Contemporary Cottage

The Contemporary Cottage Collection was inspired by the cozy, comfortable, and welcoming cottage style so popular today. The big floral master print is available in three garden-inspired colorways to satisfy every taste: rose and gold or purple and gold blossoms on a buttery background, or in a monochromatic creamy beige that would make a great background for a pieced or appliquéd quilt. An accompanying wavy stripe, lively dots and circles, a vibrant swirl, interlocking circles, and a good basic sponged texture in light, medium, and dark values add a contemporary twist to the traditional florals. Redo a bedroom quickly by covering a duvet with the luscious large-scale floral, and update the look with a bed skirt from the splashy stripe. A floor length round tablecloth might be just the thing for your sunroom. Or, perk up those tired dining room chairs with slipcovers!
