quilt as a backdrop behind your table or as a table cover. Tie project kits with metallic covered wire or ribbon. Pour some iridescent stones or pebbles in the bottom of a large fish bowl or small aquarium and place kits inside. Sew pj's using the pattern listed above and hang near table or display on a mannequin. Looking good!
