## *Fishing Friends*

Ingrid is an award-winning designer and an author/illustrator of children's books. Her artwork is filled with cozy subjects and happy colors. Her characteristic detailed and nostalgic work is seen in the scenic print of the boy and girl fishing and playing near the water. There's a companion allover print of the boy and girl frolicking, a wonderful watery texture, a little daisy print, a stripe, small vignettes in a daisy lattice, and a cheerful toss of fish, leaves, frogs, and dragonflies. These are wonderful prints for kids' quilts and for decorating their rooms. Center the scenic print vignettes in an Ohio or variable star or Churn Dash block for a pretty bed quilt and make a valance from the daisy lattice. Make pillowcases from the allover print and band them with a strip of the texture and the little daisies. Display these prints with bunches of daisies, a fishing basket, and a straw hat.
