**K**atelyn's Garden is as pretty as can be with its bouquets of luscious pink and blue roses. Sprays of roses, a small, densely packed floral, a lattice floral, plus a stripe, a tiny vine, and a beautiful scroll print complete this 24-piece collection. These florals are well suited for traditional quilt patterns like baskets, stars, log cabins, and garden mazes. Or, make a duvet cover for your bedroom and stitch up a pretty dust ruffle from the stripe. Add some corded and ruffled pillow shams; cover the pillows with the lattice floral and the cording with the tiny vine, and add ruffles in the small floral. Complete the room decor with a valance from the elegant scroll print.

A quilt pattern designed by June Pease for Red Rooster is available for this collection. You'll love the pretty pieced sashing that frames the large floral blocks!
