Elm Creek Quilts: Circle of Quilters

Jennifer Chiaverini has designed her sixth fabric line, Elm Creek Quilts: Circle of Quilters, for Red Rooster Fabrics. She is the best-selling author of nine *Elm Creek Quilts* novels and *An Elm Creek Quilts Sampler*, published by Simon & Schuster. She has also written two quilt pattern books, *Elm Creek Quilts* and *Return to Elm Creek*, both published by C&T.

The fabrics in the Circle of Quilters collection were inspired by Jennifer's newest novel, *Circle of Quilters*, the story of five quilters who apply for two faculty positions at Elm Creek Manor, a fictional retreat for quilters in rural Pennsylvania. The designs in the collection include small and medium scale florals that appeal to traditional quilters, and a stripe and geometric with a contemporary flair. A grape and grapevine motif recalls one character's memorable journey through the California wine country, while an overlapping dot pattern symbolizes the energetic and close-knit circle of quilters at Elm Creek Manor that the candidates are eager to join.

Show this collection with Jennifer's novels and pattern books...

✿ *Elm Creek Quilts: Quilt Projects Inspired by the Elm Creek Quilts Novels* (Chiaverini and Odum) and *Return to Elm Creek* by Jennifer Chiaverini, C&T Publishing. Both books include inviting quilt patterns for traditional and contemporary prints.

✿ *Turning Twenty and Turning Twenty...Again* by Tricia Cribbs, FriendFolks. In just 3-5 hours, make a shop sample from one of these books. Display it with a stack of 20 coordinated fat quarters, and watch the books and fat quarters fly out of the store!

✿ *Wine Country Quilts: A Bounty of Flavorful Projects for Any Palette* by Cindy Lyle Rymer and Jennifer Rounds, C&T Publishing. Fifteen quilt designs inspired by nature and lots of extras.

Add a wearables pattern to your display...

✿ *Sassy Skirts* by Cindy Taylor Oates, Taylor Made Designs. Choose from 12 different skirt patterns: short or long, A-line, tiered, or ruffled. Trim with ribbon, rick rack, and fringe. This is a great pattern for florals or stripes, geometrics, and circles.

✿ *Wacky Patchwork Jacket* by Back Porch Press. A casual, relaxed jacket with collar and cuffs. Just rotary cut strips and sew. Machine quilt to blend the fabrics.
