Companion prints include a wonderful stripe, a big check with frolicking Santas, a peppermint toss, a little check, a toss of gift boxes, and a stripe of peppermint Ho Ho Hos. What a cute star quilt this collection would make, with the Santa vignettes featured at the star's centers! The vignettes would also make great placemats with checked napkins. Or, try them in a pair of gift pajamas with the master print for the top and the Ho Ho Hos for the bottom. Stitch up a quick fabric bowl and fill it with peppermint candies to display with this fabric line.
